



- 01. The aforementioned amount is the "Contract Price" payable in consideration of the execution, and completion of the subject works. This amount has been established based on the understanding that it includes all of the Consultant's costs and profits as well as any tax obligation that may be imposed on the Consultant. This amount may be increased subject to the pending decisions/ revisions/ approval of Planning & Development Department, accordingly.
- 02. In pursuant to clause 24.2 of data sheet of Request for Proposal (RFP), you are required to furnish the **Performance Security** in form of pay order, demand draft or bank guarantee worth **Rs. 189,000/-** (not more than 10% of the contract amount) within Fourteen (14) days after receipt of this letter.

- 03. You are required to sign the Contract Agreement on Judicial Paper and duly stamped @ 0.3% of the value of contract in terms of Rule 55 of SPPRA Rules 2010 and Rule-159 (a) of Sindh Financial Rules, vol-I.
 - 04. The Consultant will act as Engineering Unit and will be responsible for detailed drawings, designs, detailed supervision, monitoring, evaluation and assessment of works as per BOQ of Civil works, Certification, Tender Design & assist in Tendering process, Bid evaluation and award of contract and commissioning under the scheme, which includes:

CONTRACT AGREEMENT

This Contract Agreement is made at Karachi on this 06th day of May 2016.

BETWEEN

SINDH POULTRY VACCINE CENTRE, LIVESTOCK & FISHERIES DEPARTMENT, GOVERNMENT OF SINDH having its principal place of business at Animal Science Complex, Korangi Industrial Area (near Singer Chowrangi), Korangi, Karachi-74900, (Pakistan), hereinafter called the "Procuring Agency or PA".

AND

M/S. ESS-I-AAR having its principal place of business at Suit No. 314, 3rd Floor, Mashrique Centre, Guishan-e-Iqbal Block 14, Karachi hereinafte RACalled the "Consultant".

WHEREAS, the PA wishes to have the Consultant performing the services hereinafter referred to, and

WHEREAS, the Consultant is willing to perform these services,

Now therefore the Parties hereby agree as follows:

1. SERVICES:

- (i) The Consultant shall perform the services specified in Annex A, "Terms of Reference and Scope of Services," which is made an integral part of this Contract ("the Services").
- (ii) The Consultant shall provide the reports listed in Annex B, "Consultant's Reporting Obligations" within the time periods listed in such Annex, and the personnel listed in Annex C, "Cost Estimate of Services, List of Personnel and Schedule of Rates" to perform the Services.

2. TERM:

The Consultant shall perform the Services during the period commencing from dated: 11.05.2016 and continuing through the year 2017-18 (extendable till the completion of the project) or any other period as may be subsequently agreed by the parties in writing.

3. PAYMENT:

A. CEILING:

For Services rendered pursuant to Annex A, the PA shall pay the Consultant an amount not to exceed worth Rs. 1.890 million or 2.32% of capital / civil works or may be exceed as per Planning & Development Department approval. This amount has been established based on the understanding that it includes all of the Consultant's costs and profits as well as any tax obligation that may be imposed on the Consultant.

B. PAYMENT CONDITIONS:

Payment shall be made in **Pak Rupees**, no later than 30 days following submission by the Consultant of invoices in duplicate to the Coordinator designated in paragraph 4. The Consultant has to claim his charges for design work on lump sum basis and for supervision on percentage basis. The cost of design consultancy is 15% of total cost of consultant. Whereas, supervision cost will be claimed on passing the bills of contractor on percentage basis of work completed.

4. ECONOMIC PRICE ADJUSTMENT:

In order to adjust the remuneration for inflation, a price adjustment provision has not been included. However, if Government of Sindh or Planning & Development Department allows the revised rates of consultancy, the same increase applies to the consultant.

5. PROJECT ADMINISTRATION:

A. COORDINATOR:

The PA designates **Dr. Nazeer Hussain Kalhoro**, **Project Director** as PA's Coordinator; the Coordinator shall be responsible for the coordination of activities under the Contract, for receiving and approving invoices for payment, and for acceptance of the deliverables by the PA.

B. TIMESHEETS:

During the course of their work under this Contract the Consultant's employees providing services under this Contract may be required to complete timesheets or any other document used to identify time spent, as instructed by the Coordinator.

C. RECORDS AND ACCOUNTS:

The Consultant shall keep accurate and systematic records and accounts in respect of the Services, which will clearly identify all charges and expenses. The PA reserves the right to audit, or to nominate a reputable accounting firm to audit, the Consultant's records relating to amounts claimed under this Contract during its term and any extension, and for a period of three months thereafter.

6. PERFORMANCE STANDARD:

TERMS OF REFERENCE AND SCOPE OF SERVICES

SCOPE:
