Instructions to Bidders

ofineligibility for corruptand fraudulentpracticesissued bytheany governmentorganizationinaccordance withsub clause 34.1

## 3. EligibleGoods and Services

- 3.1 Allgoodsandrelatedservicestobesuppliedunderthecontract shallhavetheiroriginineligiblesourcecountries, defined in the SPPRARules, 2010 and its Bidding Documents and all expenditures made underthecontract will be limited to such goodsand services.
- 3.2 Forpurposesofthisclause, "origin" meanstheplacewherethe goodsare mined, grown, or produced, or the place from which the related services are supplied. Goodsare produced when, through manufacturing, processing, or substantial and major assembly of components, a commercially-recognized product results that is substantially different in basic characteristics or in purpose or utility from its components.
- 3.3 Theoriginofgoodsandservicesisdistinctfromthenationality of theBidder.

# 4. Cost of Bidding

4.1 TheBiddershallbearallcostsassociatedwiththepreparation and submission of its bid, and the Procuring agency named in the BidData Sheet, hereinafter referred to as "the Procuring agency," will inno case be responsible or liable for those costs, regardless of the conductor outcome of the bidding process.

# 5. Content of Bidding Documents

- 5.1 thebiddingdocumentsinclude:

  - (e) Scheduleof Requirements
  - (f) Technical Specifications
  - (g) BidFormand PriceSchedules
  - (h) BidSecurity Form
  - (i) ContractForm
  - (j) PerformanceSecurity Form
  - (k) Manufacturer's Authorization Form
- 5.2 TheBidderisexpectedtoexamineallinstructions, forms, terms, and specifications in the bidding documents. Failure to furnish all information required by the bidding documents or to substantially responsive to the bidding documents in every respectively beauther bidder's risk and may result in the

rejection of its bid.

# 6. Clarification of Bidding Documents

6.1 AinterestedBidderrequiringanyclarification ofthebidding documentsmaynotify theProcuring agencyinwriting. Procuring agency will respond in writing to any request for clarification of the bidding documents which it receives no later thanthreeworkingdayspriortothedeadlineforthesubmission ofbidsprescribedintheBidDataSheet. Writtencopiesofthe Procuringagency's response(including an explanation ofthe querybutwithoutidentifyingthesourceofinquiry)willbesent to all interested bidders that have received the bidding documents.

# 7. Amendment of Bidding Documents

- 7.1 Atanytimepriortothedeadlineforsubmissionofbids,the Procuringagency,foranyreason,whetheratitsowninitiativeor inresponsetoa clarificationrequestedbyainterestedBidder, may modify thebidding documentsbyamendment.
- 7.2 Allinterestedbiddersthathavereceivedthebiddingdocuments willbenotifiedoftheamendmentinwriting,andwillbebinding on them.
- 7.3 In orderto allowinterestedbiddersreasonabletimeinwhichto takethe amendmentintoaccountin preparingtheirbids, the Procuring agency, at its discretion, may extend the deadline for the submission of bids.

### C. Preparation of Bids

# 8. Language of Bid

8.1 Thebid preparedby the Bidder, as well as all correspondence and documents relating to the bid exchanged by the Bidder and the Procuring agency shall be written in the language specified in the BidData Sheet. Supporting documents and printed literature furnished by the Bidder may be in another language provided they are accompanied by an accurate translation of the relevant passages in the language specified in the Bid Data Sheet, in which case, for purposes of interpretation of the Bid, the translation shall govern.

# 9. Documents Comprising the Bid

- 9.1 ThebidpreparedbytheBiddershallcomprisethefollowing components:
  - (a) aBidFormandaPriceSchedulecompletedinaccordance withITB Clauses 10, 11, and 12;
  - (b) documentaryevidenceestablishedinaccordancewithITB

- Clause 13 that the Bidderise ligible to bid and is qualified to perform the contractifits bid is accepted;
- (c) documentaryevidenceestablishedinaccordancewithITB
  Clause 14 that the goods and ancillary services to be
  suppliedbytheBidderareeligiblegoodsandservicesand
  conformto thebidding documents;and
- (d) bidsecurity furnishedin accordancewith ITB Clause 15.

#### 10.Bid Form

10.1 TheBiddershallcomplete theBidFormandtheappropriate Price Schedulefurnishedinthebiddingdocuments,indicating thegoodstobesupplied,abriefdescriptionofthegoods,their country of origin,quantity,andprices.

#### 11.Bid Prices

- 11.1 TheBidder shallindicateon the appropriatePriceSchedulethe unitprices(whereapplicable)and totalbid priceof thegoodsit proposesto supply under thecontract.
- 11.2Pricesindicatedon thePrice Schedule shallbe deliveredduty paid(DDP) prices. Thepriceof other (incidental)services,if any,listed inthe BidData Sheet willbeenteredseparately.
- 11.3TheBidder'sseparationofpricecomponentsinaccordancewith ITB Clause 11.2 above will be solely for the purpose of facilitatingthecomparisonofbidsbytheProcuringagencyand willnotinanywaylimittheProcuringagency'srighttocontract on any of thetermsoffered.
- 11.5Pricesquoted bytheBidder shallbe fixedduring theBidder's performanceof thecontractand notsubjectto variationon any account,unlessotherwise specifiedinthe BidData Sheet. Abid submittedwith anadjustablepricequotationwillbe treatedas nonresponsiveand willbe rejected,pursuant to ITBClause 24. If, however,in accordancewith theBid DataSheet,prices quotedbytheBiddershallbe subject toadjustmentduringthe performanceof thecontract,a bidsubmittedwith afixed price quotationwillnotbe rejected,but thepriceadjustment would be treatedaszero.

### 12.Bid Currencies

- 12.1 PricesshallbequotedinPakRupeesunlessotherwisespecified in theBid DataSheet.
- 13.Documents

- 13.1PursuanttoITBClause9,theBiddershallfurnish,aspartofits bid,documentsestablishingtheBidder'seligibilitytobidandits qualificationsto performthe contractif itsbidisaccepted.

- 13.2 ThedocumentaryevidenceoftheBidder'seligibilitytobidshall establishto theProcuringagency'ssatisfactionthatthe Bidder,at thetimeofsubmissionofitsbid,isfromaneligiblecountryas definedunder ITB Clause2.
- 13.3The documentaryevidence of the Bidder's qualifications to performthe contractifitsbidisacceptedshallestablishtothe Procuring agency's satisfaction:
  - (a) that,inthecaseofaBidderofferingtosupplygoodsunder the contract which the Bidder did not manufacture or otherwiseproduce,theBidderhasbeendulyauthorizedby thegoods'Manufacturerorproducertosupplythegoodsin theProcuring agency'scountry;
  - (b) thattheBidderhasthefinancial,technical,andproduction capability necessary to perform the contract;
  - that,inthecaseofaBiddernotdoingbusinesswithinthe
    Procuring agency'scountry, theBidderisorwillbe(if awarded the contract) represented by an Agent in that country equipped, and able to carry out the Supplier's maintenance, repair,andspare parts-stockingobligations prescribedintheConditionsofContract and/orTechnical Specifications;and
  - (d) thattheBiddermeetsthequalificationcriterialistedinthe BidData Sheet.
- 14.Documents
  Establishing
  Goods'
  Eligibilityand
  Conformity to
  Bidding
  Documents
- 14.1PursuanttoITBClause9,theBiddershallfurnish,aspartofits bid,documentsestablishingtheeligibilityandconformitytothe bidding documentsofallgoodsandserviceswhichtheBidder proposestosupply under thecontract.
- 14.2Thedocumentaryevidenceoftheeligibilityofthegoodsand servicesshallconsistofastatementinthePriceScheduleofthe countryoforiginofthegoodsandservicesofferedwhichshall be confirmed byacertificate of origin issued atthe time of shipment.
- 14.3The documentary evidence of conformity of the goods and services to the bidding documents may be in the form of literature, drawings, and data, and shallconsistof:
  - (a) adetailed description of the essential technical and

### Performancecharacteristicsof the goods;

- (b) alistgivingfullparticulars,includingavailablesourcesand current pricesofspareparts,specialtools,etc.,necessary fortheproperandcontinuingfunctioningofthegoodsfora period tobespecified i n the BidDataSheet, following commencementoftheuseofthe goodsbytheProcuring agency;and
- (c) an item-by-item commentary on the Procuring agency's Technical Specifications demonstrating substantial responsiveness of the goods and services to those specifications, or a statement of deviations and exceptions to the provisions of the Technical Specifications.
- 14.4ForpurposesofthecommentarytobefurnishedpursuanttoITB Clause 14.3(c)above,theBiddershallnotethatstandardsfor workmanship,material,andequipment,aswellasreferencesto brandnamesorcataloguenumbersdesignatedbytheProcuring agency in its Technical Specifications, are intended to be descriptiveonlyandnotrestrictive. TheBiddermaysubstitute alternativestandards,brandnamcs,and/orcataloguenumbersin itsbid,providedthatitdemonstratestotheProcuring agency'ssatisfactionthatthesubstitutionsensuresubstantialequivale nce to those designatedinthe TechnicalSpecifications.

### 15.Bid Security

- 15.1 PursuanttoITBClause9,theBiddershallfurnish,aspartofits bid, a bidsecurity in the amount specifiedinthe BidData Sheet.
- 15.2The bid security is required to protect the Procuring agency against riskofBidder's conduct which would warrant the security's forfeiture, pursuant to ITB Clause 15.7.
- 15.3ThebidsecurityshallbeinPak.Rupeesandshallbeinoneof the followingforms:
  - (a) abankguaranteeoranirrevocableletterofcreditissuedby areputablebanklocatedintheProcuringagency'scountry, intheformprovidedinthebiddingdocumentsoranother formacceptabletotheProcuringagencyandvalidfor thirty (30) daysbeyondthevalidityof the bid;or
- (b) Irrevocableencashableon-demandBank call-deposit.
- 15.4AnybidnotsecuredinaccordancewithITBClauses15.1and 15.3willberejectedbytheProcuringagencyasnonresponsive, pursuantto ITBClause 24.

- 15.5Unsuccessfulbidders'bidsecuritywillbedischargedorreturned aspromptly aspossiblebutnotlaterthanthirty(30)daysafter the expiration of the period of bid validity prescribed by the Procuring agency pursuant to ITBClause 16.
- 15.6ThesuccessfulBidder'sbidsecuritywillbedischargeduponthe Bidder signing the contract, pursuant to ITB Clause 32, and furnishing theperformance security, pursuant to ITBClause 33.

