Committee also discussed that the contract for each educational facility may be awarded on the basis of estimated quantities, as mentioned in the bidding document. However, payment against the contract shall be made on the basis of actual supply/disbursement of articles and provision of delivery challans.


After detailed evaluation of technical and financial bids, comparative statements prepared for each educational facility's articles, committee decided as follows:-

Decision:-

- Committee decided that the contract for each educational facility be awarded on the basis of lowest rate on complete package (covering all the articles of relevant educational facility), instead of article-wise lowest rate, according to direction of SPPRA rules, as recommended in proceeding scheme-wise recommendations, so as the disbursement of such facility may be made in a smooth manner.
- Committee decided that the contract for each educational facility may be awarded on the basis of estimated quantities, as mentioned in the bidding documents. However, total quantum of contract shall base on actual supply/disbarment of articles. Similarly, the payment of claims to contacting firms shall be based on provision of delivery challans and re-verification by the Head of Institutions.
- Committee recommended that before award of contract for providing textbooks, grammar books, exercise copies/ registers, practical journals and school bags to M/s. Al-Farooq Traders, who is the single bidding firm, any two members of Procurement Committee may be obtain rates of BOQ articles from local market as per SPPRA Rules 2010 (48) and compare local market rates of articles with the quoted rates of M/s. Al-Farooq Trades in financial bid. Members of Committee shall also prepare a separate comparative statement and placed on before Procurement Committee for further decision in the light of SPPRA Rules 2010. The decision will be taken after assessment of rates.
- Committee recommended that award of contract for providing School Uniforms & Sweater, to M/s. Excel Tex Industries, Karachi, on the basis of lowest quoted rates for the complete educational facility, with amount of Rs.47,998,840/- However, the assurance of quality and quantity would be the responsibility of the Head of Institution.

- Committee recommended the award of contract for providing School Shoes (black and P.T shoes), to M/s. Al-Farooq Traders, Karachi, on the basis of lowest quoted rates for the complete educational facility, with amount of Rs.17,923,063/-. However, the assurance of quality and quantity would be the responsibility of the Head of Institution.


