National Examination & Evaluation Foundation was "Rs.5,550,000/=" with bid security Rs.166,500/= which corresponds to 3% of the bid amount. The total amount of bid from M/s. Sukkur IBA was "Rs.4,149,285/=" while bid security was not provided by the bidder with the financial proposal as per requirements mentioned in the published RFP. Thus, M/s. National Examination & Evaluation Foundation qualified financially, but it emerged as single Bidder as the Financial Proposals submitted by M/s. Sukkur IBA did not meet the requirements.






