General Rules and Direction for the Guidance of Contractors

1. All work proposed to be executed by contract shall be notified in a form of invitation to tender posted on a board hung up in the office of the Executive Engineer and signed by the Executive Engineer, and the detailed of the works to be tendered will be supplied to the prospective tenderers on their request.

This form will state the work to be carried out, as well as the date for submitting and opening tenders and the time allowed for carrying out the work; also the amount of earnest money to be deposited with the tender, and the amount of the security deposit to be deposited by the successful tenderers and the percentage, if any, to be deducted from bills. It will also state whether refund of quarry fees, royalties, octroi dues and ground rents will be granted. Copies of the specifications, designs and drawings and estimated rates schedule rates and any other documents required in connection with the work shall be signed by the Executive Engineer for the purpose of identification, and shall also be open for inspection by contractors at the office of the Executive Engineer during office hours.

2. In the event of the tender being submitted by a firm, it must be signed separately by each partner thereof, or in the event of the absence of any partner, it shall be signed on his behalf by a person holding a power-of-attorney authorizing him to do so.

3. Receipts for payments made on account of any work, when executed by a firm, shall also be signed by all the partners, except where the contractors are described in their tender as a firm, in which case the receipt shall be signed in the name of the firm by one of the partners, or by some other persons having authority to give effectual receipts for the firm.

4. Any person who submits a tender shall fill up the usual printed form, stating at what percentage above or below the rates specified in Schedule 'B' memorandum showing items of work to be carried out, he is willing to undertake the work. Only one rate of such percentage, on all the estimated rate/schedule rates shall be framed. Tenders, which propose any alteration in the works specified in the said form of invitation to tender, or in the time allowed for carrying out the work, or which contain any other conditions, will be liable to rejection. No printed form of tender shall include a tender for more than one work, but if contractors wish to tender for two or more works they shall submit a separate tender for each. Tenders shall have name and number of the work to which they refer written outside the envelope.

5. The Executive Engineer or his duly authorised Assistant shall open tenders in the presence of contractors who have submitted tenders or their representatives who may be present at the time, and he will enter the amount of the several tenders in a comparative statement in suitable form. In the event of a tender being accepted, the contractors shall for the purpose of identification, sign copies of the specifications and other documents mentioned in Rule 1. In the event of a tender being rejected the Divisional Officer shall authorize the Treasury Officer, concerned to refund the amount of the earnest money deposited to the contractor making the tender, on his giving a receipt for return of the money.

