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

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

5. The bids were lateron sent to the concerned Consultants as per ToR for detailed evaluation in accordance with SPPRA Rules, 2010 and procedure provided in instruction to bidders.

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6. M/s. EA Consulting (Pvt) Limited, the Consultants for scheme of Phase-I have furnished Bid Evaluation Report vide letter No.EA/H/768/2285/13 dated: 22.11.2013 wherein the bid price of lowest bidder as compared with Engineer's Estimate has been calculated as under:-

7. The Consultants have therefore recommended as under :-

Since, the price quoted by the lowest bidder is 36% above the Engineer's Estimate and also higher than the already awarded contracts, it seems that the rates quoted are still higher, even if the escalation or increase in market rates during one year is kept in consideration therefore :-

- The bids of both the bidders may be rejected in accordance with NIT para No.8, Instructions to Bidders Clause No.30 and SPPRA Rule-25.
- The bidding process may be annulled in accordance with NIT para-8, Instructions to Bidders Clause-30 and SPPRA Rule-25 and
- Fresh bidding process may be undertaken in accordance with SPPRA Rule-26.

8. This Bid Evaluation Report alongwith Consultants recommendations was placed before the Procurement Committee in its meeting held on 27.11.2013 in the Committee Room of Sindh Coal Authority chaired by Additional Secretary, Coal Energy Department. The Committee reviewed the Bid Evaluation Report and by discussing the same in detail found Evaluation Report in order and satisfactory as per SPPRA Rules and endorsed the recommendations of the Consultants for rejection as the rates quoted by the lowest bidder are still higher than the Engineer's Estimate previously received rates and already awarded contracts even if variation / escalation in market prices is kept in view.


9. Looking to the recommendations of Procurement Committee and keeping in consideration the high rates, which are much beyond the Engineer's Estimates viz. 36% above quoted by the lowest bidder M/s. Maqbool Associates (Pvt) Limited (refer page-12 of Bid Evaluation Report), it is requested that the bidding process may be annulled and lowest quoted rates may be rejected in the best interest of public work.

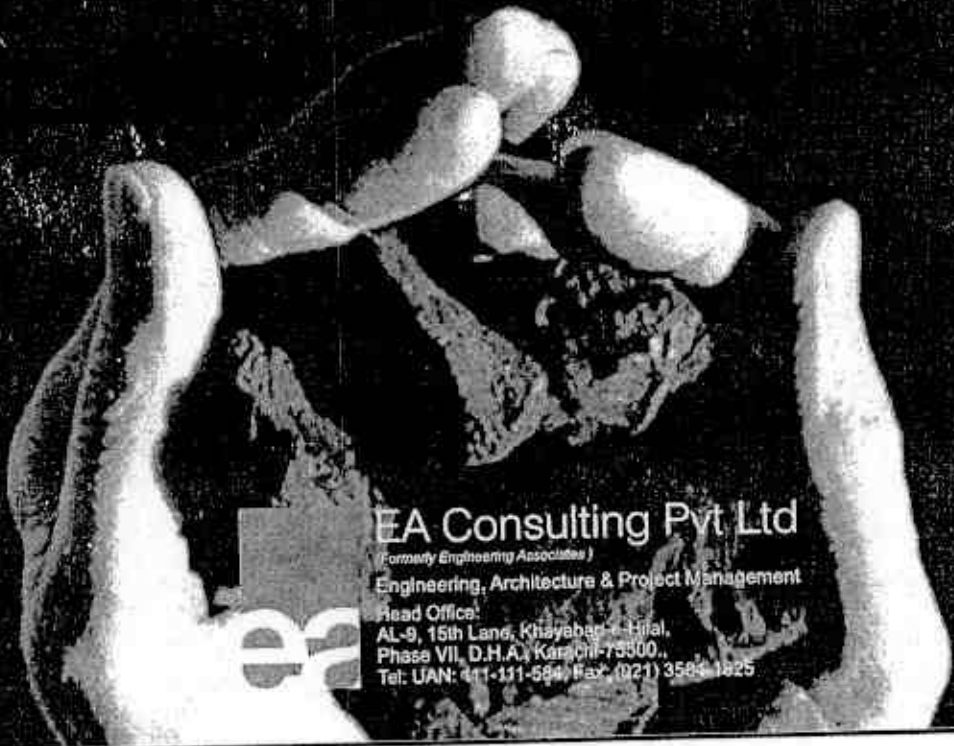

1. **GENERAL:**

1.1 ***Introduction***

This report covers the evaluation and recommendations in respect of the bids opened on November 7th, 2013 for the following contract package:-

