The Committee has informed that a tender notice was got published in leading newspapers; Daily Dawn on 19 January 2018, Daily Jang on 20- January-2018 and Daily Kawish on 22 January 2018 respectively.

Due to late hoisted/ uploaded on the official website of SPPRA, the date of technical bid opening was extended from 06.2.2018 to 15.02.2018 with the approval by the Secretary/CEO of WWB, Sindh to cover the 15 days notice as per SPPRA Rules. Accordingly, as per SPPRA Rules 2010 these tender were invited as Single stage - two envelopes bids, containing Technical and Financial Proposals. Only Technical Proposals are opened on the day in the presence of the Representatives of participated firms and retained the Financial Proposals in the Lock & Key and will be opened of firms qualifying the Technical Criteria. The date will be informed separately.

In response to advertisement, Eleven (11) interested firms purchased the tender documents, out of which Four (04) firms submitted their bids; containing technical &

financial proposals alongwith their company's profiles. Representatives of all firms were available while opening of bids.

After opening the technical proposals, the Committee carried-out the technical evaluation of the company profiles as well documents provided by the bidding firms in support of their technical proposals. *As per evaluation criteria, 80% marks were required to be obtained by a bidding firm to qualify for further competing in bidding process (including 80 marks of Laboratory Testing Report* Accordingly, Committee prepared a preliminary Bid Evaluation Sheet, according to marks assigned as per para-meter given in evaluation criteria to work out actual position of the participated firms and sending their samples to Laboratory for examining their specification for preparation of final Bid Evaluation Report (attached at Annexure-A). As per para-meters given in evaluation criteria, the position of marks in preliminary evaluation sheet (excluding Lab: testing report) obtained by firms, is given as follows:

The technical qualification of firms shall be finalized after incorporating the marks of laboratory tests reports.

3. On receipt of laboratory reports, a statement of technical evaluation shall be prepared in terms of marks obtained by bidding firms to finalize the acceptance of technical proposals.
4. Letters shall be issued/ sent to technically qualified bidders, inviting them to attend the proceedings of financial proposals opening by the Tender Opening Committee.

The Committee has informed that Procurement Committee of WWBS was opened Technical Proposal for supply of School Uniforms / Sportswear and School Uniforms to Workers Children studying in all Workers Model Schools /Colleges and other then Board Institutions (Govt. and Private Colleges & Schools) throughout province of Sindh for the academic year 2018-19 in the financial year 2017-18 on 15.02.2018 at 11:30 a.m.

The Committee has prepared a preliminary Bid evaluation Sheet, according to marks assigned as per para-meter given in evaluation criteria to work out actual position of the participated firms and sending their samples to Laboratory for examining their specification for preparation of final Bid Evaluation Report. As per para-meters given in evaluation criteria, the position of marks in preliminary evaluation sheet (excluding Lab: testing report) the following three firms out of four participated firms have qualified preliminary Bid evaluation criteria:-

1. M/s. Excel Tex Industries (Pvt) Ltd.
2. M/s. Blue Stare International.
3. M/s. Falcon Leather & Textile

Accordingly, after obtained necessary permission by the Secretary/CEO of the Workers Welfare Board, Sindh samples of the above named preliminary qualified firms sent to M/s. Army Store and Inspection Depot (ASID), Karachi for proper examining and testing with regard to technical specifications.

It is further that concerned laboratory has issued test reports their in it is confirmed that the samples of all above mentioned three firms almost found as per specification as given in the Technical Proposal.





The Committee was informed that a tender notice on **Open Competitive basis** (single stage two envelopes method) was got published in leading newspapers through Information Department Govt. of Sindh Daily Dawn on 19th January 2018, Jang on 20th January-2018 and Daily Kawish on 22nd January 2018 respectively as well as on SPRRA website at S.No. 36464. dated 29.01-2018 for procurement of above articles for wide publicity and brings value of money as per SPPRA Rue-17.

In response to Advertisement Eleven (11) firms purchased the tender documents, out of which following four (04) firms submitted their bids (attendance sheet duly signed by all is annexed) on the date and time containing technical & financial proposals alongwith their company's profiles. The others did not turned up despite purchasing of bid documents.