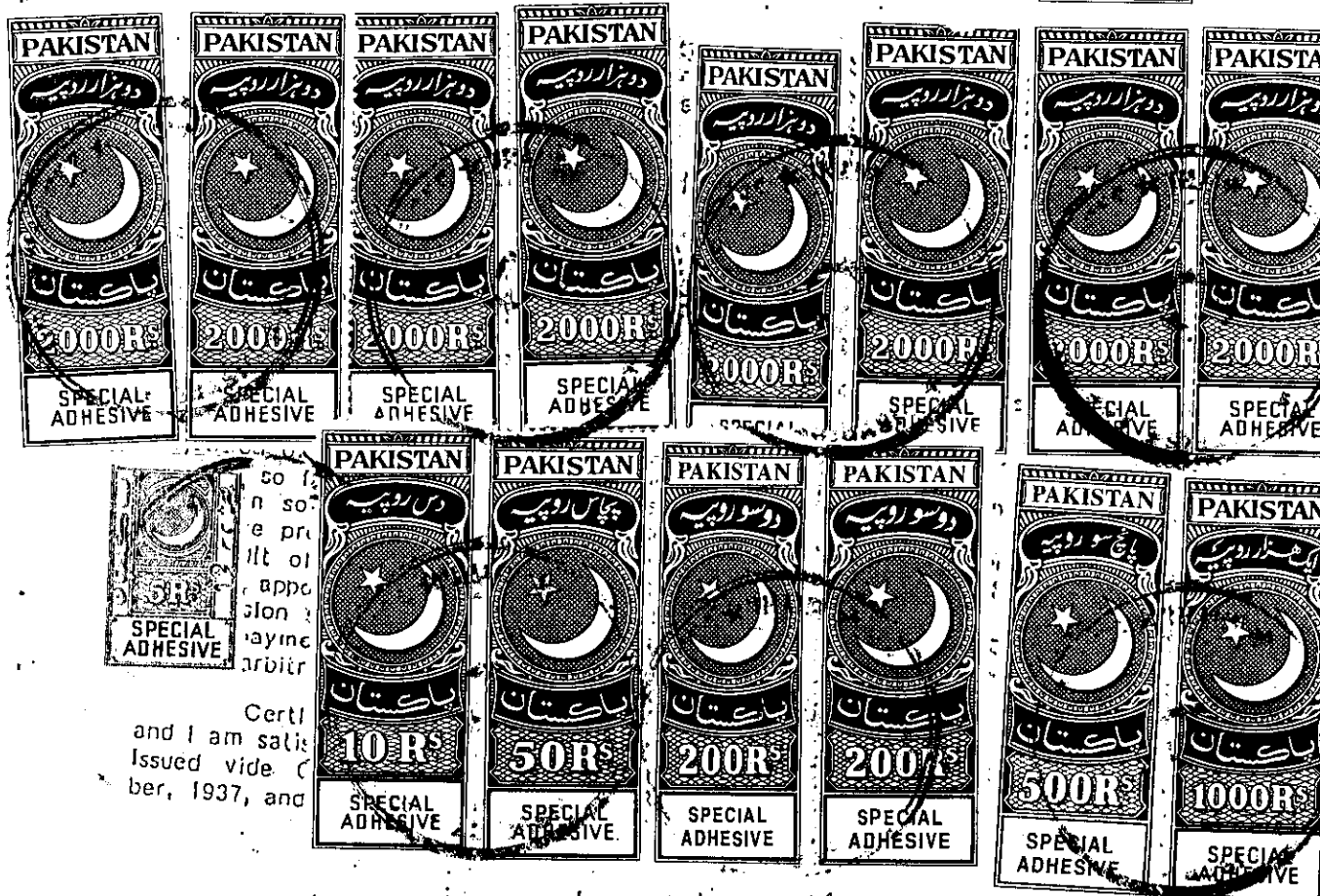



It will also state whether refund of quarry fees, royalties, petrol dues and ground rents will be granted. Copies of the specifications, designs and drawings and estimated rates schedule rates and any other documents required in connection with the work shall be signed by the Executive Engineer for the purpose of identification, and shall also be open for inspection by contractors at the office of the Executive Engineer during office hours.

