MINUTES OF THE CDWP MEETING HELD ON 27-01-2015

Item 11(a): Up-gradation of Academic Facilities at Sindh Agriculture University Tandojam
(Total Cost Rs 876.093 million without FEC)


The Deputy Chief (S&T) stated that the project envisages rehabilitation of existing infrastructure, providing additional infrastructure & allied facilities and office equipment for sustained quality education. The project components included infrastructure development & rehabilitation, teaching & lab equipment, furniture & fixture, operational vehicles, project coordination staff, chemical & consumables and contingency. He said that the project was discussed in pre-CDWP and the sponsors were advised to rationalize civil works unit cost, delete the car from list of vehicles and provide long term vision of the university. He informed that the university has faculty strength of 255 of which 91 were PhD degree holders while 64 were enrolled in PhD programmes. He said that the PC-I contained KPIs formulated in desired manner.

2. The Chair observed that in education performance is based on merit principles, so there is need to sensitize educational institutions/universities on quality of education and merit enforcement. He directed the sponsors that proposed architecture of the University should be compatible with the old building.

3. The representative of the University assured that the building design would be kept compatible with the existing traditional structure. He also informed that that Tandojam University might be called a mini Pakistan as it had representation of students from all over the country including 20% from Balochistan province.

Decision:

4. The project was approved at a total cost of Rs 874.093 million without FEC after deleting cost of a car. The project implementation period would be 36 months.
