

Minutes of the Pre-Proposal Conference held on February 22, 2018
For Accelerated Action Plan for Reduction of Stunting & Malnutrition,
Health Department, Government of Sindh

A Pre Proposal Conference was held on February 22, 2018, to address queries of potential NGOs, for the Hiring of NGOs for Service Delivery in Districts Sukkur and Mirpurkhas - Uncovered Area for Accelerated Action Plan (AAP) for Reduction of Stunting & Malnutrition at 3rd Floor, Tughlaq House Sindh Secretariat Building No. 2, Kamal Atta Turk Road, Karachi. The meeting was chaired by Dr. Sahib Jan Bader, Program Coordinator, AAP. List of participants is attached at Annex-A.

2. After the introduction of participants, the Chair welcomed the participants and appreciated the positive attendance and thanked the participants for taking their precious time from their busy schedule for this meeting. Subsequently, she gave an introduction about the project and informed the participants that initially the project would be implemented in two districts and after each year more districts would be included in the ambit of the project. She informed that participants that AAP is multi-sectorial approach and the project is being implemented by seven different Departments of Government of Sindh i.e. Health Livestock & Fisheries, Local Government, Social Welfare, Agriculture, Education and Population Welfare Department. She then gave floor to participants to raise their queries. Questions raised by the bidder and their responses are given below:

S. No	Query	Clarification
1	Is the NGO responsible for establishing OTPs and Stabilization Centers?	Yes, the NGO is responsible for establishing OTP sites in their relevant areas. NGO is not required to establish Stabilization Centers as it is the responsibility of the Health Department but the NGOs would make provisions in their financial proposal for the support staff that would be working in the Stabilization Centers.
2	The number of CHWs required in both districts in given in the ToRs but details of where they would be posted is not given.	The same is also mentioned in the ToRs that the engaged NGO would carry out the mapping exercise and post the CHWs in the uncovered UCs. The same would be provided to AAP in the inception report of the NGO.
3	The total duration of the project is 1 year or would it be extended?	The initial contract would be for a period of one year, which would be extended on the basis of satisfactory performance of the NGO.
4	We understand that the concept is same as of the NSP, so just like NSP we would be provided with the supplies?	Yes, the equipment such as weight machines (both for mothers and children), MAUC tapes, thermometers and IEC material along with supplies such as RUTF, MNP, F-75 and F-1000 along with various medicines will be provided by AAP.

5	Which organizations do the NGOs would be required to have coordination in the field?	NGO should have close coordination with PPHI, Sindh LHW Program at district level and also will be in coordination with all stakeholders of AAP mentioned above. Additionally, coordination with DCOs Sindh LHWs Program, Focal MNCH Program, DNO of NSP and DHOs is very essential.
6	ToRs mention that a single NGO can only bid for one district, why is that?	Yes, it is mentioned in the ToRs cause given the ground realities we have witnessed that an NGO cannot handle running two districts simultaneously.
7	What is the procurement method to be followed?	The proposals are to be submitted in accordance with Quality and Cost Based Selection method as described in the Sindh Public Procurement Rules 2010 (amended 2017) and other terms and conditions as mentioned in the Request for Proposal.

3. It was decided that in light of the above decisions, minutes of the pre-proposal conference would be circulated amongst the NGOs who have already purchased the RFP and would be issued to NGOs who would purchase the RFP in future.

7. The meeting ended with vote of thanks to and from the chair.
