

1) INTRODUCTION

The Expression of Interest (EOI) for Consultancy services was invited by the Project Director, Sindh Resilience Project, Sindh Irrigation Department through leading daily newspapers i.e. Daily Kawish Sindhi, Daily Express Urdu and Daily Dawn English on 03-11-2016 & 04-11-2016 respectively for Procurement of Consultancy Services for Social and Environmental Assessment of Disaster and Climate Resilience Enhancement Program.

All the consulting firms were invited by the Project Director vide letter No: PD/SRP/PC-II/103 dated 14-12-2016 to obtain RFP document on a request from the office of the Project Director during the office hours till 05-01-2017. The document was also available at the SPPRA website for downloading and same should be submitted by hand or post in the office of the Project Director not later than 09-01-2017 by 1.00 P.M.


