Clause 1 The firm/contractor shall enclose the one original and two (2) copies of the documents in a sealed envelope which shall:-

- (b) be delivered by hand or through courier/registered mail to address mentioned in advertisement for pre-qualification or in document; and
- (c) be clearly marked "Application for Pre-qualification for "Remodeling of Kuka Link Bund Mile 0/0 to 20/6 & Restoration of Stone Apron and T-Head Spur along Surjani Complex".

Clause 2 If the envelope is not sealed and marked as required, the procuring agency will assume no responsibility for the misplacement or pre-maturing opening of the document.

Clause 3 Document shall be prepared in the English language. In case of ICB, the information provided in any other language shall be accompanied by English translation also.

Clause 4 Firm/Contractor must respond to all questions and provide complete information as advised in this document. Any lapses to provide essential information may result in dis-qualification of the firm/contractor.

1. **REQUIRED WORK**

1. Remodeling of Regulators of Gungri Large RD 20, Sujawal X-Regulator RD 90, Chahto X-Regulator RD 108

The Gungri Large Distry off takes from Munarki X-Regulator RD 125 having length 101 RDs and discharge 720 cusecs. The major work of Regulators of this system was not carried out after Super Flood 2010. The abutment, piers and slab were damaged badly at that time only the minor repair work was carried out.

At this stage so many cracks are appeared in piers of Regulators and pavement has been damaged significantly. To avoid any mishap, the PC-1 is prepared is the case with Sujawal X-Regulator RD 90 and Chahto Large RD 108 of Darro Branch.

2. Providing Gates X- Regulator Munarki at RD 125 of Darro Branch, Sattah Branch and X-Regulator off takes from Darro Branch

It is pertinent to mention here that the Gates / Regulators of (i) Munarki X-Regulator RD 125 of Darro Branch (ii) Sattah Branch and X-Regulator off takes from Darro Barnch are not in working condition and are required to be replaced / repaired so is to make regulation properly and to avoid any un towards situation.

3. Malia Branch Head Regulator RD 90 Of Pinyari Branch and Remodeling of Pinyari Branch RD 0 to 90

Furthermore Pinyari Branch which off takes from PFL RD 168 and total length is 196 RD's with a discharge of 4943 cusecs and having on sub division of Lower Pinyari Division Sujawal and a part of Darro Sub Division of Upper Pinyari Division (RD 0 to 50) and RD 50-90 up to Bhuddo X-Regulator.

Also Malia Branch off takes at RD 90 of Pinyari Branch, Bhuddo X-Regulator. During the Super Flood 2010 a breach was occurred @ Kotalmo with discharge 150000 cusecs caused many breaches in Pinyari Branch. Due to consequences of these breach the breach sites were weakened and water crossed the branch deeply eroding these locations. On the other hand it also flew in branch in both directions i-e upstream and downstream side. Thus huge silt was deposited in branch thus the width and depth of Pinyari branch from RD 0 to 90 were considerably reduced and also of prism of Pinyari Branch is badly affected. Therefore carrying capacity of Pinyari Branch and its off taking channels was reduced. Thus Malia Branch and D/S Mirkhana X-Regulator, Begnah X-Regulator are suffering badly.

4. C.C LINING ALONG FATEH WAH RD 3 TO 7 IN CITY AREA OF MIRPUR BATHORO

Fateh Wah off takes from tail of Gunj Bahar Branch and having discharge 375 cusecs is crossing through Mirpur Bathoro Town which is to be lined and to provide Stone Protection Wall to avoid untoward situation.
