1.0 INTRODUCTION

 The Right Bank Out Fall Drain (RBOD) crosses KB Lower Canal near Chilia and the Escape of MRB Link Canal near Keenjhar. It also crosses KG Canal on its downstream.

This invitation is for the construction of Siphons as crossing structures along with two Fall structures. There are three Packages in this Project of contract No. RBOD/2013/1. Each Package is discussed briefly as under:

3.2 Qualification Criteria

3.2.1 General

Pre-qualification will be based on all the criteria given in succeeding paras 3.2.2 to 3.2.6 regarding the Applicant's Financial Soundness, Experience Record, Personnel Capabilities and Equipment Capabilities as demonstrated by the Applicant's responses in the forms attached to this letter. The Employer reserves the right to waive minor deviations, if these don't materially affect the capability of an applicant to perform the contract. Sub-contractor's experience and resources shall not be taken into account in determining the Applicant's compliance with the qualifying criteria. However, Joint Venture experience & resources shall be considered. Consortium or Association of firms will be considered for similar treatment as in case of Joint Venture. The procuring agency shall evolve a criteria keeping in view the complexity of the Project. 3.3 Joint Venture (JV)

- 3.3.1 Joint Venture must comply with the following requirements:

 - iii) In the opinion of the Employer, a substantial reduction in competition would result.
 - c) Bid shall be signed by all members in the JV so as to legally bind all partners, jointly and severally, and any bid shall be submitted with a copy of the JV agreement providing the joint and several liability with respect to the contract.
- The prequalification of a JV does not necessarily prequalify any of its partners individually or as a partner in any other JV or association. In case of dissolution of a JV, each one of the constituent firms may prequalify if they meet all the prequalification requirements and any partner of J.V has requested/shall request for the same and then his prequalification shall be subject to the written approval of the Employer.

3.4 Conflict of Interest

The Applicant (including all members of a JV) must not be associated, nor have been associated in the past, with the consultant or any other entity that has prepared the design, specifications, and other prequalification and bidding documents for the project, or was proposed as Engineer for the contract, over the last five years. Any such association may result in disqualification of the Applicant.

3.5 Updating Prequalification Information

Bidders shall be required to update the financial, personnel and equipment information used for prequalification at the time of submitting their bids, to confirm their continued compliance with the qualification criteria and verification of the information provided at the time of prequalification. A bid shall be rejected if the Applicant's qualification thresholds are no longer met at the time of bidding.

3.6 Other Factors

- Only firms and JVs that have been prequalified under this procedure shall be invited to bid. A qualified firm or a member of a qualified JV may participate only in one bid for the contract. If a firm submits more than one bid, singly or as a JV, all bids including that bidder will be rejected. This rule will not apply in respect of bids which include specialist sub-contractors who are used by more than one bidder.
- 3.6.2 The Employer reserves the right to:
 - a) Amend the scope and value of any contract(s) to be bid, in which event the bidder(s) will only bid among those prequalified bidders who meet the requirements of the contract(s) as amended. However the Employer has to review the disqualified bids who originally do not meet the specified criteria for Pre-qualification.
 - b) Reject or accept any application; and
 - c) Cancel the prequalification process and reject all applications.

Firms owned by individuals, and partnerships, may submit their balance sheets certified by a registered accountant, and supported by copies of tax returns, if audits are not required by the laws of their countries of origin in case of foreign firms.
