1. INTRODUCTION

1.1 Introduction

Pakistan experienced extensive monsoon rains in July-August 2010, which generated unprecedented flood flows in primary, secondary and other rivers including hill torrents and local nullahs. Rivers Swat, Panjkhora and Kabul experienced historic flood flows, which crossed the historic flood peaks. The floods caused huge damages to private and public infrastructure including irrigation networks and flood protection works across Pakistan. The flood damages to the irrigation and drainage infrastructure are estimated at Rs 23,600 million.

In Sindh, four breaches in flood protection embankments, Left Marginal Bund of Guddu Barrage and Tori, MS and PB Bunds, caused main damages. The Tori Bund breach had inundated entire North West Canal command area and damaged much of the infrastructure on its way back to the Indus River.

1.2 Project Description

In response to flood damage recovery and reconstruction interventions, Asian Development Bank (ADB) through its emergency loan i.e. 2742/ 2743 (PAK) SF: Flood Emergency Reconstruction Project (FERP), has committed to support the ongoing efforts of the Government of Pakistan (GOP) for reconstruction of irrigation, drainage and flood protection infrastructure in Sindh Province. "Earthwork Rasing/Strengthening along F.P Bund from RD 1 to 30, 120 to 147 and 192 to 220, Providing Stone Pitching from RD 120 to 147 and 192 to 220 and Service Track from RD 120 to 220" (the Project) is one of several sub projects being Financed under ADB's FERP Irrigation Sector support.

(a) Location and Access

The work site (F.P Bund, Southern Dadu Division) is situated in District Dadu, about 235 km North-West of Hyderabad City and easily accessible through Indus Highway. The nearest towns to the site are Johi and Kakar.

(b) Works under the Contract

Works under the contract includes earthwork, stone pitching and service track.

1.3 Bidding Document and Post-Qualification

The Contract is National Competitive Bidding (NCB) conducted in accordance with ADB's "Single-Stage: Two-Envelope" Post-Qualification Bidding Procedures.

1.4 Invitation for Bid

The Invitation for Bids was advertised on 19 Nov, 2011 issues of two local newspapers. Copy is available at **Appendix 2**. The Bidding Documents were ready for issuance from 19 Nov, 2011 and in total twelve (12) firms purchased the Bidding Documents.

Initially it was envisaged that PMU-FERP Hyderabad, would receive/evaluate bids and accordingly NIT was published. However in the later stage Sindh Irrigation Department (SID) decided that all procurement for civil works under ADB's FERP-Irrigation Sector Support shall be initiated, received and evaluated at regional office by the concerned Chief Engineers. This change in procurement process through a Corrigendum dated November 2011 was published in the news paper (copy attached as **Appendix 2.1**). Corrigendum were also issued to all firms who purchased the bidding documents.

1.5 Submission of Bids

Receipt of bids by the Procurement Committee at the Administrative Division of Southern Dadu Division, Dadu was closed at 11:30 AM local time on 9 December 2011 as scheduled. Out of twelve (12) firms which purchased the bidding documents, following four (4) bidders submitted bids.

1.6 Technical Proposals Opening

Technical Proposals were opened at 12.30 hours on 9 December 2011 at Southern Dadu Division, Dadu by the Procurement Committee in the presence of representatives of bidders and Price Proposals kept unopened in safe custody. 
On the basis of the systematic evaluation of bids as presented in this report, it was concluded that three out of the four submitted bids were considered Substantially Responsive (Appendix 7).


Of the four bids received, one bid was considered Unqualified (Sub-Paragraph 2.4 here above).







On 10 December 2011 the three Bidders No. 1, 2 and 4 were informed in writing that their Technical Proposals had been considered responsive and qualified; and they were invited to attend the opening of their Price Proposals; the time, date and place indicated (see Appendix 1 for details)

1.2 Opening of Price Proposals
