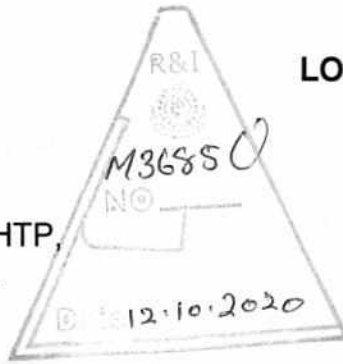

On the fixed date representative of M/s. Multiline Enterprises were appeared before the Committee and explained their grievances as under:-

The Complaint Redressal Committee (CRC) of grievances & settlement of disputes was constituted vide Notification No. LG/DG/M&E/AD-II/327(1-Sindh)/2017/692, Dated 20.03.2020, issued by Assistant Director-II (PM&EC), Local Government Department, GOS Karachi. in accordance with Rule-31 of Sindh Public Procurement Rules-2010 (amended 2013). **(at Annexure-A)**

❖ **COMPLAINT PROCEEDINGS:**

1. The Chairman CR Committee first asked the delegation of Multiline Enterprise to present its position and details regarding the grievances. The head of the M/s Multiline Enterprise delegation then expressed his concerns in detail and presented his point of view, while the Procurement Committee gave a detailed explanation on each point
2. The Procurement Committee also informed the CR committee that some errors have already been rectified and a pre-bid document has been issued, in this regard.
3. It may be pertinent to mentioned here that the notification regarding the composition of the CR Committee was issued dated 20.03.2020, but the Chairman CR Committee was kept unaware of this notification.
4. It is also noteworthy that uptill now, the Procurement Committee was responding to all the complaints of the bidders on its own. In this regard, no any complaint has been sent to the Chairman CR Committee.
5. During the proceedings, the CR Committee came to know that this tender has been postponed five times since 2009.
6. As this complaint relates to purely "**Technical Evaluation Criteria**", the Committee decides that M/S NESPAK, who is also a member of this Procurement Committee as an observer, submit its complete experts opinion and recommendations to the Committee till the next meeting.

7. This Committee further directs the Procurement Committee to submit all the documents related to this tender before this Committee at its next meeting.


❖ **CONCLUSION:**



A.	<p>Reservation regarding Clause 17, PART-A, Bidder Eligibility Criteria which states:</p> <p><b>"Similar Quoted Fire Tenders and Major Components i.e. Chassis, Fire Pump, Fire Monitor and Water Monitor, must already have been sold and operational in Pakistan."</b></p> <p>Please also note the above conditions are in contradiction to each other and it dilutes competition between quality suppliers and manufacturer and hence creates ambiguity for the participation in the bid. Therefore, to ensure maximum participation and to invite international investment, technology and quality equipment in Pakistan, you are requested to allow international references of developed countries also along with Pakistan and South Asian countries references.</p>	<p>It is important to clarify that Selection Criteria given in the Bidding documents is for assessment of the Worth of the firm who is supplying goods or services. For that it is important that the firm who will act as the front face for the procuring agency has enough technical / financial expertise to not only perform the task but subsequently provide O&amp;M services for at least three years beyond delivery date. Any firm or JV interested in the bidding process must be locally registered and comply with the basic required placed. This is good for all the interested parties who can come up with any international product which can comply with already specified specifications in bidding documents.</p> <p>The purpose of this Clause is to safeguard that technical expertise which exists in local market and also open up avenues for transfer of technology in the subsequent years with proper O&amp;M mechanism. Further, the tender also contains recognized international standards for proposed Chassis and also stipulates origin of Fire Pump, Water Monitor, Foam Mixer, Fire Hose Reel to be EU/USA/Japan. This is to ensure world class performance and quality.</p>
B.	<p>Reservation regarding Note I, PART-B, Technical Evaluation Criteria which states:</p> <p><b>"Bidders are required to provide NTN Certificate, Sales Tax, Income Tax Returns and Manufacturer Accreditation including ISO 9001:2015 or ISO 14001 and EN 1028-1 &amp; EN-1028-2 compliance (Fire Pump) Water Monitor must be verifiable to EU / USA, Japanese Origin, Material of Boom Ladder and Turntable should be EU / American / Japan Origin, PTO should owned and certified by Chassis manufacturer, Chassis' Can must be certified by ECE standard and manufacturer audited balance sheet as</b></p>	<p>This clause does NOT suggest that the manufacturer's equipment such as chassis must be certified using manufacturer audited balance sheet. It is also global practice that most of the sophisticated and advanced technological products e.g. an aircraft uses turbo fans or turbines from best available sources other than their own brands. The paramount example of arranging best component other than original manufacturer is Rolls Royce.</p>	<p>There are numerous manufacturers across the globe that are manufacturing fire pumps and foam mixers to the standard required in the subject tender. However, this is not a mandatory requirement which will render the bidder disqualified if this requirement is not met. It is only a stated preference of the Procurement Committee, LGDP, GOS. As such, bidders are open to offer their technical bids accordingly.</p> <p>However the allied components / parts used in any product must be owned and certified and must comply the international standards / specifications of the particular manufacturer as mentioned in bidding document.</p>

