

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Fresh terror wave reaches KP, tribal areas

Three Levies, one FC personnel among seven killed; five militants gunned down

GHALAKAPPEHAWAR A renewed wave of terrorism in the country witnessed on Wednesday when four suicide bombers blew themselves up one after another at different spots in Peshawar, Mohmand Agency and Charsadda in an attempt to target senior judges and members of the judiciary.

Two suicide bombers targeted a government hospital in Charsadda, the headquarters of Mohmand Agency, before a third bomber in Peshawar targeted his eight-member committee with a vehicle carrying four judges. The fourth suicide bomber

How himself up in a bombing operation later in the day in a village in Charsadda.

A total of seven people, including four security personnel, were killed and nine others wounded in the attacks. The five judges survived the Peshawar attack but sustained serious wounds.

Mohmand Agency attacks came two days after a powerful vehicle bombing killed at least 13 people and wounded over 100 others in Lahore. Two personnel of the Fresh University hospital were killed when a bomb they were defusing went off in Quetta on Monday.

On Sunday, a suicide bomber was killed in Charsadda.

Karachi in an attack whose responsibility was claimed by the outlawed Tehreek-e-Taliban Pakistan.

In Lahore, police believed to have arrested a "suspect" of the Monday bombing.

In the Charsadda case, two attackers tried to enter the judicial compound. Witnesses said one of them opened fire on the Levies personnel manning the main gate in order to get the suicide bomber into the compound. However, the personnel retaliated and shot him dead at the entrance to the compound.

The second bomber was a female and she detonated it into the main gate of the compound, killing three Levies personnel.

For Khud Muhammad, medical superintendent of the agency headquarters hospital in Charsadda, said two doctors and six injured were brought to the hospital. One of the injured Levies personnel died later.

Hours later in Peshawar, a suicide bomber rammed his motorcycle into an official vehicle carrying four judges of the anti-terrorism judiciary, killing the driver and wounding five others, including judges, in the Hayatabad area.

The judges have been identified as Aziz Ishaq, Raza Ahsan, Amara Haider and Salimullah Khan. The wounded judge and a passer-by were taken to the Hayatabad Medical Complex, whose doctors said their conditions were stable.

Peshawar police chief Muttammar Tahir Khan said that the judge's vehicle was hit with a police car as according to him security could not be provided to each vehicle in the road that 15 kilograms of explosives were used in the blast.

He said the law and order situation was precarious on the other side of the border (Afghanistan) and the tribal areas (Khyber Agency) was located at a walking distance of five minutes. "It's a security failure as we have been enjoying calmness on a daily basis keeping in view the looming threats in Peshawar," he said while explaining to a

SC unhappy with cyclical arguments in Panama case

Salman Akram Raja questions court's 'ingratiating' jurisdiction; Justice Saeed returns to bench in good spirits

ISLAMABAD Exasperated by the repetitive arguments being advanced before it despite a two-strike ban, the Supreme Court on Wednesday wondered why the questions that were being the courts on this case of the Panama Papers leaks are continued to be put up.

elder son of Prime Minister Nawaz Sharif, is the owner of the firm 'Lionel Bass'?" asked Justice Sheikh Anwar Saad, a member of the five-judge Supreme Court bench who resumed proceedings.

Prices of petrol, HSD increased by Rel each

ISLAMABAD The government increased on Wednesday the prices of petrol and high-speed diesel (HSD) by Rs1 per litre each with immediate effect.

The announcement was made by Finance Minister Ishaq Dar, who also said the government had not planned to fully increase consumer prices because it was recommended by the Oil and Gas Regulatory Authority (OGRA) and decided to absorb an additional Rs1 billion by not fully transferring to them the full impact of price hike in the international market.

According to state-run Sui Gas, however, this is not the whole truth.

A few days ago, the finance ministry asked the petroleum ministry to increase prices higher rate of petrol and HSD to the international market (IFM) while maintaining the unchanged price changes.

The price of petrol, high-speed oil (HSD) and kerosene is standard OMC rate of

Senator wants rules on post-retirement benefits revisited

Rabbani asks govt to explain its position on recent wave of terrorist attacks; minister 'unaware' of Airbus sale to German firm

ISLAMABAD Senator Farhatullah Rabbani on Wednesday called for a re-examination of the rules regarding post-retirement benefits awarded to public officials and sought an in-camera examination of the issue at the Senate committee level.

Speaking on a point of public importance, Mr. Rabbani called the issue of alteration of laws to public satisfaction

as one of their retirement as a reward for services rendered.

While making a point, the Pakistan Peoples Party member said the issue raised a number of questions, including whether such alterations were governed by legislative or rules and regulations, who framed these rules and when, the applicability of the rules in the past and whether the application of such rules in the future needed to be re-examined.

"There is also the question of who among the retired senior officials are entitled to this extraordinary privilege," he said, in an apparent reference to reports about the allotment of 90 acres of agricultural land to former army chief retired Gen. Raheel Sharif.

The issue had started a debate in the country, leaving the Inter-Services Public Relations (ISPR) in a quandary as all such alterations were made through a "Constitutional provision".

Mr. Rabbani said the matter was both sensitive and important and called for its re-examination in an in-camera session of the relevant Senate committee.

Senate Chairman Raza Rabbani, however, rejected his calling, saying that he would consider how best to proceed with post-retirement benefits in public officials in a holistic manner.

Interestingly, Mr. Rabbani had mentioned one individual in his remarks, but the chairman said that their actions should not be seen as targeting an individual.

Terrorism attacks

The Senate chairman also sought an explanation from the government over the fresh wave of terrorism menacing the country and its position on a new video message released by a militant group threatening to carry out attacks on the armed forces and key installations.

The disgraced Pakistani Muslim League-Nawaz parliamentary leader Mubashar Ali Khan, to ensure the presence of Minister of State for Interior Raza Rabbani on Thursday during its local sessions on the recent terrorist attacks and take the house into confidence over the video message released by Osama al-Ashari.

The director came after former interior minister Rabbani Malik informed the house about the suicide attack on Peshawar. He said that the militants had struck all provincial capitals in recent days, adding that the militant group had released a video message threatening attacks across the country.

Rabbani Malik said the militants had named a "Khatm-e-Dunya" in their message, but the group had not mentioned itself from Islamabad.

"This group's name is the last of