### 15.7Thebid security maybe forfeited:

- (a) if a Bidder withdraws its bid during the period of bid validityspecifiedby the Bidder on the Bid Form; or
- (b) inthe case of a successful Bidder, if the Bidderfails:
  - (i) tosignthecontractinaccordancewithITBClause 32;

or

(ii) tofurnishperformancesecurityinaccordancewith ITBClause 33.

### 16.Periodof Validityof Bids

- 16.1BidsshallremainvalidfortheperiodspecifiedintheBidData
  SheetafterthedateofbidopeningprescribedbytheProcuring
  agency,pursuantto ITBClause19. Abidvalidforashorter period
  shall be rejected by the Procuring agency as
  nonresponsive.
- 16.2Inexceptionalcircumstances, the Procuring agencymay solicit the Bidder's consent to an extension of the period of validity. The request and the responses the reto shall be made in writing. The bidse curity provided under ITB Clause 15 shall also be suitably extended.

  ABidder may refuse the request without for feiting its bidsecurity. ABidder granting the request will not be required no repermitted to modify its bid, except as provided in the bidding document.

### 17.Format and Signing of Bid

- 17.1TheBiddershallprepareanoriginalandthenumberofcopiesof indicatedintheBidDataSheet,clearlymarkingeach "ORIGINALBID" and "COPYOFBID," asappropriate. In the event of any discrepancy between them, the original shall govern.
- 17.2Theoriginalandthecopyorcopiesofthebidshallbetypedor writtenin indelibleinkandshallbesignedbytheBidderora

- person or persons duly authorized to bind the Bidder to the contract. All pagesofthebid, except forun-amended printed literature, shall be initialed by the person or persons signing the bid.
- 17.3Any interlineations, erasures, or overwriting shall be valid only if they are initialed by the person or persons signing the bid.
- 17.4TheBiddershallfurnishinformationasdescribedintheFormof Bidon commissionsorgratuities,ifany,paidortobepaidto agentsrelatingtothisBid,andtocontractexecutioniftheBidder isawardedthe contract.

### D. Submission ofBids

### 18.Sealingand Marking of Bids

- 18.1TheBiddershallsealtheoriginalandeachcopyofthebidin separateenvelopes,dulymarkingtheenvelopesas"ORIGINAL" and "COPY." Theenvelopesshallthenbesealedinanouter envelope.
- 18.2Theinner andouter envelopesshall:
  - (a) beaddressedtotheProcuringagencyatthcaddressgiven inthe BidDataSheet;and
  - (b) beartheProjectnameindicatedintheBidDataSheet,the
    InvitationforBids(IFB)titleandnumberindicatedinthe Bid
    Data Sheet, and a statement: "DO NOT OPEN
    BEFORE," to be completed with the time andthe date
    specifiedinthe BidData Sheet,pursuantto ITBClause 2.2.
- 18.3Theinnerenvelopesshallalsoindicatethenameandaddressof theBiddertoenablethebidtobereturnedunopenedincaseitis declared"late".
- 18.4If theouter envelopeisnotsealedand markedasrequired by ITB Clause 18.2, the Procuring agency will assume no responsibility for the bid's misplacement or premature opening.

### 19.Deadlinefor Submission of Bids

- 19.1BidsmustbereceivedbytheProcuringagencyattheaddress specifiedunderITBClause18.2nolaterthanthetimeanddate specifiedin theBid DataSheet.
- 19.2TheProcuringagencymay,atitsdiscretion,extendthisdeadline for the submission of bidsbyamendingthe biddingdocumentsin accordance with ITB Clause 7, in which case all rights and

obligations of the Procuring agency and bidders previously subject to the deadline will there after be subject to the deadline as extended.

### 20. LateBids

20.1 AnybidreceivedbytheProcuringagencyafterthedeadlinefor submissionofbidsprescribedbytheProcuringagencypursuant toITBClause19willberejectedandreturnedunopenedtothe Bidder.

### 21. Modification and Withdrawalof Bids

- 21.1The Bidder may modify or withdraw its bid after the bid's submission, provided that written notice of the modification, including substitution or withdrawal of the bids, is received by the Procuring agency prior to the deadline prescribed for submission of bids.
- 21.2The Bidder's modification or withdrawal notice shall be prepared, sealed, marked, and dispatched in accordance with the provisions of ITB Clause 18. by a signed confirmation copy, postmarked not later than the deadline for submission of bids.
- 21.3Nobidmaybemodifiedafterthedeadlineforsubmissionof bids.
- 21.4Nobidmaybewithdrawnintheintervalbetweenthedeadline for submissionofbidsandtheexpirationoftheperiodofbid validityspecifiedbytheBidderontheBidForm. Withdrawalof abidduringthisintervalmayresultintheBidder'sforfeitureof itsbid security,pursuantto the ITBClause 15.7.

