The participants of the meeting were informed that Request for Proposals (RFP) for Hiring of firm for Recruitment & Selection of Employee was published on 1st March, 2017 in newspapers and Technical Proposals on RFP document was opened on 21st March 2017. Only Three firms submitted their proposals 1) M/s. UHY Hassan Naeem & Co., 2) M/s. Pakistan Testing Services (PTS) & 3) M/s. National Testing Services, Pakistan (NTS).

The Consultant Selection Committee reviewed the Eligibility Evaluation Sheet other than Experience which was prepared by Procurement Department. Only two firms M/s. UHY Hassan Naeem & Co. and M/s. National Testing Services, Pakistan (NTS) were found eligible for Technical Evaluation, while one firm M/s. Pakistan Testing Services (PTS) was found not eligible due to short experience of providing services of Recruitment & Selection. The members of the Consultant Selection Committee and co-opt member of the Committee evaluated the Technical Proposals and decided to open Financial Proposals of the qualified firms i.e. M/s. UHY Hassan Naeem & Co. and M/s. National Testing Services, Pakistan (NTS) and permitted procuring agency to proceed further in the matter.
