### 4.0 Section I. Instructions to Bidders/Applicants (ITB).

- Clause 1 The firm/contractor shall enclose the one original and two (2) copies of the documents in a sealed envelope which shall:-
  - (a) bear the name and address of the Applicant;
  - (b) be delivered by hand or through courier/registered mail to address mentioned in advertisement for pre-qualification or in document; and
  - (c) be clearly marked "Application for Pre-qualification for "Providing Stone Studs and Spurs along H.P Bund between Mile 3/0 to 14/7 and Recouping Stone Apron and Damaged Stone Pitching along H.P Bund (Various Reaches).
- Clause 2 If the envelope is not sealed and marked as required, the procuring agency will assume no responsibility for the misplacement or pre-maturing opening of the document.
- Clause 3 Document shall be prepared in the English language. In case of ICB, the information provided in any other language shall be accompanied by English translation also.
- Clause 4 Firm/Contractor must respond to all questions and provide complete information as advised in this document. Any lapses to provide essential information may result in dis-qualification of the firm/contractor.

### Clause 5 Clarification and Modification of Documents (SPP Rule 23).

Firm/Contractor, who has obtained documents, may request for clarification of contents of the bidding document in writing, and respond to such queries shall be made in writing within three calendar days, provided they are received at least five calendar days prior to the date of opening of bid.

#### Clause 6 Addendum:

At any time prior to the deadline for submission of documents, the agency may amend the Prequalification Document by issuing addenda. Any addendum issued shall be part of the Prequalification Document and shall be communicated in writing to all who have obtained the prequalification document.

### Clause 7 Deadline for submission of Documents (SPP Rule 22 & 24):

Documents shall be received by the agency at the address (mention the address & telephone & fax numbers), not later than the (mention the date & time). The procuring agency may, at its discretion, extend the deadline for the submission of documents by amending the Prequalification Document, and in which case all rights and obligations of the Agency and the firms/contractors subject to the previous deadline shall thereafter be subject to the deadline as extended

### Clause 8 Evaluation (Rule 27 (2):

Firm's/Contractor's general and particular experience, personnel and equipment capabilities, and financial position, as demonstrated by the Applicant's responses in the prescribed forms will be evaluated as per evaluation criteria given in the document. The Procuring Agency reserves the right to waive minor deviations, if these don't materially affect the capability of an applicant to perform the contract. Subcontractor's experience and resources shall not be taken into account in determining the firm/contractor compliance with the qualifying criteria. However, Joint Venture experience & resources shall be considered. Consortium or Association of firms will be considered for similar treatment as in case of Joint Venture.

### Clause 9 Clarification of Prequalification Information (Rule 43):

To assist in the evaluation of information, the agency may, at its discretion, ask any firm/contractor for a clarification of any information which shall be submitted within a stated reasonable period of time. Any request for clarification shall be in writing. If any firm/contractor does not provide clarifications of the information requested by the date and time set in the agency's request for clarification then application of the firm/contractor may be rejected.

### Clause 10 Verification of Prequalification Information (Rule 28 (1d)):

Verification of the information provided by the pre-qualified/shortlisted firms/contractors in the submissions for prequalification may be made. In case the information is found to be wrong or incorrect in any material way or firm/contractor is found to be lacking in the capability or resources to successfully perform the contract, then it shall not be pre-qualified.

#### REQUIRED WORKS.

PROVIDING STONE STUDS AND SPURS ALONG H.P. BUND BETWEEN MILE 3/0 TO 14/7 AND RECOUPING STONE APRON AND STONE PITCHING ALONG H.P. BUND (VARIOUS REACHES)

It has been observed that the river current has remained very active during current high flood 2015 and river water travelling very near to bund at Mle 5/2 to 6/6. This portion of bund is very close to Katair town and other towns and villages along infrastructure which consisting of lacs population along with surrounding villages. During flood 2015 the People were in fear looking to the pressure of flood water and safeguard the lives and assets of people from upcoming floods. It is very necessary to divert flow by constructing 2 Nos T-Head Spurs and 10 Nos. Studs from Mile 3/0 to 14/7. This will safeguard the vast area from Katair to Badin from the catastrophic effect of any mishap at this location.

It may pointed out here that due to heavy pressure of water during last floods including flood 2015 and due to heavy rainfall Stone Apron and Stone Pitching was clamaged and launched at various reaches of H.P. Bund which needs to be recouped and restored to its design section.

The I.R.C. Proposals for Providing Stone Studs and Stone Spurs along H.P.Bund between Mile 3/0 to 14/7 and Recouping Stone Apron and Damaged Stone Pitching along H.P. Bund (Various Reaches) were approved in the 177th of Full Committee meeting held on 30-09-2015.