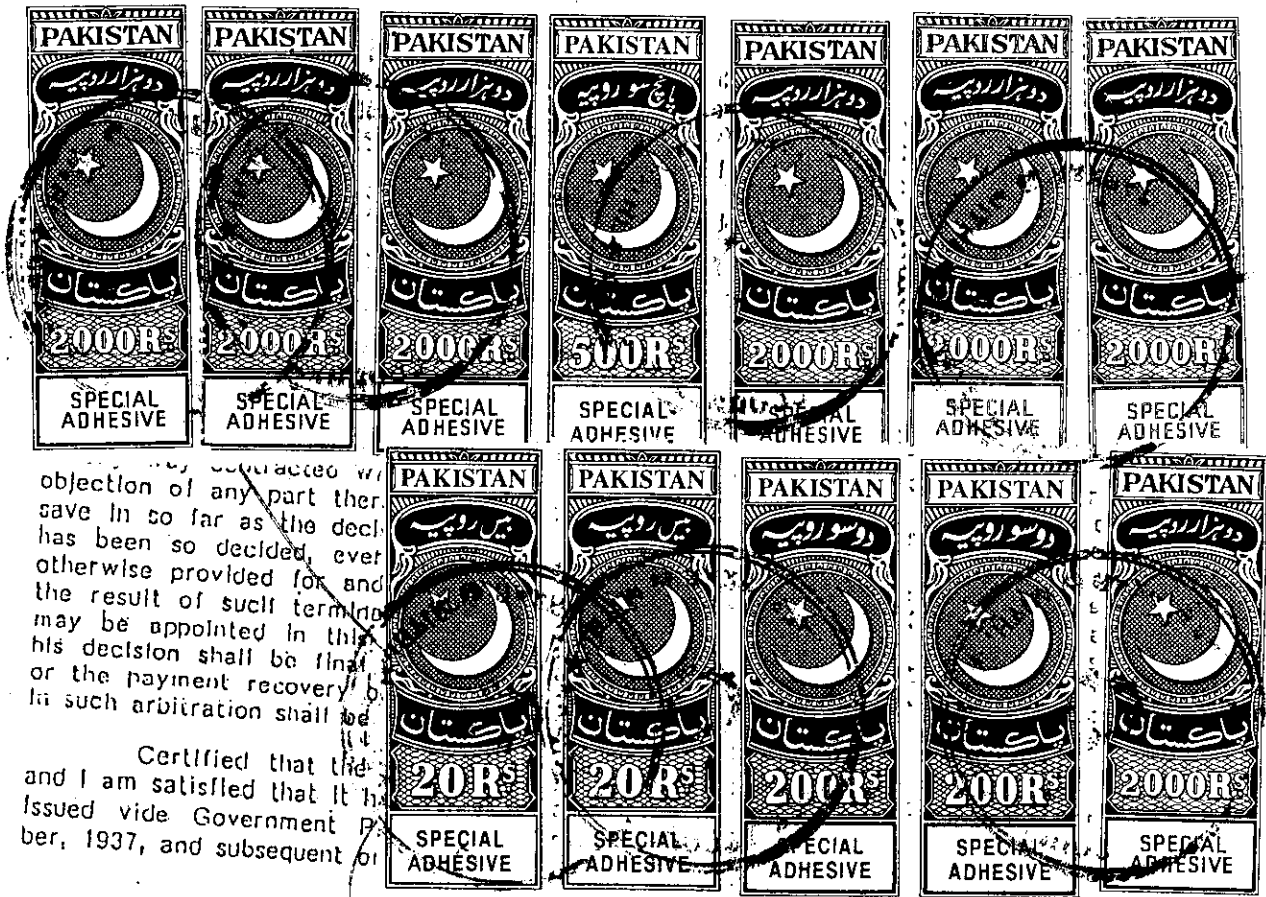

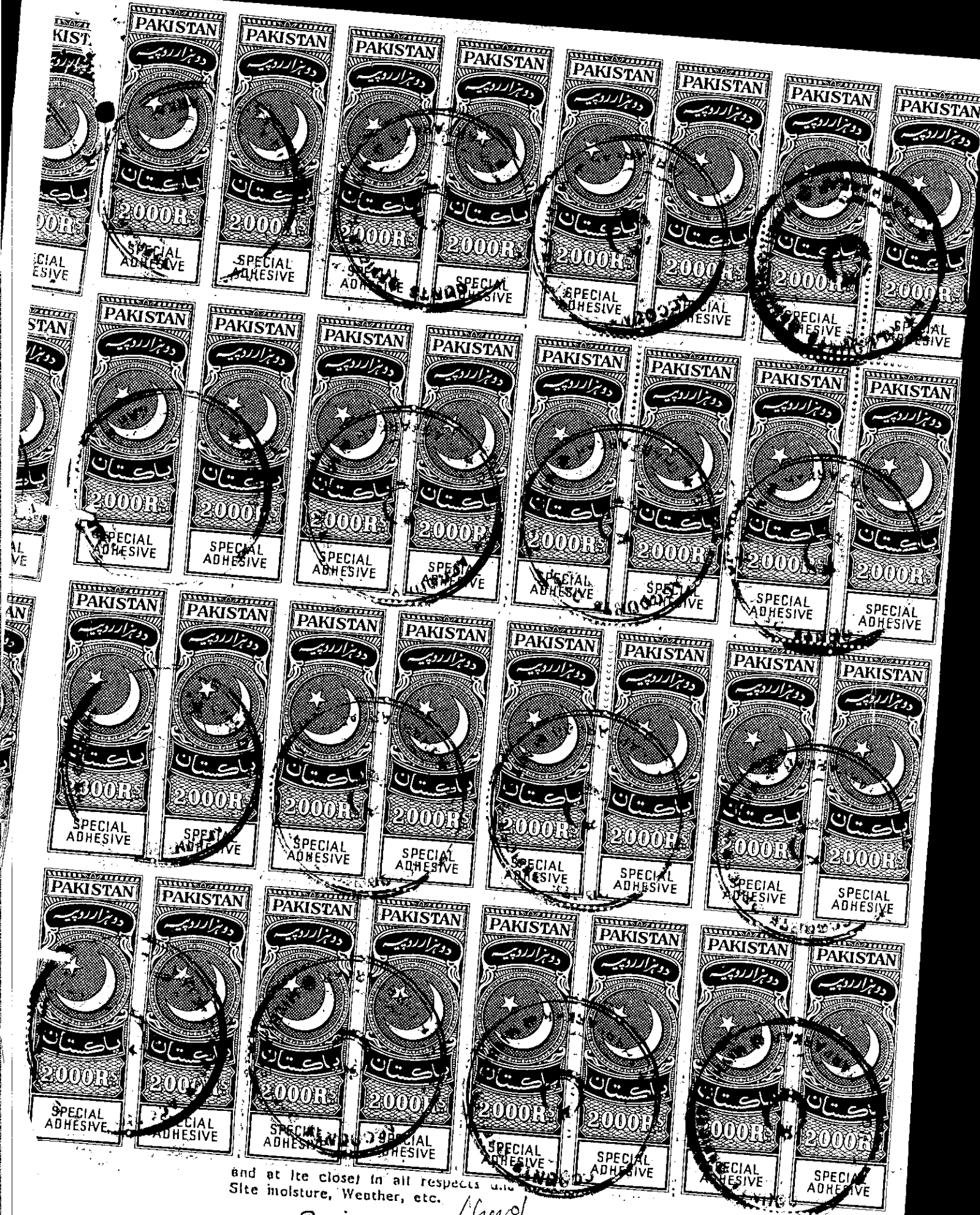