Project Name:

Improvement of Road Network from Thatta to Wango Mor via Sujawal, Badin with Construction of (05) Bypasses, Rehabilitation of Damaged Road Portions and Rehabilitation / Reconstruction of Structures (Phase-1, 176 Kms)

Contract Package:

Construction of Sujawal Bypasses (Length 8 Kms), Contract Package No: SCA/Phase 1/CP-V

Bids for the above contract package were invited from the pre-qualified bidders only. It is to be noted that first time the bids for this contract package were invited on 28th August and received / opened on 17th September 2013. However, due to high Bid Prices quoted by the bidders, same was cancelled and fresh bids were re-invited on 21st October, 2013.

1.2 ***Scope of Work***

The above-mentioned contract package consists of construction of bypasses (length 8 Kms).

1.3 ***Methodology***

Bid evaluation has been carried out in accordance with the SPPRA Rules and Instructions to Bidders contained in the bidding document. The report is divided in to '5' sections namely:-

Section - 1:	General
Section - 2:	Bidding Process
Section - 3:	Preliminary Evaluation
Section - 4:	Detailed Evaluation
Section - 5:	Summary and Recommendations

2. THE BIDDING PROCESS

2.1 *Invitation of Bids*

The Sindh Coal Authority (SCA) invited bids from eleven (11) pre-qualified bidders through letters dated October 21st, 2013.

During the bidding period, no queries were raised by the bidders in writing. The pre-bid meeting was held in the conference room of SCA on October 31st, 2013 at 1200hrs, wherein all the queries/questions of bidders were replied and Minutes of Pre-Bid meeting were issued as Addendum No.1.

2.2 *Submissions of Bids*

The procedure for the Submission of Bids is provided in IB Clause 19 which states

Quote

"19.1 Each bidder shall submit his bid as under:

- (a) ORIGINAL and 1 COPIES of the bid shall be separately sealed and put in separate envelopes and marked as such.*
- (b) The envelopes containing the ORIGINAL and COPIES shall be put in one sealed envelope and addressed as given in sub - clause IB 19.2 hereof.*

19.2 The inner and outer envelopes shall:

- (a) be addressed to the procuring agency at the address provided in the bidding data;*
- (b) bear the name and identification number of the contract as defined in the bidding data; and*
- (c) provide a warning not to open before the time and date for bid opening, as specified in the bidding data.*

19.3 In addition to the identification required in sub- clause IB 19.2 hereof, the inner envelope shall indicate the name and postal address of the bidder to enable the bid to be returned unopened in case it is declared "late" pursuant to Clause IB.21

19.4 If the outer envelope is not sealed and marked as above, the procuring agency will assume no responsibility for the misplacement or premature opening of the Bid." Un-quote

2.3 *Deadline for Submissions of Bids*

IB Clause 20 and 21 states

Quote

"20.1 (a) Bids must be received by the procuring agency at the address specified not later than the time and date stipulated in the bidding data,

- (b) *Bids with charges payable will not be accepted, nor will arrangements be undertaken to collect the bids from any delivery point other than that specified above. Bidders shall bear all expenses incurred in the preparation and delivery of bids. No claims shall be entertained for refund of such expenses,*
- (c) *Where delivery of a bid is by mail and the bidder wishes to receive an acknowledgment of receipt of such bid, he shall make a request for such acknowledgment in a separate letter attached to but not included in the sealed bid package,*
- (d) *Upon request, acknowledgment of receipt of bids will be provided to those making delivery in person or by messenger.*

20.2 *The Procuring Agency may, at its discretion, extend the deadline for submission of bids by issuing an amendment in accordance with IB 09. In such case, all rights and obligations of the procuring agency and the bidders shall remain the same as mentioned in the original deadline.*

IB.21 Late Bids

- (a) *any bid received by the procuring agency after the deadline for submission of bids prescribed in to clause IB 20 shall be returned unopened to such bidder.*
- (b) *delays in the mail, person in transit, or delivery of a bid to the wrong office shall not be accepted as an excuse for failure to deliver a bid at the proper place and time. It shall be the bidder's responsibility to submit the bid in time." Un-quote*

Out of eleven (11) prequalified bidders, following three (03) bidders purchased the bidding documents.

