PRE-QUALIFICATION OF FIRMS FOR SYNGAS POWER GENERATION SYSTEM

I am directed to refer to your letter No.DIR/CB/SPPRA/M34/UCG/12-13/729 dated 15.08.2013 on the subject.

2. It is stated that applications were invited through National Press and SPPRA Website Sr. # 16948 for Re-invitation of Pre-qualification of firms for Syngas Power Generation System for UCG Project. The twenty five firms have purchased the prescribed Re-invitation of Pre-qualification documents out of which only six firms have submitted their documents.

3. The committee held its meeting on October 25, 2013 at office of the DG, Sindh Coal Authority, Karachi to evaluate the documents and recommended that the exercise for Pre-qualification of firms for Syngas Power Generation System is done twice and in both the case only one firm qualified for prequalification. **The committee, therefore, recommended that the Pre-qualification of firms for Syngas Power Generation System may be scrapped and an open tender may be invited through National Press and SPPRA Website as per decision of Governing Body in its meeting held on July 25, 2013.** The minutes of the meeting is enclosed for hoisting on SPPRA Website accordingly.

- e) M/s Jaffer Brothers (Pvt.) Ltd Islamabad. They have supported their request with the documents from their principals M/S Shingli Oilfield Shingli Power Machinery Group Company Ltd. China / Shanghai Blue Eyes Import & Export Co. Ltd China. They have supported their request with the literature for High Concentration Gas Generators Sets. The fuel used by this High Concentration Gas Generator is gas with CH₄ which is not lower than 25%. They have also offered Low Concentration Gas Generator Sets. The fuel used by this Low Concentration Gas Set is gas with CH₄ of 9% - 25%. Both of the types offered by the firm are not according to the requirement of UCG Project Thar. Therefore they are not recommended for prequalification.
- f) M/s Business Resource Development (Pvt) Ltd. Karachi. They have supported their request from the principals M/s China National Chemical Engineering Corporation (CNCEC). The equipment offered by the firm is Multi Slurry Gasification & Coal Slurry Gasification. These types are not according to the requirements of UCG Project Thar. Therefore they are not recommended for prequalification.
6. **Recommendation:** The exercise for Pre-qualification of Firms for Syngas Power Generation System is done Twice. In both of the cases only one firm qualified for pre-qualification. It is therefore recommended that the Pre-qualification of Firms for Syngas Power Generation System may be scrapped and an Open Tender may be invited through National Press and SPPRA Web Site as per Decision of Governing Body vide Item No. # 5 in its 11th meeting reproduced as below:

Item # 5

PURCHASE OF SYN GAS POWER GENERATION SYSTEM

MD, UCG informed the forum about the problems being faced by the Project on purchase of syngas generators. Open tenders for Syn Gas Generators were invited through National Press during 2011. The offer of M/S Shengli Oil Field Shengli Power Machinery Group Co. Ltd C/O Forwarding Enterprise was according to technical specifications and was lower in price also. M/S Shengli Oil Field Shengli Power Machinery Group Co. Ltd was selected for award of the contract. But due to delay in allocation of funds, the offer of the firm was cancelled being a time barred offer according to SPPRA rules.

The tenders were re-invited through National Press. Again the offer of M/S Shengli Oil Field Shengli Power Machinery Group Co. Ltd C/O Forwarding Enterprise was according to specifications but it was not supported with proper Bank Guarantee as against required Earnest Money. The tenders were therefore cancelled again according to SPPRA rules.

Later on the applications were invited through National Press and SPPRA Web Site for Prequalification of Firms for Syngas Power Generation System for UCG Project. There was only one party who came up with the Gen sets suitable for Syn Gas produced by Under Ground Coal Gasification out of three firms.

Evaluation Committee meeting on pre-qualification of Syngas Power Generation System was held on May 27, 2013 and the committee after going through the details of the case, recommends that the case may be referred to SPPRA for their Advice through Secretary (C&EDD) Government of Sindh for final decision. Therefore, the matter was


again forwarded to the SPPRA for advice on the recommendation of the pre-qualification committee meeting. The SPPRA has advised to re-invite the pre-qualification of firms for Syngas Power Generation System which has also been re-invited through National Press and SPPRA Web site and the last date is August 20, 2013.

Decision


Governing Body, UCG Project Thar has thoroughly discussed the case for purchase of Syngas Power Generation System and decided that the pre-qualification of firms for Syngas Generators may be completed in the light of SPPRA Rules 2010 and if still there remain one firm after pre-qualification then UCG Project Thar may go for open tender for purchase of Syngas Power Generation System in the light of SPPRA Rules 2010.

Subject: Minutes of Meeting on Re-Invitation of Pre-qualification of Firms For Syngas Power Generation System.

1. As contained in letter No. Dir(CB)M34(UCG)/SPPRA/12-13/174 dated 10th July 2013, the applications for Prequalification of Firms for Syn Gas Power Generation System were re-invited through National Press and SPPRA Web Site. In response to this re-invitation the below given firms purchased the Pre-qualification Documents against the prescribed cost.

2. In order to get a healthier response and provision of more information, the opening date of the prequalification documents was extended up to 05th September 2103 through National Press and SPPRA Web Site. The firms who have purchased the documents were also informed through Fax/ Courier.

3. The documents were opened on 5th September 2013 at 1100 Hrs at the Office of Director General Sindh Coal Authority, Bunglow No.16,E Street, Zam Zama Park, DHA Phase V Karachi by the committee approved vide No. SO (Coord)/ C&EDD/5-14/2013 dated 23rd May 2013.

4. The following firms participated:

5. The committee held its meeting on 25th October 2013 at the Office of DG Sindh Coal Authority. The evaluation is as under:

- a) The documents submitted by M/S Link Lines (Pvt.) Ltd Lahore. They have supported their request with the documents from their principals M/s Shingli Oilfield Shingli Power Machinery Group Company Ltd. China for prequalification for syngas power generation system (Syn gas produced by underground coal gasification). The firm has supported their request with the performance certificate of different numbers of generators fuelled by low BTU from Underground Coal Gasification System. They have also supported their request with a technical description of power generation technology program for Pakistan Underground Coal Gasification Gas and a technical catalogue from ShenDong Genset for coal gas/Underground Coal Gasification Gas/ producer gas GenSets specifications. This is inconsonance with the requirements of UCG Project Thar. The firm stands qualified for pre-qualification.
- b) M/s Allied Engineering & Services Ltd. Karachi. They have supported their request with the documents from their principals Caterpillar S.A.R.L. They have based their request on the basis of coal mine methane gas (CMM) engines. These type of generators are not as per requirements of UCG Project Thar. Therefore they are not recommended for prequalification.
- c) M/s SM Jaffer & Co. Karachi. Their principals M/S Jinan Diesel Engine Co. Ltd. China. According to the catalogues they have offered the coal gas generators fuelled by Natural Gas/ Natural Gas from Oil Field, Bio Gas, Coal Gas, Refinery Gas, Coal Mine Gas, Diesel. These types of generators are not according to the requirement of UCG Project Thar. Therefore they are not recommended for prequalification.
- d) M/s STZ Engineers Lahore. They have supported their request from the principals M/S China Machinery Engineering Corporation China. They have offered generators fuelled by Low Concentration, Bio Gas, Biomass Gas, The equipment offered by the firm is not as per requirements of UCG Project Thar. Therefore they are not recommended for pre-qualification.
