- iv. Since NIT-7 consists upon different works at Karachi, Nooriabad, Hyderabad, Mirpurkhas and Shaheed Benazirabad, The Executive Director-I signed the documents for Karachi (7.1, 7.2, 7.3 under NIT-7) and Executive Director (Operation-III) signed the documents for Nooriabad, Hyderabad, Mirpurkhas and Shaheed Benazirabad (7.4,7.5,7.6 and 7.7 under NIT-7).
