The Financial proposal of the technically accepted bidders were opened by the Procurement Committee and announced the rates in presence of Representatives of the bidding firms on 16th March-2018 at 3:00 p.m in the office of the Secretary Workers Welfare Board Sindh who was also present.

After opening of financial proposals, the committee preliminary prepared separate attendance sheet, showing the names of the technically accepted bidding firms, the amount of earnest money enclosed alongwith the bids, total amount/ value of bid quoted by the bidders and the total amount/value calculated by the committee after checking of individual quoted rates and amount thereof and prepared a comparative statement. The quoted rates this year are based on estimated quantity of 25000 children of workers whereas last year the rates were called only for 9000 students (only for Board's Institutions).

The summarized position / comparative statement of the participated firms as given below:-

Decision:-

- To further evaluate the tender, rates/prices were compared with the rates of last awarded contract partially because last year the supply was restricted to our schools only and no supply was made other than our schools. On the same basis it is found that present quoted prices are about <u>28% lower</u> than the prices of last year (only for those items which were supplied last) therefore the bid can be accepted safely. The comparative statement is also enclosed at Annexure-"A". The rule-48 of SPPRA narrates that bid can be accepted if the rates are comparable to the prices of last awarded contract.
- At present estimated per child cost remains to be Rs.3695/- whereas the rates per child last year was Rs.3999/- which is about 8% below of last year.
- On the basis of above facts the Committee decided to recommend awarding the contract to lowest bidder as per his quoted rates (duly corrected).
- The Committee also decided to up-load all the required documents and minutes on the website of the SPPRA
- The meeting ended with a vote of thanks to and from the Chair.