Reservation regarding Note II of Technical Evaluation Criteria which states:  <b>Minimum Qualifying Marks is 80 out of 100 of technical evaluation to declare Substantial Responsive and eligible for Financial Bid Evaluation. Otherwise, their bid will be rejected and their sealed Financial Offer will be returned unopened within 10 working days after acceptance of award of supply.</b></p> <p>The requirement of 80% is stringent enough and allocated / designed to facilitate limited companies. The split and marks distribution to achieve this number is not evenly designed and showing imbalance in favor of certain manufacturers and empirically not possible</p>	<p>The Procurement Committee, LGDP, GOS has set this minimum standard of 80 marks out of 100 of technical evaluation in order to ensure that citizens of Sindh receive the very best quality equipment in relation to lifesaving, firefighting and disaster management. This is only possible from high quality manufacturer. It is envisaged that any top quality manufacturing company will be easily able to meet this requirement. After all, 80% is only a basic pass mark. Further, the subject tenders have the status of International Tenders as per SPPRA Rules, 2010 which stipulate that any tenders of this size for specialist equipment/vehicles must be</p>

However, any notification / order / circular etc, in this regard, issued by department / transparency monitoring agencies issued at any time prior to award of this work shall be complied with.</b></p> <p>That the above referred clause 12 of Eligibility Criteria is malafidely designed to technically knock out any person or company for the nefarious designs to award the subject tender to some blue eyed company and/or person.</p>	<p>The said clause is a sincere effort on the part of Procurement Committee, LGDP, GOS to prevent <u>ONLY</u> those companies from competing which are guilty of the specific offences listed in the clause. It is hoped that all bidders would wholeheartedly agree that any firm that is guilty of these specific offences should be prevented from competing on government tenders in order to safeguard the precious public monies. Nonetheless, it is obvious from the clause highlighted that no specific company is being prohibited from competing in the said tender, and as importantly, no company or person is being preferred. Indeed, any bidder is most welcome to participate. As such, any assertions declaring that any bidder's rights are being deprived does not stand up to scrutiny.</p>



It is hoped that the maximum number of bidders / manufacturers will compete in the subject matters in order to engender intense competition which is hoped will get maximum value for the public purse for the citizens of Sindh.

**Insaf Imdad programme to begin on Monday**

**// SHEIKHUPURA**  
**8 shot dead after clash over kids in Shekhupura**

Eight persons were killed and four others injured in an armed clash between two groups in the jurisdiction of Shekhupura station on Saturday. According to police, the incident occurred near Kharanwala area where Ghulam Rasool Group and Khadim Group exchanged fire following a fight over children. As a result, All Shah Khadim of Kharanwala, Yasir Khwida, Bahadur Bhai, Wahid Ahmed, Muhammad Tufail, Tariq Ahmed and Abroz Ali received bullet injuries and died on the spot. Police are investigating the incident. — AFP

**People throng markets as govt eases lockdown**

ISLAMABAD — Pakistanis crowded markets on Saturday after a nationwide coronavirus lockdown was eased, despite the country declaring its second highest daily infection toll.

