REHABILITATION & STRENGTHENING OF K.B.F LOWER.

The Irrigation systems of 04 Taluka of District Thatta totally depends upon Kalri Baghar Feeder Lower including drinking water supply of the area Makli and Thatta City. The condition of the Kalri Baghar Feeder Lower between RD. 22.0 to RD.77 is very miserable and it cannot pass the designed discharges causing that the irrigation system of 04 Taluka of District Thatta is badly damaged. Therefore rehabilitation and strengthening of K.B. Feeder Lower is proposed to cater the demand of area of the peoples and also redress the grievances of the Khatedars.

REHABILITATION OF PURICHA MINOR & GHAR MASSAN MINOR.

The Puricha minor off-takes from RD.77 of Kalri Baghar Feeder Lower. The banks of both channels are completely damaged & beds of channels are also badly silted and choked, Hence the rehabilitation of Puricha Minor and Ghar Massan minor are proposed.

<u>REHABILITATION OF BAGHAR ESCAPE CHANNEL EX.K,B.F LOWER</u>.

The Eaghar Escape off-takes from Kalri Baghar Feeder Lower @ RD.77. The designed discharge of the Escape is 2000 cusecs. During the super flood 2010 as well as heavy rain fall in the year 2011, the banks of Baghar Escape were completely damaged and are in Worst condition, it needs to rehubilitated.

REHABILITATION ROAD BRIDGES ALONG CHANNELS IN K.B. DIVISION, THATTA.

There are thickly populated areas situated along both side of the Link canal, Ghar Massan, Allah Khai and Jherruck Distry and available Road bridges at RD. 56 & 100 of Link Canal, RD.7 & RD.10 of Ghar Massan, RD.05 of Allah Khai Minor & at RD.30 of Jherruck Distry are main sources for the people of the vicinity to travel one place etc and these bridges are in deteriorated condition and **GODFORBID** may fall any time, which need to be repaired on emergent basis.
