**4.0 Section I. Instructions to Bidders/Applicants (ITB).**

**Clause 1** The firm/contractor shall enclose the one original and two (2) copies of the documents in a sealed envelope which shall:-

- (a) bear the name and address of the Applicant;
- (b) be delivered by hand or through courier/registered mail to address mentioned in advertisement for pre-qualification or in document; and
- (c) be clearly marked "Application for Pre-qualification for " **Providing stone pitching along PFL RD 120 to 130 IP side rd 135 to 140 NIP side, RD 152 to 160 and 161 to 163 NIP side village Abral, Re-sectioning of Gunj Bahar branch and repair to head regulator, road bridge, dumping of stone pitching, Rehabilitation of laikpur ex: Ali bahar distry and protection wall and earth work and stone pitching wall, Earth work and stone pitching along Raj wah Ex: PFL RD 0 to 30 and earth work, Stone pitching along Ghari wah Ex: Pinyari branch RD 4 to 6 with cattle ramp at RD 06, Reconstruction / repair of regulators in Sujawal District "**.

**Clause 2** If the envelope is not sealed and marked as required, the procuring agency will assume no responsibility for the misplacement or pre-maturing opening of the document.

**Clause 3** Document shall be prepared in the English language. In case of ICB, the information provided in any other language shall be accompanied by English translation also.

**Clause 4** Firm/Contractor must respond to all questions and provide complete information as advised in this document. Any lapses to provide essential information may result in dis-qualification of the firm/contractor.

**Clause 5 Clarification and Modification of Documents (SPP Rule 23).**

Firm/Contractor, who has obtained documents, may request for clarification of contents of the bidding document in writing, and respond to such queries shall be made in writing within three calendar days, provided they are received at least five calendar days prior to the date of opening of bid.

**Clause 6 Addendum:**

At any time prior to the deadline for submission of documents, the agency may amend the Prequalification Document by issuing addenda. Any addendum issued shall be part of the Prequalification Document and shall be communicated in writing to all who have obtained the prequalification document.

**Clause 7 Deadline for submission of Documents (SPP Rule 22 & 24):**

Documents shall be received by the agency at the address (*mention the address & telephone & fax numbers*), not later than the (*mention the date & time*). The procuring agency may, at its discretion, extend the deadline for the submission of documents by amending the Prequalification Document, and in which case all rights and obligations of the Agency and the firms/contractors subject to the previous deadline shall thereafter be subject to the deadline as extended

**Clause 8 Evaluation (Rule 27 (2)):**

Firm's/Contractor's general and particular experience, personnel and equipment capabilities, and financial position, as demonstrated by the Applicant's responses in the prescribed forms will be evaluated as per evaluation criteria given in the document. The Procuring Agency reserves the right to waive minor deviations, if these don't materially affect the capability of an applicant to perform the contract. Sub-contractor's experience and resources shall not be taken into account in determining the firm/contractor compliance with the qualifying criteria. However, Joint Venture experience & resources shall be considered. Consortium or Association of firms will be considered for similar treatment as in case of Joint Venture.

**Clause 9 Clarification of Prequalification Information (Rule 43):**

To assist in the evaluation of information, the agency may, at its discretion, ask any firm/contractor for a clarification of any information which shall be submitted within a stated reasonable period of time. Any request for clarification shall be in writing. If any firm/contractor does not provide clarifications of the information requested by the date and time set in the agency's request for clarification then application of the firm/contractor may be rejected.

**Clause 10 Verification of Prequalification Information (Rule 28 (1d)):**

Verification of the information provided by the pre-qualified/shortlisted firms/contractors in the submissions for prequalification may be made. In case the information is found to be wrong or incorrect in any material way or firm/contractor is found to be lacking in the capability or resources to successfully perform the contract, then it shall not be pre-qualified.

1. **REQUIRED WORK**

**STONE PITCHING ALONG PINYARI FEEDER LOWER RD 120 TO 130 INSPECTION PATH SIDE RD 135 TO 140 NON-INSPECTION PATH RD 152 TO 160 AND 161 TO 163 VILLAGE ABRAL**

*Pinyari Feeder Lower is non-perennial system which off takes from Old Fuleli Canal RD 114, having design discharge 12763 cusecs. The 14 Nos. channels off takes from this system.*

*During the Super Flood 2010 some portion was badly damaged at that time the repair work was carried out. The portions along PFL RD 120 to 130 inspection path side RD 135 to 140 non-inspection path were also damaged badly there are sandy portion have design parameters are not maintained able any heavy slipping occurs.*

*Avery thick population is residing along both sides of PFL, to avoid any misshape, stone pitching work is proposed to maintain the design parameters of the channels. Under ADP Scheme No. 1189.*

**RE-SECTIONING OF GUNJ BAHAR BRANCH AND REPAIR TO HEAD REGULATOR, ROAD BRIDGE, DUMPING OF STONE PITCHING**

*The Gunj Bahar Branch off takes from PFL RD 114.135 with design discharge of 857.0 cusecs and total length in 70 RD. Due to huge silt deposited in canal due to low discharges available from Kotri Barrage, it does not carry the design discharge resulting there is hue and cry of shortage of water to tail enders.*

*The Head Regulator and Road Bridge work are also proposed in this ADP Scheme.*

**STONE PITCHING DUMPING AND REHABILITATION OF LAIKPUR**

*The laikpur distry off takes from Ali Bahar distry from RD 13.90 with length in RD 16 and having its design discharge of 55 cusecs. Due to heavy silt enter and low discharges prisms of canal is badly affected. Thus bed width and depth of laikpur distry is considerably reduced. So this work proposed to bring the canal prism to its design levels to carry the full design discharge to avoid shortage in tail.*

**PROTECTION WALL EARTH WORK AND STONE PITCHING ALONG RAJ WAH AND GHARI WAH**

*The Raj wah off takes from P.F.L at RD 148.0 and Ghari Wah off takes from Gunj Bahar Branch at RD 7.0. Due to heavy silt entry and low discharges prism of canal is badly affected. Thus bed width and depth of Raj wah, Ghari wah off takes from Gunj Bahar Branch is considerably reduced. So this work is proposed to bring the canal prisms to its design levels to carry the full design discharge to avoid shortages in tail also various breaches were occurred during the flood 2010 which needs stone pitching to stabilize the prism of canal which is very difficult during the full level.*

**RE-SECTIONING OF GUNJ BAHAR BRANCH AND REPAIR TO HEAD REGULATOR, ROAD BRIDGE, DUMPING OF STONE PITCHING**

*Various Regulators along Darro Branch particularly Tail Regulators of Darro Branch Head Regulator Machki Branch, Khnato Distry, Ghar Wah and Ratoool Distry were damaged badly due to immerses flow of flood 2010. But the repair works was not carried out resulting feline of many Regulators. Hence Scheme is prepared for repair and reconstruction of above regulators.*
