However, it is advised to furnish the Bidders Qualification Report (in original) duly signed by the members of Procurement Committee in terms of Rule-46(1)(a) of SPP Rules, 2010. The Rule is, in turn, reproduced as under:

Rule-46(1)(a) stipulates that "Notice Inviting Tenders and bidding documents of this method shall contain the following eligibility criteria;

- (i) relevant experience;
- (ii) turn over of at-least last three years;
- (iii) registration with income tax, sales tax and Pakistan Engineering Council (where applicable);
- (iv) any other factor deemed to be relevant by the procuring agency subject to provision of Rule-44;

2. Further, it is advised to furnish reply / compliance on this Authority's letter of 18th August, 2014.

3. An early compliance will be appreciated and non-compliance of SPP Rules shall render the Procurement "mis-procurement" under relevant provisions of SPP Rules, 2010.

Dear Sir,

This is with reference to UCG Tender No. Mechanical -201/2014, opened on dated 18-08-2014 in presence of Tender Opening Committee and bidders, i.e Mr. Maj Muhammad Ilyas (President) and Mr. Zafarullah (Member) and Our Representative of our firm M/s Jagani & Brothers Mithi. One member Mr. Ghulam Mustafa Bajeer Assistant Director SCA Mithi (Member) was not present and other bidder M/s T.M.Anjarwala Karachi sent bid through courier service.

Two firms participated in the bid, M/s T.M Anjarwala & Sons karachi and M/s Jagani & Brothers Mithi, the quoted prices of each bidder was read out as mentioned below:

1. T.M. Anjarwal & Sons karachi quoted for China Brand Chain Block with Unit price of Rs. 27,000/-with total cost of Rs. 810 000 for 30 Nos. without GST.
2. Our Firm M/s Jagani & Brothers Mithi quoted two options mentioned below:
 - I. China brand with Unit price of Rs. 19,500/- with total cost of Rs. 585,000/- for 30 Nos. without GST.
 - II. Japan brand with Unit price of Rs. 30,900/- with total cost of Rs. 927,000/- for 30 Nos without GST.

Resulting as our firm M/s Jagani & Brothers declared as lowest bidder and other bidder rates were much higher than our bid.

Later on an email from the President Tender opening committee dated:20/08/2014 received, requesting to provide the sample of the quoted item of China make copy attached, responding to request we provided the Sample which was according to laid down specification in the tender document.

BER and Comparative statement with S.No. 4958, ID NO. 1397/2014, 26th September, 2014 was hoisted at SPPRA Website, referring to Comparative statement note as mentioned below:

" Samples and discount was asked from both bidders. The sample from M/s T.M Anjarwala & Sons karachi, was superior in quality, workmanship material and length of Lifting Chain. However he has offered a rebate. Thus M/s T.M Anjarwala & Sons karachi is the lowest and technically qualified. Purchase order may be issued to M/s T.M. Anjarwala & Sons after hoisting on SPPRA website."

Our observations on Comparative statement are as under:

1. No letter/email was received asking for discount but email received for providing sample same was presented. It appears that Committee has only asked one Supplier M/s T.M.Anjarwala, who has offered new rates Rs.19, 400/- per unit price (Rs. 7, 600/- per unit price as 28 % and Rs. 273,600/- on 36 Nos.) and only 100 Rs. Less than our firm quoted price of Rs. 19,500/-.
2. Original price of bidder M/s T.M Anjarwala & Sons Karachi which was read out at bid opening time not mentioned in Comparative statement and BER.
3. Multiplying the Unit rate of Rs. 19500/- with revised quantity 36 Nos from tender quantity 30 Nos, Total cost becomes Rs. 702,000/- , GST is 119,340/- and G.Total Cost as 821, 340/- but in comparative statement mentioned total cost is Rs.720,000/- and G.Total cost as 839,340/- considering these our firm M/s Jagani & Brothers may also be corrected.

Observations mentioned in above are clearly violation of SPPRA rules mentioned in Bid evaluation section and it appears that committee has favoured the bidder M/s T.M.Anjarwala Karachi.

It is requested to take serious disciplinary action against committee for violating the SPPRA rules and re-evaluate the tender and considering as our sample is acceptable as committee has not rejected our sample,