### **E.Opening and Evaluation of Bids**

### 22. Opening of Bidsby the Procuring agency

- 22.1The Procuring agency will open all bids in the presence of bidders'representativeswhochoosetoattend,atthetime,onthe date, andatthe placespecified intheBidDataSheet. The bidders'representatives whoare present shall sign aregister evidencingtheirattendance.
- 22.2The bidders' names, bid modifications or withdrawals, bid prices, discounts, and the presence or absence of requisite bid security and such other details as the Procuring agency, at its discretion, may consider appropriate, will be announced at the opening. No bidshall be rejected at bid opening, except for late bids, which shall be returned unopened to the Bidder pursuant to ITB Clause 20.

- 22.3Bids(andmodificationssentpursuanttoITBClause21.2)that are not opened and read out at bid opening shall not be considered further for evaluation, irrespective of the circumstances. Withdrawnbidswillbereturnedunopenedtothe bidders.
- 22.4TheProcuring agency willprepare minutesof thebid opening.

# 23. Clarification of Bids

23.1Duringevaluationofthebids,theProcuringagencymay,atits discretion, asktheBidder fora clarification ofits bid. The requestforclarificationandtheresponseshallbeinwriting,and nochangeinthepricesorsubstanceofthebidshallbesought, offered,or permitted.

### 24.Preliminary Examination

- 24.1The Procuring agency will examine the bids to determine whether they are complete, whether any computational errors have been made, whether required sureties have been furnished, whether the documents have been properly signed, and whether the bids are generally in order.
- 24.2Arithmeticalerrorswillberectifiedonthefollowingbasis. If thereisadiscrepancybetwcontheunitpricandthetotalprice thatisobtainedby multiplyingtheunitpriceandquantity,the unitpriceshallprevail,andthetotalpriceshallbecorrected. If the Supplier does not accept the correction of the errors, its bid will be rejected, and its bid security may be for feited. If there is a discrepancy between words and figures, the amount in words will prevail.
- 24.3The Procuring agency maywaive any minor informality, nonconformity, orirregularity in abid which does not constitute amaterial deviation, provided such waiver does not prejudice or affect the relative ranking of any Bidder.
- 24.4Priortothedetailedevaluation,pursuanttoITBClause25the Procuring agencywilldeterminethesubstantialresponsiveness of each bidtothe biddingdocuments. Forpurposesofthese Clauses, a substantially responsive bid is one which conforms to allthetermsandconditionsofthe biddingdocumentswithout material deviations. Deviations from, or objections or reservationstocriticalprovisions, suchas those concerning Bid Security(ITBClause15), Applicable Law (GCCClause30), and TaxesandDuties(GCCClause32), willbedeemedtobea materialdeviation. The Procuring agency's determinationofa bid's responsiveness is to be based on the contents of thebid itselfwithoutrecourse to extrinsic evidence.

24.5Ifabidisnotsubstantiallyresponsive, it will be rejected by the Procuringagencyandmaynotsubsequentlybemaderesponsive bytheBidder bycorrection of the nonconformity.

### Comparison of Bids

- 25.Evaluation and 25.1TheProcuringagencywillevaluateandcomparethebidswhich have been determined to be substantially responsive, pursuant toITBClause 24.
  - 25.2 The Procuring agency's evaluation of a bid will be ondelivered (DDP)priceinclusiveofprevailingdutiesandwill dutypaid excludeanyallowanceforpriceadjustmentduringtheperiodof execution of the contract, if provided in the bid.
  - 25.3The Procuring agency's evaluation of a bid will take into account,in additiontothebidpricequotedinaccordancewith Clause 11.2, one or more of the following factors as specifiedintheBidDataSheet,and quantifiedinITBClause 25.4:
    - (a) incidentalcosts
    - deliveryscheduleofferedin thebid;
    - deviationsinpaymentschedulefromthatspecifiedinthe (c) SpecialConditionsof Contract;
    - the cost of components, mandatory spare parts, and service;
    - the availabilityProcuringagencyofsparepartsandafter-(e) sales services for the equipment of fered in the bid;
    - the projected operating and maintenance costs during the life of (f) theequipment:
    - the performance and productivity of the equipment of fered;(g) and/or
    - other specificcriteria indicated in the Bid Data Sheet (h) and/orin the Technical Specifications.
  - 25.4 For factors retained in the Bid Data Sheet pursuant to ITB 25.3,one ormore of the following quantification methods will be applied, as detailed in the Bid Data Sheet:
    - Incidentalcostsprovidedbythebidderwillbeaddedby (a) Procuringagencytothedelivereddutypaid(DDP)priceat

### thefinaldestination.

### (b) Delivery schedule.

(i) The Procuring agency requires that the goods under the Invitation for Bids shall be delivered at the time specified in the Schedule of Requirements which will be treated as the base, adelivery "adjustment" will be calculated for bids by applying a percentage, specified in the Bid Data Sheet, of the DDP price for each week of delay beyond the base, and this will be added to the bid price for evaluation. No credit shall be given to early delivery.

or

(ii) Thegoodscoveredunderthisinvitationarerequired tobedelivered(shipped)withinanacceptablerange ofweeks specifiedintheScheduleofRequirement. Nocreditwillbegiventoearlierdeliveries,andbids offeringdeliverybeyondthisrangewillbetreatedas nonresponsive. Within thisacceptable range, an adjustment perweek,asspecified in the BidData Sheet,willbeaddedforevaluationtothebidpriceof bidsofferingdeliverieslaterthantheearliestdelivery periodspecifiedin theScheduleof Requirements.

or

(iii) Thegoodscoveredunderthisinvitationarerequired tobe deliveredinpartialshipments, asspecified in the Schedule of Requirements. Bids offering deliveriesearlierorlaterthanthespecifieddeliveries willbeadjustedintheevaluation by adding to the bid price a factor equal to a percentage, specified in the Bid Data Sheet, of DDP price per week of variation from the specified delivery schedule.

### (c) Deviationinpaymentschedule.

(i) Bidders shallstate their bid price for the payment scheduleoutlinedintheSCC. Bidswillbeevaluated onthebasisofthisbaseprice. Biddersare,however, permittedto stateanalternativepaymentscheduleand indicatethereductioninbidpricetheywishtooffer forsuchalternativepaymentschedule. TheProcuring agency may consider the alternative payment scheduleofferedby the selectedBidder.

or

(ii) The SCC stipulates the payments chedule offered by

the Procuringagency. If abid deviates from the schedule and if such deviation is considered acceptabletothe Procuringagency, the bid will be evaluated by calculating intereste arned for any earlier payments involved in the terms outlined in the bid as compared with those stipulated in this invitation, at the rate per annum specified in the Bid Data Sheet.

- (e) Performanceand productivity of the equipment.
  - (i) Bidders shallstate the guaranteed performance or efficiencyinresponsetothe Technical Specification. Foreachdropintheperformance or efficiency below the norm of 100, an adjustment for an amount specified in the Bid Data Sheet will be added to the bid price, representing the capitalized cost of additional operating costs overthelife of the plant, using the methodology specified in the Bid Data Sheet or in the Technical Specifications.

or

- (ii) Goods offeredshall have a minimum productivity specified under the relevant provision in the TechnicalSpecificationstobeconsideredresponsive. Evaluationshallbebasedonthecostperunitofthe actual productivityofgoodsofferedinthebid,and adjustmentwill beaddedtothebidpriceusingthe methodologyspecifiedintheBidDataSheetorinthe TechnicalSpecifications.
- (f) SpecificadditionalcriteriaindicatedintheBidDataSheet and/orinthe TechnicalSpecifications.

TherelevantevaluationmethodshallbedetailedintheBid DataSheetand/orin theTechnicalSpecifications.

### 25.4 MeritPointSystem:

The following merit points ystem for weighing evaluation factors can be applied if none of the evaluation methods listed in 25.4 above has been retained in the Bid Data Sheet. The number of points allocated to each factor shall be specified in the Bid Data Sheet.

### 26.Contacting the Procuring agency

26.1SubjecttoITBClause23,noBiddershallcontacttheProcuring agencyonanymatterrelatingtoitsbid,fromthetimeofthebid openingtothetimethecontractisawarded.IftheBidderwishes tobringadditionalinformationto thenoticeoftheProcuring

### 1 Definitions

- 1.1 In thisContract, the following terms shall be interpreted as indicated:
  - (a) "TheContract" meanstheagreemententeredintobetween theProcuringagencyandtheSupplier, as recorded in the Contract Form signed by the parties, including all attachments and appendices thereto and all documents incorporated by reference therein.
  - (b) "The Contract Price" means the price payable to the Supplier under the Contract for the full and proper performance of its contractual obligations.
  - (c) "The Goods" means all of the goods, supplies and equipment and/or othermaterials whichthe Supplier isrequired to supply to the Procuringagency underthe Contract.
  - (d) "TheServices" meansthoseservices ancillary to the supply of the Goods, such as transportation and insurance, and any other incidental services, such as installation, commissioning, provision of technical assistance, training, and other such obligations of the Supplier covered under the Contract.
  - (e) "GCC" means the General Conditions of Contract contained in this section.
  - (f) "SCC"meanstheSpecialConditionsof Contract.
  - (g) "TheProcuringagency"meanstheorganizationpurchasing the Goods, asnamedin SCC.
  - (h) "TheProcuringagency'scountry"isthecountrynamedin SCC.
  - "TheSupplier" meanstheindividualor firmsupplying the Goods and Services under this Contract.
  - (j) "TheProjectSite,"whereapplicable,meanstheplaceor placesnamedin SCC.
  - (k) "Day"meanscalendarday.

### 2. Application

2.1 TheseGeneralConditionsshallapplytotheextentthattheyare

notsupersededby provisions of other parts of the Contract.

### 3. Countryof Origin

- 3.1 AllGoodsandServicessuppliedundertheContractshallhave theirorigininthecountriesandterritorieseligibleundertherules and`further elaboratedin theSCC.
- 3.2 ForpurposesofthisClause, "origin" meanstheplacewherethe Goods were mined, grown, or produced, or from which the Services are supplied. Goodsare producedwhen, through manufacturing, processing, or substantial and major assembly of components, a commercially recognized new product results that is substantially different in basic characteristics or in purpose or utility from its components.
- 3.3 TheoriginofGoodsandServicesisdistinctfromthenationality of theSupplier.

# 4. Technical Specification

- 4.1 TheGoodssuppliedunderthisContractshallconformtothe standardsmentionedintheTechnicalSpecifications,and,when no applicable standard is mentioned, to the authoritative standardsappropriate to the Goods' country of origin. Such standards shall be the latest is sued by the concerned institution.
- 5. Use of
  Contract
  Documents
  and
  Information;
  Inspectionand
  Auditbythe
  Government
- 5.1 The Supplier shall not, without the Procuring agency's prior writtenconsent, disclose the Contract, or any specification, plan, drawing, pattern, sample, or information furnished by or on behalf of the Procuring agency in connection therewith, to any person other than a person employed by the Supplier in the performance of the Contract. Disclosure to any such employed person shall be made in confidence and shall extend only so far as may be necessary for purposes of such performance.
- 5.2 The Supplier shall not, without the Procuring agency's prior written consent, make use of any document or information enumerated in GCC Clause 5.1 except for purposes of performingtheContract.
- 5.3 Any document, other than the Contract itself, enumerated in GCC Clause 5.1 shall remain the property of the Procuring agencyandshallbereturned(allcopies)totheProcuringagency oncompletionoftheSupplier'sperformanceundertheContract ifso required bytheProcuringagency.

5.4 TheSuppliershallpermittheProcuringagencytoinspectthe Supplier's accountsandrecordsrelatingtotheperformanceof theSupplierandtohavethemauditedbyauditorsappointedby theprocuring agency,ifso required.

### 6. PatentRights

6.1 The Supplier shall indemnify the Procuring agency against all third-party claims of infringement of patent, trademark, or industrial design rights arising from use of the Goodsor any part thereof in the Procuring agency's country.

### 7. Performance Security

- 7.1 Withintwenty(20)daysofreceiptofthenotificationofContract award, the successful Bidder shall furnish to the Procuring agency the performance security in the amount specified in SCC.
- 7.2 The proceeds of the performance security shall be payable to the Procuring agency as compensation for any loss resulting from the Supplier's failure to complete its obligations under the Contract.
- 7.3 Theperformancesecurityshallbedenominatedinthecurrency of the Contractacceptable to the Procuring agency and shall be in one of the following forms:
  - (a) abankguaranteeoranirrevocableletterofcreditissuedby areputablebanklocatedintheProcuringagency'scountry, intheformprovidedinthebiddingdocumentsoranother formacceptableto theProcuringagency;or
  - (b) acashier'sor certifiedcheck.
- 7.4 TheperformancesecuritywillbedischargedbytheProcuring agencyand returnedto theSuppliernotlaterthanthirty(30) days followingthedateofcompletionoftheSupplier'sperformance obligations under the Contract, including any warranty obligations, unless specifiedotherwise in SCC.

# 8. Inspections and Tests

- 8.1 The Procuring agency or its representative shall have the right to inspect and/or to test the Goodsto confirm their conformity to the Contract specifications at no extra cost to the Procuring agency. SCC and the Technical Specifications shall specify what inspections and tests the Procuring agency requires and where they are to be conducted. The Procuring agency shall not if y the Supplier in writing, in a timely manner, of the identity of any representatives retained for the sepurposes.
- 8.2 Theinspections and tests may be conducted on the premises of the Supplier or its subcontractor (s), at point of delivery, and/or at

- the Goods' final destination. If conducted on the premises of the Supplier or its subcontractor(s), all reasonable facilities and assistance, including access to drawings and production data, shall be furnished to the inspector sat no charge to the Procuring agency.
- 8.3 Shouldanyinspected ortested Goodsfailtoconformtothe Specifications, the Procuring agency may reject the Goods, and the Supplier shall either replace the rejected Goods or make alterations necessary to meet specification requirements free of cost to the Procuring agency.
- 8.4 The Procuring agency's right to inspect, test and, where necessary, reject the Goods after the Goods' arrival in the Procuringagency's countryshallinnoway be limited or waived by reason of the Goods having previously been inspected, tested, and passed by the Procuring agency or its representative prior to the Goods' shipment from the country of origin.
- 8.5 NothinginGCCClause8shallinanywayreleasetheSupplier fromany warranty or otherobligationsunder thisContract.

### 9. Packing

- 9.1 The Supplier shall provide such packing of the Goods as is requiredtopreventtheirdamageordeteriorationduring transitto theirfinal destination, as indicated in the Contract. The packing shall be sufficient to with stand, without limitation, rough handling during transitand exposure to extreme temperatures, saltand precipitation during transit, and open storage. Packing case size and weights shall take into consideration, where appropriate, the remoteness of the Goods' final destination and the absence of heavy handling facilities at all points in transit.
- 9.2 The packing, marking, and documentation within and outside the packages shall complystrictly with such special requirements as shall be expressly provided for in the Contract, including additional requirements, if any, specified in SCC, and in any subsequent instructions or dered by the Procuring agency.

## 10.Deliveryand Documents

12.1TheSupplier isrequiredunderthe Contacttotransport theGoods toaspecifiedplaceofdestinationwithintheProcuringagency's country, transporttosuchplaceofdestinationintheProcuring agency'scountry, includinginsuranceandstorage,asshallbe specifiedintheContract,shallbearrangedbytheSupplier,and relatedcostsshallbe includedin theContractPrice.

### 13.Incidental Services

- 13.1The Supplier may be required to provide any or all of the following services, including additional services, if any, specifiedinSCC:
  - (a) performance or supervision of on-site assembly and/or startup of the suppliedGoods;
  - (b) furnishing of tools required for assembly and/or maintenance of the supplied Goods;
  - (c) furnishingofadetailedoperationsandmaintenancemanual for each appropriate unit of the supplied Goods;
  - (d) performanceorsupervisionormaintenanceand/orrepairof the supplied Goods, for a periodoftime agreed by the parties, provided that this service shall not relieve the Supplier of any warranty obligation sunder this Contract; and
  - (e) training of the Procuring agency's personnel, at the Supplier's plant and/or on-site, in assembly, start-up, operation, maintenance, and/or repair of the supplied Goods.
- 13.2Prices charged by the Supplier for incidental services, if not included in the Contract Price for the Goods, shall be agreed upon in advance by the parties and shall not exceed the prevailing rates charged for other parties by the Supplier for similar services.
- 14.1 AsspecifiedinSCC, the Supplier may be required to provide any or all of the following materials, notifications, and information pertaining to spare parts manufactured or distributed by the Supplier:

### 14.Spare Parts

- (a) such spare parts as the Procuring agency may elect to purchasefromtheSupplier,providedthatthiselectionshall notrelievetheSupplierofanywarrantyobligationsunder theContract;and
- (b) in the event of termination of production of the spareparts: (i)
  - advance notificationtotheProcuringagencyofthe pendingtermination,insufficienttimetopermitthe Procuring agency to procure needed requirements; and
  - (ii) followingsuchtermination, furnishingatnocostto the Procuringagency, the blueprints, drawings, and specifications of the spareparts, if requested.

### 15.Warranty

- 15.1 The Supplier warrants that the Goods supplied under the Contractarenew, unused, of themostrecentor current models, and that the yincorporate all recent improvements in design and materials unless provided otherwise in the Contract. The Supplier further warrants that all Goods supplied under this Contracts hall have no defect, arising from design, materials, or work manship (except when the design and/or material is required by the Procuring agency's specifications) or from any actor omission of the Supplier, that may develop under normal use of the supplied Goods in the conditions prevailing in the country of final destination.
- 15.2Thiswarrantyshallremainvalidfortwelve(12)monthsafterthe
  Goods,or anyportionthereofasthecasemaybe,havebeen
  deliveredtoandacceptedatthefinaldestinationindicatedinthe
  Contract,orforeighteen(18)monthsafterthedateofshipment from
  the port or place of loading in the source country,
  whicheverperiodconcludesearlier,unlessspecifiedotherwisein
  SCC.
- 15.3The Procuringagency shall promptly notify the Supplier in writing of any claims arising under this warranty.
- 15.4Uponreceiptofsuchnotice, the Suppliershall, within the period specified in SCC and with all reasonable speed, repair or replace the defective Goods or parts thereof, without costs to the Procuring agency.
- 15.5IftheSupplier,havingbeennotified,failstoremedythedefect(s)

withintheperiodspecifiedinSCC, withinareasonableperiod, the Procuring agency may proceed to take such remedial action as may be necessary, at the Supplier's risk and expense and without prejudice to any other rights which the Procuring agency may have against the Supplier under the Contract.

### 16.Payment

- 16.1 The method and conditions of payment to be made to the Supplierunder this Contract shall be specified in SCC.
- 16.2The Supplier's request(s) for payment shall be made to the Procuring agency in writing, accompanied by an invoice describing, as appropriate, the Goods delivered and Services performed, and by documents submitted pursuant to GCC Clause 10, and uponful fillment of other obligations stipulated in the Contract.
- 16.3PaymentsshallbemadepromptlybytheProcuringagency,but in no case later than sixty (60) days after submission of an invoiceor claimby theSupplier.

16.4Thecurrency of paymentisPak. Rupees.

#### 17.Prices

17.1 PriceschargedbytheSupplierforGoodsdeliveredandServices performed under the Contract shall not vary from the prices quotedbytheSupplierinitsbid,withtheexceptionofanyprice adjustments authorized in SCC or in the Procuring agency's requestfor bid validityextension,asthecase may be.

### 18.ChangeOrders

- 18.1 TheProcuringagencymayatanytime,byawrittenordergiven totheSupplierpursuanttoGCCClause31,makechangeswithin thegeneralscope oftheContractinanyoneormoreofthe following:
  - (a) drawings, designs, or specifications, where Goodsto be furnished under the Contract are to be specifically manufactured for the Procuring agency;
  - (b) themethodof shipmentor packing;
  - (c) theplaceof delivery; and/or
  - (d) the Service stobe provided by the Supplier.
- 18.2Ifanysuchchangecausesanincreaseordecreaseinthecostof, or the time required for, the Supplier's performance of any provisionsunderthe Contract, an equitable adjustments hall be

madeintheContractPriceordeliveryschedule,orboth,andthe Contract shall accordingly be amended. Any claimsby the Supplierforadjustmentunderthisclausemustbeassertedwithin thirty(30) daysfromthedateoftheSupplier'sreceiptofthe Procuringagency'schangeorder.

# 19.Contract Amendments

19.1SubjecttoGCCClause18,novariationinormodificationofthe terms of the Contract shall be made except by written amendment signed bytheparties.

### 20.Assignment

20.1 The Suppliershall not assign, in whole or in part, it so bligations to perform under this Contract, except with the Procuring agency's prior written consent.

