

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



SUBJECT: MINUTES OF THE CONSULTANT SELECTION COMMITTEE (CSC) MEETING FOR OPENING AND EVALUATION OF FINANCIAL PROPOSALS FOR PROCUREMENT OF SERVICES OF A CONSULTING FIRM FOR "ENVIRONMENTAL AND SOCIAL BASELINE ASSESSMENT FOR REMAINING 14 DISTRICTS UNDER ACCELERATED ACTION PLAN (AAP) FOR SINDH".

A meeting of Consultant Selection Committee (CSC) was held under the Chairmanship of Director General, Directorate of Urban Policy & Strategic Planning (UP&SP), Planning & Development Department, Government of Sindh on 3rd July, 2017 at 02:00 PM in the committee room of the Directorate for opening of financial proposal submitted by technically qualified firms for subject assignment / procurement. The meeting was attended by all CSC members except member from Environment Department. However, as per rule 68 of SPP rules, the quorum was complete to conduct the meeting as representatives from P&D Department and Finance Department attended the meeting.

2. As a result of the evaluation of technical proposal submitted by M/s. EMC Pakistan Pvt. Ltd. secured the minimum qualifying marks of 70 out of 100 and was invited for the public opening of the financial proposal. Representative of technically qualified firm attended the meeting. The Chairman CSC welcomed the members of CSC and representative of qualified firm. The Secretary CSC read aloud the name and technical score of qualified firm based on evaluation of technical proposal submitted by them. The name of qualified firm and their technical score are given in below table.

3. The financial proposal of technically qualified firm was opened before the members of the CSC and representatives of M/s. EMC Pakistan Pvt. Ltd.. The firm submitted bid security of 2.5% of total bid along with the financial proposal in shape of pay order. The prices quoted were read aloud and recorded as given below.

4. The CSC thoroughly examined and evaluated the financial proposal in line with the RFP issued, technical proposal submitted by the firm and SPP Rules. The opened financial proposal submitted by M/s. EMC Pakistan Pvt. Ltd. was PKR 3,420,000/- (PKR Three Million Four Hundred and Twenty Thousand Only) with the above said breakdown.

5. The CSC decided to evaluate the financial proposal as per man month requirements and reimbursable expenses given in the RFP issued. In view of the above considerations, the CSC finalized the consultant's evaluated bid as mentioned below:

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
6. The CSC noted that since the firm did not mention other applicable taxes in their financial proposal, therefore, it was deemed that all applicable taxes to be paid by the consulting firm was included in the financial proposal.

7. It was also observed that out of five technical proposals submitted by the firms; only one technical proposal submitted by M/s. EMC Pakistan Pvt. Ltd. had been qualified. In view of the qualified single bid and nature of the assignment, the Committee discussed that the bid could not be compared to the market prices as the procurement process was for hiring of consultancy services; however, the bid can be compared with estimated cost of the assignment. Further, the subject activity is time bound and is a major condition of World Bank before processing the World Bank funded project. Therefore, the committee noticed that the bid price was within the estimated cost of the assignment and considered the bid valid.

8. Keeping in view the above and in order to fulfill the obligation of Government of Sindh with World Bank for the project finalization the CSC considered the evaluated bid responsive and recommended the M/s. EMC Pakistan Pvt. Ltd. for award of contract. The meeting ended with a vote of thanks to and from the Chair.





A meeting of Consultant Selection Committee (CSC) was held under the Chairmanship of Director General, Directorate of Urban Policy & Strategic Planning (UP&SP), Planning & Development Department, Government of Sindh on **19th June, 2017** in the committee room of the Directorate for opening and evaluation of technical proposals submitted by the interested firms for the subject assignment. The meeting was attended by all CSC members except member from Environment Department. However, as per rule 68 of SPP rules, the quorum was complete to conduct the meeting as representatives from P&D Department and Finance Department attended the meeting.

2. The technical proposals were opened at **12:45 PM** in the presence of the representatives of interested consultants who chose to attend. The Secretary, Consultant Selection Committee informed the Committee that five (05) firms had submitted the proposals (Technical & Financial) by the cut off time of 12:30 PM on 19th June, 2017 for the subject assignment. The names of participating firms were loudly announced by the Secretary of CSC. The names of the interested firms that submitted the proposals are annexed below:

3. Technical evaluation of the submitted technical proposals were carried out on the same day after zuhr namaz break. The CSC informed the representatives of the firms that the Committee would evaluate the technical proposals submitted by the firms as per evaluation criteria given in the RFP document and financial proposal would be opened only qualified firms as per SPP Rules.

4. The Consultant Selection Committee examined the proposals for preliminary screening as per criteria given in the RFP document. The CSC noticed that all the firms had submitted the tender fee of PKR 2,000 except M/s. NEC Consultants Pvt. Ltd. Moreover, M/s. Research & Development Consultants didn't submit the NTN, GST and SRB Registration; Incorporation Certificates and therefore M/s. NEC Consultants Pvt. Ltd. and M/s. Research & Development Consultants have been disqualified.

5. The CSC thoroughly examined and evaluated the technical proposal of M/s. Exponent Engineers Pvt. Ltd., M/s. EMC Pakistan Pvt. Ltd. and M/s. Velosi Integrity & Safety Pakistan Pvt. Ltd. The Committee discussed that as per issued Request for Proposal (RFP); the consultancy services were being hired through Least Cost Based Selection. The type of technical proposal was Full Technical Proposal (FTP) and comprised a total score of 100. The minimum qualifying score for technical proposal was 70 out of 100. The criteria included 10 marks for specific experience of the consultants relevant to the assignment; 25 marks for adequacy of the proposed methodology and work plan in responding to the Terms of Reference; 55 marks for key professional staff qualifications and competence for the assignment; 20 marks for Average annual turnover of the consultants (for the last three years duly certified) (a total of 100 marks).

6. Following are the details of the scores awarded to the consultants based on the evaluation of the technical proposals submitted by them:


