- All information concerning IBA which is provided to the JBL and vice versa in connection with this Agreement ("Confidential Information"), will be kept confidential by either Party, its affiliates, agents, advisors, directors, officers, or employees and, without the prior written consent of the other, each shall not:
 - (i) distribute or disclose any of the Confidential Information in any manner;
 - (ii) permit any third party access to the Confidential Information; and
 - (iii) Use the Confidential Information for any purpose other than as agreed in writing by the Party providing the information.



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
