- Clause 2 If the enveloped is not sealed and marked as required, the procuring agency will assume no responsibility for the misplacement or pre-maturing opening of the document.
- Clause 3 Documents shell be prepared in the English language. In case of ICB, the information provided in any other language shall be accompanied by English
- Clause 4 Firm/Contactor must respond to all questions and provide complete information as advised in the document. Any lapses to provide essential information may result any dis-qualification of the firm/contactor.
- Clause 5 Clarification and Modification of Documents (SSP Rule 23). Firm/Contractor, who has obtained documents, may request for clarification of contents for the bidding documents in writing, and respond to such queries shall. be made in writing within three calendar days, provided they are received at

least five calendar days prior to the date of opening of bid.

#### Clause 6 Addendum:

At any time prior to the dead line for submission of documents, the agency may arnend the Prequalification Document by issuing addenda. Any addendum issued shall be part of Prequalification Document and shall be communicated in writing to all who have obtained the prequalification document.

### Clause 7 Deadline for submission of documents (SPP Rule 22 & 24):

Documents shall be received by the Procurement Agency at the address mentioned in the NIT, not later than the date time mentioned in NIT. The procuring agency may, at its discretion, extend the deadline for the submission of documents by amending the Prequalification Document, and in which case all rights and obligations of the Agency and the firms/contractors subject to the previous deadline shall thereafter be subject to the deadline as extended.

#### Clause 8 Evaluation (Rule 27 (2):

Firm's/Contractor's general and particular experience, personnel and equipment capabilities, and financial position, as demonstrated by the Applicant's responses in the prescribed forms will be evaluated as per evaluation criteria given in the document. The Procuring Agency reserves the right to waive minor deviations, if these don't materially affect the capability of an applicant to perform the contract. Sub-contractor's experience and resources shall not be taken into account in determining the firm/contractor compliance with the qualifying criteria. However, Joint Venture experience resources shall be considered. Consortium or Association of firms will be considered for similar treatment as in case of Joint Venture.

However, If Firm/Contractors intends to subcontract any highly specialized elements of the Works to specialist subcontractor(s), such elements and the proposed specialist subcontractors) shall be clearly identified, and the experience and capacity of the specialist subcontractors) shall be described in the relevant Information Forms.

#### Clause 9 Clarification of Prequalification Information (Rule 43):

To assist in the evaluation of information, the agency may, at its discretion, ask any firm/contractor for a clarification of any information which shall be submitted within a stated reasonable period of time. Any request for clarification shall be in writing. If any firm/contractor does not provide clarifications of the information requested by the date and time set in the agency's request for clarification then application of the firm/contractor may be rejected.

### Clause 10 Verification of Prequalification Information (Rule 28 (Id)):

Verification of the information provided by the pre-qualified/ shortlisted firms/contractors in the submissions for prequalification may be made in Case the information is found to be wrong or incorrect in any material way Or firm/contractor is found to be lacking in the capability or resources to successfully perform the contract, then it shall not be pre-qualified.

## QUALIFICATION / EVALUATION REQUIRMENTS

This section contains the requirements that will be used to evaluate the pre-qualification documents of the bidders. The information to be provided in relation to each requirement and the definitions of the corresponding terms are included in the respective Bid Forms.

1.	Qualification Criteria

#### 1.1 .General

Evaluation will be based on all the criteria given in succeeding paras 1.1 to 1.7 regarding the Bidder's general and particular experience, personnel & equipment capabilities, and financial position, as demonstrated by the Bidder's responses in the forms provided under 'Application Forms'. The Employer reserves the right to waive minor deviations, if these don't materially affect the capability of a bidder to perform the contract.

#### Mandatory Requirement for Responsive Bids 1.2

The Bidder shall meet the following minimum criteria:

- a) Registration with PEC
  - Registration with Pakistan Engineering Council in Category C-3, C-2, C-1, C-B & C-A / CE-01 & CE-10.
- b) NTN (National Tax Number)
- C) Confl ct of Interest

d) Inelig bility

Not having been declared ineligible by the Employer

- e) Registration with Sindh Board of Revenue
- f) Historical Contract Non-Performance

The Bidder shall meet the following minimum criteria:

## (i) History of Non-Performing Contracts

Non-Performance of a contract did not occur within the last 5 years prior to the deadline for bid submission based on all information on fully settled disputes or litigation. A fully settled dispute or litigation is one that has been resolved in accordance with the Dispute Resolution Mechanism under the respective contract and where all appeal instances available to the bidder have been exhausted. The past performance of the bidder-on all-completed and ongoing projects also be checked in coordination with other executing agencies.

- (ii) Failure to Sign ContractNot being under execution of a Bid Securing Declaration for the last 5 years.
- (iii) Litigation History

All pending litigation shall in total not represent more than fifty (50) % of the Eidder's net worth and shall be treated as resolved against the bidder.

The Bidder should provide accurate information on any litigation or arbitration resulting from contracts completed or under execution over the last five years. A consistent history of award against the Applicant or any partner of a joint venture may result in rejection of the bid.

The Analysis of Litigation History

- The execution of any construction contract will normally result in the payment by the Employer of a number of reasonable claims from the Contractor, e.g. for defaults of the Engineer / Project Manager, delays, unforeseeable ground and climatic conditions, etc. However, some Contractors have an established business practice of bidding low to obtain award of contract; and then flooding the Employer with excessive or frivolous claims to increase their income. Employer should be on guard against any Contractor who habitually resorts to excessive claims, arbitration and litigation in the execution of contracts.
- Bidders with a consistent and significant history of excessive contract arbitrations and litigation resulting in awards or decisions against them should not be qualified to bid. Bidders should be required to list all contracts over a stated period of time (normally five years) that resulted in litigation or arbitration proceedings, with an indication of the matters and amounts in dispute, the parties involved and the resolution of the dispute.
- The criterion for rejection is that of numerous arbitral awards or court decisions against the Bidder in relation to awards for the Bidder, taking the number and amount of contracts executed. As an indicative example, the occurrence of one or two adverse cases over five years for a Contractor handling, on average, ten construction jobs simultaneously, should not be a cause for rejection. If dispute resolution is found relatively frequently in the business of the Bidder, it may indicate an attitude of the management of the firm that could be

dangerous for the Employer if the Bidder were awarded the contract, and further investigation with previous Employers may be warranted.

#### 1.3 | Finar cial Situation

The Applicant shall meet the following minimum criteria:

#### a) Financial Performance

The Bidder should demonstrate that he has access to, or has available liquid assets, un encumbered real assets, lines of credit and other financial means sufficient to meet the construction cash flow for the execution of works. Bidder's commitments for other ongoing contracts shall also be considered. [The duration for the ongoing contracts are calculated by allowing the time of construction from beginning of month Invoiced plus the time needed for the Engineer to certify the pay estimate plus the time needed by the Employer to pay the certified amount]

The audited balance sheets for the past five years should demonstrate the soundness of the Bidder's financial position, showing long term profitability. Where necessary, the Employer will make enquires with the Bidder's bankers.

The current soundness of the Bidder's financial position and its long terms pro-fitability will be evaluated on Average Net Working Capital and Average

#### b) Average Annual Construction Turnover

Minimum average annual construction turnover of Rs.400 Million, calculated as total certified payments received for contracts in progress or completed, within the last five (05) years.



1.4 Experience

The Application shall meet the following minimum criteria:

- a) General Construction Experience
  - Experience under construction contracts in the role of contractor, Subcontractor, or management contractor for at least the last five (05) years. Prior to the bid submission deadline, and with activity in at least nine (9) months in each year.
- b) Specific Construction Experience

Participation as contractor or subcontractor, in at least two (02) contracts within the last five (05) years, with a value of the largest work of at least amount as mentioned below, that have been successfully and substantially completed and that are similar to the proposed works. The similarity shall be based on the physical size, complexity, methods / technology or other characteristics.

Value of the largest similar work executed in last 5 years Rs. 288 million.

1.5 Personnel Capabilities

The Bidder must have in his employment suitably qualified personnel to fill the key management and specialist positions. The Bidder will supply information on a prime and an alternate condidate for each position (both should meet the specified experience
