

The PD/ DPD will be the focal person for the Government of Sindh/SBBHC, whereas, the Chief Executive Officer or a designated responsible official of, concerned CSO will be the Project Manager, responsible for day to day decision making for the project construction supervision. The PD will be involved in the endorsement of the work plan, progress review and monitoring.

2.02 The concerned CSO will report the progress to SBBHC as per work plan. The Services shall be carried out by concerned CSO through a team of professionals, led by a Team Leader, who shall be responsible for implementation of the work plan.
