Subject: **No. SSWMB/NIT-8, 9 & SSWMB/Re-NIT-7/2016-17**
Dated 28-02-2017 (Serial No. 31905)

Reference: Letter No. A.D(ASMT)/SPPRA/31905/2017/1181 dated 10th March 2017

With reference to your letter on the subject cited above, following Para-wise clarifications / replies of the observations are submitted for consideration as under:-

1. RFP for 7 (seven) different feasibility studies from Consulting Firms were invited through SSWMB/NIT-7 under SPPRA Serial No. 31165 and each of the seven feasibility studies was assigned separate reference Nos. 7.1 to 7.7. Not only the subject and scope of the feasibility study but even the location is different. Accordingly the RFP document and TOR were prepared separately for each feasibility study. On day of opening i.e. 24th January 2017, RFPs from Consulting Firms were received only for NIT No. 7.1, 7.2, 7.3 & 7.7. No RFPs were received from any Consulting Firms for NIT No. 7.4, 7.5 & 7.6 hence these were re-invited with same reference number.

2. The SSWMB/NIT-8 is for five different consultancy service works. Each of the five 'Consultancy Services' was assigned separate reference Nos. 8.1 to 8.5 with submission date of 15th March 2017. Due to poor response the schedule was revised and submission date was extended to 27th March 2017. NIT-8.3 and 8.4 were opened as per schedule. However, there was very low / no response from consulting firms for works 8.1, 8.2 and 8.5 hence we were left with no option but to again revise the schedule and extend the date for opening up to 5th April 2017. Not only the subject and scope of the each 'Consultancy Services' but even the location is different. Accordingly the RFP document and TOR were also prepared separately for each 'Consultancy Services'.

3. The SSWMB under NIT-9 invited the two different works/services, for lifting of Garbage from GTS East/Korangi/Malir to Landfill Site under NIT reference No. 9.1 and lifting of Garbage from GTS South/West/Central to Landfill Site under NIT reference No. 9.2 with submission date of 15th March 2017. However the bidders raised genuine objection that the tender should be separate for each district because the distance from GTS of different districts to Landfill sites is different. Moreover, some infirmities were also noticed in the bidding document hence the tender was cancelled. Fresh tender NIT-9.1 & 9.2 with corrected bidding document for lifting of Garbage from GTS of DMC South & East (which are being taken over by SSWMB) to Landfill Site was issued.

4. Hope with above clarifications, infirmities pointed out by SPPRA stand settled.
