

1. The meeting was started with the recitation of verse from the Holy Quran. The Deputy Project Director (BBSYDP) chaired the meeting and Provincial Program Manager sought approval to officially start the proceedings.
2. The Provincial Program Manager inquired the Chairman & members Procurement Committee that the DFA was sent to each member along with the received proposals & working paper for any rectification or observation so if any found it may be discussed before meeting proceedings begins so that the observation or rectification could be discussed & finalized.
3. During pre-qualification of NGOs it was observed that M/s Management Development Foundation & M/s Sindh Development Society were disqualified on the basis of criteria mentioned in the RFP. However the Procurement Committee in order to avoid any conflict of interest as well as to observe a healthy competition decided to include both NGOs in Technical Evaluation.
4. The evaluation was carried out strictly in compliance of evaluation criteria as mentioned in the RFP by the donor agency.
5. The Program Manager briefed the committee that minimum 60 marks are required to qualify for further proceedings & NGOs securing 60 marks or above will be considered for financial opening.
6. The technical proposals were evaluated & the Procurement Officer briefed the committee about the findings observed during evaluation & provided the evidence upon which the Procurement Committee scored the NGOs in lights of TORs & Evaluation criteria set in RFP.


7. All the members with mutual consent & proper evaluation finalized the Technical working paper & in lights of the findings the scoring was finalized.
8. Only M/s Care & Support Welfare Organization was qualified during the Technical evaluation by securing more than 60% marks. The member Procurement Committee commented that despite of disqualification the Committee for a healthy competition included M/s Management Development Foundation & M/s Sindh Development Society for Technical evaluation but it is regretted that both NGOs did not meet the qualifying marks for further proceedings. Both the NGOs are disqualified.
9. The evaluation was finalized & the members of Procurement Committee signed all the working papers, pre-qualifying criteria and individual as well as comparative scoring sheet for hoisting on SPPRA website.
10. Meeting ended with the vote of thanks to & from the Chairman Procurement Committee.
