1. INTRODUCTION

1.1 Introduction

Pakistan experienced extensive monsoon rains in July-August 2010, which generated unprecedented flood flows in primary, secondary and other rivers including hill torrents and local nullahs. Rivers Swat, Panjkhora and Kabul experienced historic flood flows, which crossed the historic flood peaks. The floods caused huge damages to private and public infrastructure including irrigation networks and flood protection works across Pakistan. The flood damages to the irrigation and drainage infrastructure are estimated at Rs 23,600 million.

In Sindh, four breaches in flood protection embankments, Left Marginal Bund of Guddu Barrage and Tori, MS and PB Bunds, caused main damages. The Tori Bund breach had inundated entire North West Canal command area and damaged much of the infrastructure on its way back to the Indus River.

1.2 Project Description

In response to flood damage recovery and reconstruction interventions, Asian Development Bank (ADB) through its emergency loan i.e. 2742/ 2743 (PAK) SF: Flood Emergency Reconstruction Project (FERP), has committed to support the ongoing efforts of the Government of Pakistan (GOP) for reconstruction of irrigation, drainage and flood protection infrastructure in Sindh Province. "Construction of Stone Pitching/Apron along Jamshoro Front Bund Mile 0/0 to 0/2+300 & Mile 0/2+450 to 3/0 and Repair of Studs (3 Nos.) along Mile 2/4" (the Project) is one of several sub projects being Financed under ADB's FERP Irrigation Sector support.

(a) Location and Access

The work site (Jamshoro Front Bund, Phulleli Canal Division) is situated in District Hyderabad on the S-W of Hyderabad City, at a driving distance of about 4 Km, and easily accessible through dual carriageway. The nearest towns to the site include Hussain Ahad and Kotri.

(b) Works under the Contract

Works under the contract includes Earth work, Formation and dressing and preparation of sub-grade on slope, Stone filling dry

hand packed as filling behind retaining walls or in pitching and aprons and Stone pitching

1.3 Bidding Document and Post-Qualification

The Contract is National Competitive Bidding (NCB) conducted in accordance with ADB's "Single-Stage Two-Envelope" Post-Qualification Bidding Procedures.

1.4 Invitation for Bid

The Invitation for Bids was advertised on 19 Nov. 2011 issues of two local newspapers. Copy is available at **Appendix 2**. The Bidding Documents were ready for issuance from 19 Nov, 2011. In total thirteen (13) firms purchased the Bidding Documents.

Initially it was envisaged that PMU-FERP Hyderabad, would receive/evaluate bids and accordingly NIT was published. However in the later stage Sindh Irrigation Department (SID) decided that all procurement for civil works under ADB's FERP-Irrigation Sector Support shall be initiated, received and evaluated at regional office by the concerned Executive Engineers. This change in procurement process through a Corrigendum dated November 2011 was published in the news paper (copy attached as **Appendix 2.1**). The Corrigendum was issued to all firms who purchased the bidding documents.

1.5 Submission of Bids

Receipt of bids by the Procurement Committee at Phulleli Canal Division Badin closed at 11:30 AM local time on 7 December 2011 as scheduled. Out of thirteen (13) firms who purchased the bidding documents, following Eight (8) bidders submitted bids.

1.6 Technical Proposals Opening

Technical Proposals were opened at 12:30 hours on 7 December 2011 in Phulleli Canal Division Badin by the Procurement Committee in the presence of representatives of bidders and Price Proposals kept unopened in safe custody. The bidders' names, the presence or absence of bid security and its amount were announced and recorded. The Record of Bid Opening (Technical Proposals) was prepared soon after these bids were announced and a copy of the Record of Bid Opening (Technical Proposals) was faxed to the ADB. A copy of the proceedings of the Technical Proposals Opening is attached as **Appendix 3**.

Basic information pertaining to the bidding has been summarized and is presented in start of the report as Appendix 1.

A Bid Evaluation Committee comprising six senior officers was established by the competent authority. Assistance was provided by the staff of the Project Management Consultants (PMC). The Bid Evaluation Committee members were:

**2. EXAMINATION

2.1 Bid Documents

The Technical Proposals submitted were first examined to check whether the bidders had submitted all the documents and information required by the bidding documents. The areas covered by the examination were:

- (i) Form of Bid ;
- (ii) Bid Security;
- (iii) Schedules of Particular Information;
- (iv) Joint Venture Agreement, if required;
- (v) Propriety of Signature and Power of Attorney;
- (vi) Completeness;
- (vii) Documents establishing the eligibility of bidders; and
- (viii) Documents required to assess the post-qualification of bidders.