Prime Minister Imran Khan has allowed businesses to reopen in phases from the weekend, citing the economic havoc the virus restrictions have wreaked on the impoverished nation.

In the garrison city of Rawalpindi, thousands of shoppers were preparing for Eid Al Fitr, with many floating social distancing rules and advice to wear masks.

In Karachi shopkeepers set out their wares of shoes, clothes, bangles and fabrics, while in the capital Islamabad shoppers stood in tightly-packed queues as they waited for stores to open.

Similar scenes were played out in Lahore, Quetta and Peshawar. Omar Shirazi, a banker shopping for clothes with his daughter in Rawalpindi, welcomed the move.

"Eid is approaching," he said. "We have to buy new garments for our children. It's the responsibility of people to comply with rules and wear safety gear." Tehmina Sattar, who was shopping with her sister and sons, was more cautious.

"We are happy with this decision but at the same time I have a fear in my heart that if this disease spreads it could be devastating. People here are not taking preventative measures."

The country's Information Minister Shabbaz Fiaz warned Saturday that the lockdown on businesses would be reimposed if safety guidelines were not followed, after authorities reported more than 1,600

new cases in the past 24 hours. Infections have been rising steadily as testing has increased, with more than 28,500 cases and more than 600 deaths recorded in the nation of over 210 million.

The easing comes as many across the country have openly ignored restrictions on gatherings in public during the past month, especially during the evenings in the holy month of Ramadan. — AFP

**STRANDED IN CORONA EPICENTRE**

**Repatriation of Wuhan students from May 18**

ISLAMABAD — The government has decided to bring back students stuck in Wuhan, China, by special flights, Special Assistant to Prime Minister on Overseas Pakistanis Zulfiqar Bukhari tweeted on Friday night, Dawn reported.

Pakistan International Aviation (PIA) will bring the first batch of Pakistanis — mostly students — from May 18, when around 250 individuals are expected to return.

Pakistanis who had been studying in Wuhan and other cities in the Chinese province of Hubei had

appealed for evacuation. Multiple requests for evacuation were made by the stranded students and their families back home. However, the government said that it would not repatriate them immediately and would follow guidelines and processes put in place by China in this regard.

To allay the fears of the students and their families, the Foreign Office in February sent two of its officials from the embassy in Beijing to Wuhan while the strict lockdown was still in place, according to Dawn.

**Bajwa, US peace envoy discuss Afghan talks**

ISLAMABAD — US Special Representative for Afghanistan Reconciliation Zalmay Khalilzad met with army chief Qamar Javed Bajwa about the Afghan peace process, the Pakistan military said in a short statement.

Bajwa reiterated that support to the peace process is a manifestation of a goodwill towards the cause, the statement by the Inter-Services Public Relation said on Friday, adding that the US official appreciated Pakistan's continued efforts for peace and stability in the region. Xinhua news agency reported.

Khalilzad arrived in Pakistan on Friday. — IANS

**MILITANCY**

**6 soldiers killed in blast**

ISLAMABAD — An improvised explosive device hit a Pakistani security forces vehicle in the restive southwestern province of Balochistan on Friday, killing six soldiers and wounding one other, the army said.

The incident took place in the treacherous highlands of Kech district, some 14km from the Pakistan-Iran border, where soldiers from the paramilitary Frontier Corps (FC) were on a routine patrol.

"FC South Balochistan troops were moving back to their base after assigned patrolling duty, reconnaissance vehicle of FC troops was targeted with remote controlled IED. Resultantly, 1 officer & 5 soldiers embraced Shahadat (martyrdom)," the military said in a statement. A Baloch separatist group, the Balochistan Liberation Army (BLA), claimed responsibility for the attack in an email to AFP. — AFP