- i) M/s Zarghoon Enterprises (Pvt.) Ltd
- ii) M/s Rakhshani Builders (Pvt.) Limited
- iii) M/s Maqbool Associates (Pvt.) Limited

It is interesting to note that the same three bidders participated in the bidding process, which was cancelled due to high rates/prices quoted by the bidders.

The submission of bids was November 07, 2013 at 1400 hrs by which only two bids out of three (03) were received by that time.

2.4 Opening of Bids

The procedure for the opening of bids is provided in IB Clause 23 which states

Quote

- 23.1 Procuring agency will open the bids, including withdrawals, substitution and modifications made pursuant to Clause IB.22, in the presence of bidders' representatives who choose to attend, at the time, date and location stipulated in the bidding data. The bidders or their representatives who are in attendance shall sign an attendance sheet.
- 23.2 Envelopes marked "MODIFICATION", "SUBSTITUTION" or "WITHDRAWAL" shall be opened and read out first. Bids for which an acceptable notice of withdrawal has been submitted pursuant to clause IB.22 shall not be opened.
- 23.3 Procuring agency shall read aloud the name of the bidder, total bid price and price of any Alternate Proposal(s), if any, discounts, bid modifications, substitution and withdrawals, the presence or absence of bid security, and such other details as the procuring agency may consider appropriate, and total amount of each bid, and of any alternative bids if they have been requested or permitted, shall be read aloud and recorded when opened.
- 23.4 Procuring Agency shall prepare minutes of the bid opening, including the information disclosed to those present in accordance with the sub-clause IB.23.3." Un-quote

The bids were opened by the Procurement Committee constituted by SGA & CD, GoS in accordance with SPPRA Rules, comprising:

 - ii. Chief Engineer, Sindh Coal Authority, Karachi
 - iii. The Superintending Engineer, Sindh Coal Authority, Karachi

 - v. Mr. Ahmed Ali, Executive Engineer, Provincial Buildings Division-II, Karachi
 - vi. The Executive Engineer-I, Sindh Coal Authority, Karachi
 - vii. The Divisional Accounts Officer, Sindh Coal Authority, Karachi
- Co-opted members:
- viii. The Engineer, (Team Leader), M/s. EA Consulting (Pvt.) Ltd
 - ix. The Contract/Procurement Engineer, M/s. EA Consulting (Pvt.) Ltd

Total two bids were received for this Contract Package.

In accordance with the Bidding procedure, an attendance register was signed by all the Bidder's representatives, and the members of the Bid Opening Committee. The whole record is kept in the office of SCA.

Total two bids were received for this Contract Package and Bids of these two bidders were opened and their bid price was read out strictly in accordance with the procedure laid down in Instruction to Bidders. The two bidders are:

As stated in article 2.3 above, the bid price quoted by these bidders earlier, which was cancelled due to high rates/prices, was:

This comparison is clearly showing the margin of profit built by the bidders in their quoted rates/prices.

Nevertheless, the two bids were handed over to the Consultant for evaluation and preparation of Bid Evaluation Report in accordance with the terms of services of the Consultants.

3. EXAMINATION & RESPONSIVENESS STUDY OF BIDS

3.1 Examination of Bids

The examination of the bids was carried out in accordance with IB Clause 26.1 which states

Quote

"Prior to the detailed evaluation of bids, the procuring agency will determine whether the bidder fulfils all codal requirements of eligibility criteria given in the tender notice such as registration with tax authorities, registration with PEC (where applicable), turnover statement, experience statement, and any other condition mentioned in the NIT and bidding document. If the bidder does not fulfill any of these conditions, it shall not be evaluated further to determine whether they were complete in order to assess their responsiveness." Un-Quote

The codal requirements provided in the bidding document are:

Quote

"11.1 (a) submit a written authorization on the letterhead of the bidding firm, authorizing the signatory of the bid to act for and on behalf of the bidder;

- (b) Prequalification Information to be updated:
- Annual Construction Turn Over
 - Access to Financial Resources
 - Financial Soundness

- Financial predictions for the current year and the following two years including the effect of known commitments
- Work commitments since prequalification
- Current litigation information
- Historic non-performance

Above stated information should be provided in forms provided in the bidding document for this purpose along with supporting documents

And

- (c) *furnish a technical proposal taking into account the various Appendices to Bid specially the following;*

Appendix-E to Bid Proposed Construction Schedule

Appendix-F to Bid Method of Performing the Work

Appendix-G to Bid List of Major Equipment

Appendix-K to Bid Organization Chart for Supervisory Staff

and other pertinent information such as mobilization programme etc," Un-
quote

At this stage of evaluation following documents were examined for completeness:

- i) Equipment Availability provided
- j) Work Schedule Provided
- k) Method Statement Provided
- l) Safety Plan Provided
- m) Site Facilities provided
- n) Organization Chart Provided

3.2 Responsiveness Study

The responsiveness or otherwise of the Bids is determined on the basis of Clause IB-26.2 of Instructions to Bidders. Sub-clause 26.2 of IB provides:

Quote

"26.2. Once found to be fulfilling the eligibility criteria, as mentioned in sub-clause 26.1, the bids of eligible bidders will be evaluated for technical responsiveness as per specification and criteria given in the bidding documents....." Un-quote

IB Clause 26.3 states the criteria of responsiveness

Quote

"A bid will be considered technically responsive if it (i) has been properly signed; (ii) is accompanied by the required bid security; and (iii) conforms to all the terms, conditions and specifications of the bidding documents, without material deviation or reservation. A material deviation or reservation is one (i) which affect in any substantial way the scope, quality or performance of the works; (ii) which limits in any substantial way, inconsistent with the bidding documents, the procuring agency's rights or the bidder's obligations under the contract; or (iii) adoption/rectification whereof would affect unfairly the competitive position of other bidders presenting substantially responsive bids" Unquote

For the responsiveness study following were examined, reviewed and evaluated:

- a) Validity of PEC registration certificate
- b) Annual Construction Turn Over
- c) Net Worth and Net Working Capital
- d) Cash Flow
- e) Minimum equipment requirement
- f) Work Schedule
- g) Method Statement
- h) Organization Chart

Based on the standard procedures, Check lists have been prepared, one for each of the bidders, for the documents submitted by them. The results of responsiveness study are summarized in below table:

Above table shows minor deficiency in the bids submitted by the bidders. However, to declare the bids responsive or otherwise, the Instruction to Bidders Clause IB 26.4 was studied which states

Quote

"If a bid has major deviations to the commercial requirements and technical specifications will be considered technically non responsive. As a general rule, major deviations are those that if accepted, would not fulfil the purposes for which the bid is requested, or would prevent a fair comparison or affect the ranking of the bids that are compliant with the bidding documents.

(A). Major (material) Deviations include:-

- (i) *has been not properly signed;*
- (ii) *is not accompanied by the bid security of required amount and manner;*
- (iii) *stipulating price adjustment when fixed price bids were called for;*
- (iv) *failing to respond to specifications;*
- (v) *failing to comply with Mile-stones/ Critical dates provided in Bidding Documents;*
- (vi) *sub-contracting contrary to the Conditions of Contract specified in Bidding Documents;*
- (vii) *refusing to bear important responsibilities and liabilities allocated in the Bidding Documents, such as performance guarantees and insurance coverage;*
- (viii) *taking exception to critical provisions such as applicable law, taxes and duties and dispute resolution procedures;*
- (ix) *a material deviation or reservation is one :*
 - (a) *which affect in any substantial way the scope, quality or performance of the works;*
 - (b) *adoption/rectification whereof would affect unfairly the competitive position of other bidders presenting substantially responsive bids.*

(B) Minor Deviations

Bids that offer deviations acceptable to the Procuring Agency and which can be assigned a monetary value may be considered substantially responsive at least as to the issue of fairness. This value would however be added as an adjustment for evaluation purposes only during the detailed evaluation process." Un-quote

Based on above evaluation and in light of Clause IB 26.4, assessment of the responsiveness of each of the bids received is as follows:

3.3 Conclusion

It was concluded by the Consultants that further detailed evaluation shall be carried out of two bidders having submitted Responsive and/or substantially responsive bids.

4. DETAILED EVALUATION

4.1 Introduction

This section of the report presents the detailed evaluation of bids to determine the corrected bid prices through arithmetic check. Because of the excessive variations in prices evidenced in the evaluation of bids, a general comparison is considered useful for guidance and reference purposes. Result of this general comparison, aimed at highlighting relative variations between individual bidder's prices as well as relative to the Engineer's estimates, is offered in the ensuing Section 4.3.