The record of checking for completeness of bid documents is attached as **Appendix 4**.

2.2 Propriety of Signature and Power of Attorney

Results of these examinations are shown in **Appendix 4**.

2.3 Bid Security and Bid Validity

Examination of Bid Security along with Bid Validity as per requirement of bidding documents is stipulated in Scrutiny of Bid Securities attached as **Appendix 4.1**.

2.4 Examination of Completeness of Bids

In total eight (08) bids were received, where only two (2) bids were found as complete bids.

After opening of the bids it was revealed that:

- a. four (4) bidders have submitted Technical Bid and Price Bid together in one envelope which is not in compliance to the requirements of the bid documents (ITB 25.1, Section 1 of the Bid Document); and
- b. two (2) bidders have submitted bid with bid security less than the requirements, and are hence not substantially compliant bid securities in accordance with ITB 19.3, Section 1 of the Bid Document).

After the detailed examination of completeness of bids (see Appendix 4),

six (6) bids were declared as non-responsive by the Procurement Committee. It was agreed that only two (2) bids, which are Complete Bids shall be considered further for determination of substantive responsiveness.

personnel in accordance with their respective Site Organization, Mobilization Schedule and Construction Schedule, which suit to the Work for its smooth and timely completion.

3.2.2 Equipment

Both the bidders submitted information on their Equipment which indicated that they have the capacity to mobilize key equipment in accordance with their respective Method Statement, Mobilization Schedule and Construction Schedule, which suit to the Work for its smooth and timely completion.

3.2.3 Site Organization

Site organizations proposed by both the bidders indicate that they are conversant with site conditions besides volume and extent of Work to execute it smoothly.

3.2.4 Method Statement

Both the Bidders have submitted clear Method statements, thus found competent to handle the Work execution with care and to keep the quality as well as line and level in accordance with the specifications and drawings.

3.2.5 Mobilization Schedule

Mobilization schedules proposed by the bidders indicate that they plan to mobilize before the time, provided in the bidding documents, to commence the Work.

3.2.6 Construction Schedule

Construction schedules provided by the two bidders are considered appropriate to complete the Work in time by following the critical path.


3.3 Non Responsive/Unqualified Bids

Determination of substantive responsiveness of bids is detailed in Appendix 5, 5.1 and 6.


4. CONCLUSIONS AND RECOMMENDATIONS


On the basis of the systematic evaluation of bids as presented in this report, it was concluded that two out of the eight submitted bids were considered Responsive (Appendix 7).

Of the eight bids received, six bids were considered Unqualified (Sub-Paragraph 2.4 here above). Only two bidders at serial number 1, 2 are considered as Responsive and Qualified for opening their price proposals. Price proposals of the rest (serial number 3, 4, 5, 6, 7 and 8) may be returned unopened.

A Bid Evaluation Committee comprising six senior officers was established by the competent authority. Assistance was provided by the staff of the Project Management Consultants (PMC). The Bid Evaluation Committee members were:

The Committee's decisions were made on the basis of unanimous views.

2. EXAMINATION OF PRICE PROPOSALS

2.1 Completeness and signatures

The Price Proposals were first examined to ensure that the bidders had submitted the Price Proposal Submission Sheet, priced Bill of Quantities and Schedule of Payment Currencies, and whether these documents had been prepared properly and signed as stipulated in the Instructions to Bidders. Documents of all bidders were satisfactory as all bid documents were complete, signed and corrections were initiated by the authorized person.

2.2 Discount Offered in Price Proposal

None of the bidders offered any discount in the Price Proposal.

2.3 Schedule of Payment Currencies

None of the bidders entered any foreign currency required to be paid.

2.4 Arithmetic Check and Corrections

Each priced Bill of Quantities of the bidders was checked for arithmetic errors. Errors were corrected in accordance with the stipulations in the bidding documents. These corrections were tabulated and are shown in Appendix 3 & 3A.

The corrected prices for Package No1 which were evaluated, as shown in **Appendix 3**, indicate that the lowest evaluated responsive bid is that submitted by Bidder No.2 M/s Saeed Khan Construction Company for a total evaluated bid price of PRs 39,948,630.

3.6 Examination of Unbalanced Rates for Lowest Evaluated Bid

Comparison of unit rates and prices, particularly early work items, of the lowest evaluated bid with average rates of the other bids and the Executing Agency's estimate were carried out. The comparison indicated that the unit rates of the lowest evaluated responsive bid are reasonable.

3.7 Reasonableness of Price of Lowest Evaluated Bid



3.8 Validity of Qualification Under Technical Proposal



4. CONCLUSIONS AND RECOMMENDATIONS