#### 21.Subcontracts

- 21.1 The Supplier shall not if ythe Procuring agency in writing of all subcontracts awarded under this Contract if not already specified in the bid. Such notification, in the original bid or later, shall not relieve the Supplier from any liability or obligation under the Contract.
- 21.2Subcontractsmustcomply withthe provisions of GCC Clause 3.

### 22.Delaysin the Supplier's Performance

- 22.1Delivery of the Goods and performance of Services shall be made by the Supplier in accordance with the time schedule prescribed by the Procuring agency in the Schedule of Requirements.
- 22.2If atany timeduringperformanceof theContract,the Supplieror itssubcontractor(s)shouldencounterconditionsimpedingtimely deliveryoftheGoodsandperformanceofServices,theSupplier shallpromptlynotifytheProcuringagencyinwritingofthefact ofthedelay,itslikelydurationand itscause(s). Assoonas practicableafterreceiptoftheSupplier'snotice,theProcuring agency shall evaluate the situation and may at its discretion extend the Supplier's time for performance, with or without liquidateddamages,inwhichcasetheextensionshallberatified bythepartiesby amendmentof Contract.
- 22.3Except as provided under GCC Clause 25, a delay by the Supplier in the performance of its delivery obligations shall renderthe Supplierliableto the imposition of liquidated damages pursuant to GCC Clause 23, unlessan extension of time is agreed upon pursuant to GCC Clause 22.2 without the application of liquidated damages.

### 23.Liquidated

23.1 Subject toGCC Clause25, if the Supplier fails to deliverany or

### **Damages**

allof theGoodsor to perform theServices withinthe period(s) specifiedinthe Contract, the Procuring agency shall, without prejudiceto itsotherremediesunder theContract,deductfrom theContractPrice,asliquidateddamages,a sumequivalentto thepercentage specifiedin SCC of the deliveredprice of the delayedGoodsor unperformedServicesfor eachweek or part thereofof delay untilactualdeliveryor performance,up maximumdeductionof thepercentage specifiedinSCC. Once themaximumisreached, the Procuring agency mayconsider termination of the Contract pursuant to GCC Clause 24.

# 24.Termination for Default

- 24.1TheProcuringagency,withoutprejudicetoanyotherremedyfor breach of Contract, by written notice of default sent to the Supplier,mayterminatethisContractin wholeor in part:
  - (a) ifthe Supplierfailstodeliverany or allof the Goods within the period(s) specified in the Contract, or within any extension thereof granted by the Procuring agency pursuant to GCC Clause 22; or
  - (b) if the Supplier fails to perform any other obligation(s) underthe Contract.
  - (c) ifthe Supplier, in the judgment of the Procuring agency has engaged incorruptor fraudulent practices in competing for in executing the Contract.

### Forthepurpose of this clause:

"corruptpractice" meanstheoffering, giving, receiving or soliciting of anything of value to influence the action of a public of ficial in the procurement processor in contract execution.

"fraudulentpractice" means a misrepresentation of facts in order to influence a procurement processor the execution of a contract to the detriment of the Borrower, and includes collusive practice among Bidders (prior to or after bid submission) designed to establish bid prices at artificial non-competitive levels and to deprive the Borrower of the benefits of free and open competition.

24.2Inthe eventtheProcuring agencyterminates the Contractin wholeorin part,pursuanttoGCCClause24.1,theProcuring agencymayprocure,uponsuchtermsandinsuchmannerasit deems appropriate, Goods or Services similar to those

undelivered, and the Supplier shall beliable to the Procuring agency for any excess costs for such similar Goods or Services. However, the Supplier shall continue performance of the Contract to the extent not terminated.

### 25.ForceMajeure

- 25.1 NotwithstandingtheprovisionsofGCCClauses22,23,and24, theSuppliershallnotbeliableforforfeitureofitsperformance security,liquidateddamages,orterminationfordefaultifandto the extent that its delay in performance or other failure to performitsobligationsunderthe Contract istheresultofan eventof Force Majeure.
- 25.2Forpurposesofthisclause, "ForceMajeure" means an event beyond the control of the Supplier and not involving the Supplier's faultornegligence and not foresee able. Such events may include, but are not restricted to, acts of the Procuring agency in its sovereign capacity, wars or revolutions, fires, floods, epidemics, quarantine restrictions, and freightem bargoes.
- 25.3IfaForceMajeuresituationarises,theSuppliershallpromptly notifytheProcuringagencyinwritingofsuchconditionandthe cause thereof. Unless otherwise directed by the Procuring agency in writing, the Supplier shall continue to perform its obligationsundertheContractasfarasis reasonablypractical, andshallseekallreasonablealternativemeansforperformance notpreventedby the ForceMajeure event.

# 26.Termination for Insolvency

26.1TheProcuringagencymayatanytimeterminatetheContractby giving writtennoticetotheSupplieriftheSupplierbecomes bankruptorotherwiseinsolvent. Inthisevent,terminationwill be without compensation to the Supplier, provided that such terminationwillnot prejudiceoraffectanyrightofactionor remedy which has accrued or will accrue thereafter to the Procuringagency.

### 27.Termination for Convenience

- 27.1TheProcuringagency, by writtennotices entto the Supplier, may terminate the Contract, in whole or in part, at any time for its convenience. The notice of terminations hall specify that termination is for the Procuringagency's convenience, the extent to which performance of the Supplier under the Contract is terminated, and the date upon which such termination becomes effective.