4.2 *Arithmetical Check of Responsive Bids*

Bids have been checked for arithmetic errors and rectified on the basis of Clause ITB 27 of Instructions to Bidders, which provides:

Quote

** 27.1 "Bids determined to be substantially responsive will be checked by the procuring agency for any arithmetic errors. Errors will be corrected by the procuring agency as follows:*

- (a) where there is a discrepancy between the amounts in figures and in words, the amount in words will govern; and*
- (b) where there is a discrepancy between the unit rate and the line item total resulting from multiplying the unit rate by the quantity, the unit rate as quoted will govern, unless in the opinion of the procuring agency there is an obviously gross misplacement of the decimal point in the unit rate, in which case the line item total as quoted will govern, and the unit rate will be corrected.*

27.2 The amount stated in the Bid will be adjusted by the procuring agency in accordance with the above procedure for the correction of errors and, with the concurrence of the bidder. The amount thus corrected shall be considered as binding upon the bidder. If the bidder does not accept the corrected bid price, his bid will be rejected, and the bid security shall be forfeited in accordance with Sub-Clause 15.6(b) hereof." Un-Quote

An arithmetical check of the Bidders' BOQ has been carried out and prices corrected in accordance with the procedure provided in IB Clause 27 above. The results are attached at the end of this report.

4.3 Evaluation of Bids

The evaluation of bids has been carried out in accordance with Clause IB 28 of Instruction to Bidders, which provides;

Quote

"28.1 The procuring agency will evaluate and compare only the Bids determined to be substantially responsive in accordance with clause IB 26.

28.2 In evaluating the Bids, the procuring agency will determine for each bid the evaluated bid price by adjusting the bid price as follows:

- (a) making any correction for errors pursuant to clause IB 27;
- (b) excluding provisional sums (if any), for contingencies in the Summary Bill of Quantities, but including competitively priced Day work; and
- (c) making an appropriate adjustment for any other acceptable variation or deviation." Un-Quote

The detailed evaluation of all bids is placed at Table 4.1 and 4.2 and the resulting corrected bid price of each bidder for this contract package thereby emerge out as follows;

The evaluation of bids carried out on above parameters has caused no change to the ranking of the lowest bidder.

4.4 Comparison of Bids

4.4.1 General Price Comparison

A general Price comparison is undertaken based on corrected prices exhibited in the preceding section. Bidder's price variations are calculated relative to the Engineer's Estimate.

The comparison is illustrated in Tables 4.1 for assessment of Price distribution and variation trends.

4.4.2 Item-wise Comparison of BOQ Prices

Table 4.2 list the variation of corrected prices of all the bidders (Responsive/Substantially Responsive) from the Engineer's Estimate.

The Findings are as follows:

4.5 Comparison of Significant Pay Items

Comparison of significant works items included in the BOQ is given in Table 4.3. Table 4.3 shows the trend in pricing the rates of significant items.

It is noted that the bidders have quoted the rates irrespective of requirement of specifications and are exorbitantly high.

5. SUMMARY AND RECOMMENDATIONS:

5.1 *General*

Bids were received and opened on November 7th, 2013. Two (02) Bidders submitted the bids. The bid evaluation has been carried out in accordance with SPPRA Rules and procedure provided in Instructions to Bidders. Following the examination and responsiveness study, both the bids were found complete and substantially responsive with some minor deficiencies and deviations noted in the evaluation summary (see section 3.1 above), however, no major deviation was found.

5.2 *Summary of Detailed Evaluation*

The comparison of bid prices of two bidders who quoted the rates with Engineer's Estimate is presented in section 4.4 above. M/s Maqbool Associates (Pvt.) Limited bid is found the lowest. The final price of Maqbool Associates (Pvt.) Limited is as under:

Contract Package V Rs. 778,841,762
(36% above the Engineer's Estimate)

5.3 *Recommendations By the Consultants*


On the basis of examination of the terms and conditions of the Bidding Documents, considering effect of labour & fuel escalation which is not reimbursable to the successful bidder as per the Conditions of Contract, non payable items of engineer's facilities, the evaluation of bids has been carried out by the Consultants.

Since the price quoted by the lowest bidder is 36% above the Engineer's Estimate and already awarded contracts, it seems that the rates quoted are much higher, even if the escalation or increase in market rates during one year is kept in consideration. The Consultants therefore recommend in public interest that:

- a. the bids of both the bidders may be rejected in accordance with NIT para no 8, Instructions to Bidders Clause No 30 and SPPRA Rule 25;
- b. the bidding process may be annulled in accordance with NIT para no 8, Instructions to Bidders Clause No 30 and SPPRA Rule 25; and
- c. fresh bidding process may be undertaken in accordance with SPPRA Rule 26.

5.4 Submission By the Consultants

The Bid Evaluation Report is being submitted to Procurement Committee for review, consideration and approval please.