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

Technical Proposals of the above named firms were opened by the Committee on 15.02.2018 in the presence of the representatives of the firms. The Committee has prepared a preliminary technical evaluation report in its meeting again held on 13.03.2018 at 11.00 a.m. in the office of the Secretary, Workers Welfare Board Sindh. On the basis of evaluation Report all the firms except M/s. Harmain Enterprises, Karachi have qualified in the preliminary technical evaluation criteria given in the bid documents and further decided to send the samples of preliminary qualified bidding firms to the Army Stores Inspection Depot (ASID) for test / examination also given in the conditions to check technical specifications, as provided in the tender documents after obtaining necessary approval from the Secretary, Workers Welfare Board Sindh. The same specifications in the bid documents are followed which are being adopted since last many years and did not change the same. The complete technical qualification of firms shall be finalized after incorporating the marks of laboratory tests reports. Accordingly, the samples of the above named successful bidders were sent to laboratory; viz. Army Stores Inspection Depot, Karachi as provided in the bid documents after approval from the Secretary / CEO of Workers Welfare Board Sindh.

On receipt of Laboratory reports, the technical proposals of bidding firms were finally evaluated with regard to experience of bidding firms in relevant field, financial worth, NTN, Sales Tax/ SRB registration, photographic evidence of tailoring setup as well as distribution outlets, supply of relevant articles in past years, team members of professionals, income tax returns and audited accounts etc.

As per technical evaluation reports, the technical proposals of above named bidding firms except M/s. Harmain Enterprises, Karachi were found correct and stands qualified. No complaint from any bidder is received by the Office or by CRC. Accordingly, letters of intimation regarding acceptance of technical proposals and inviting to attend opening of financial proposals, were issued to firms qualified for bidding. The Financial proposal of the technically accepted bidders were opened by the Procurement Committee and announced the rates in presence of representatives of the bidding firms on 16th March-2018 at 3:30 p.m in the office of the Secretary of Workers Welfare Board Sindh.

After opening of financial proposals, the committee preliminary prepared separate attendance sheet, showing the names of the technically accepted bidding firms, the amount of earnest money provided alongwith the bids, total amount/ value of bid quoted by the bidders and the total amount/value calculated by the committee after checking of individual quoted rates and amount thereof and prepared a comparative statement. The quoted rates and amount based on estimated quantity of 25000 children of workers.

The bottom of the page features several handwritten signatures and initials in black ink. The Committee unanimously decided that the contract for supply of Uniforms/ Sportswear and School Sweaters shall be awarded to the lowest bidder on the basis of estimated quantities, as mentioned in the bidding document. However, payment against the contract shall be made on the basis of actual supply/disbursement of articles and provision of delivery challans / coupons which should be re-verified by the Head of Schools / Colleges of the Board as well as coupons must be re-verified with the worker and employer of the concern establishment.






After detailed discussion on evaluation of technical and financial bids & comparative statement prepared by the Committee and decided as follows:-

Decision:-

- Committee decided that the contact for Procurement of Uniforms/ Sportswear and School Sweaters be awarded to the lowest quoted firm M/s.Excel Tex Industries (Pvt) Ltd, Karachi with the quoted amount of **Rs.197,959,100/-** after obtaining necessary approval/ permission from the Secretary/ CEO of Workers Welfare Board Sindh. The Committee also compared the present quoted rates of 1st lowest bidder and found about 10% above as compared to last year which are reasonable and justified. However this year a new item "sportswear" is included in the tender which was never supplied before and the rate of same cannot be compared.

- Committee decided that the contract of said educational facility shall be awarded on the basis of estimated quantities, as mentioned in the bidding documents. However, total quantum of contract shall base on actual supply/disbarment of articles. Similarly, the payment of claims to contacting firm shall be based on provision of delivery challans and re-verification by the Head of Institutions and employers of Establishments. No payment to be made if the challans or coupons are not verified.
- The Committee also decided to up-load all the required documents on the website of the SPPRA before issuance of Supply order and completion of mandatory period/time. Similarly the proforma of NAB showing all the information may also be sent to NAB for their examination as mandatory required.
