OF SHIKARPUR (NEW & REMAINING WORKS)****BID EVALUATION REPORT****1.0 INTRODUCTION**

The North Sindh Urban Services Corporation (the "Procuring Agency") has received grant/funds from P&D Department, Government of Sindh towards the cost of Rehabilitation and Improvement of Sewerage/Drainage System of Shikarpur and it is intended that part of the proceeds of the grant/funds will be applied to eligible payments under the contract for the rehabilitation and improvement of sewerage/drainage system of Shikarpur. The Invitation for Bids was advertised on 4th April, 2016 in the national dailies "The Messenger", "Daily Awami Awaz" and "Daily Express" and on the SPPRA website Dated 12-04-2016 vide tender S.No.27454. See Appendix 1 for details.

2.0 BIDING PROCESS**2.1 Number of firms who purchased Bid documents**

Bid documents were purchased by the Bidders as named below.

2. BID SUBMISSION & OPENING**2.1 Bid Submission Deadline**

The deadline for submission was fixed on 11th May 2016, 2:00 hours PST and the Bid were opened on the same day by the Bid opening committee. The following firms submitted their bids:

1. M/s Haji Syed Ameer & Brothers.
2. M/s Haji Gul Muhammad Khan Shirani
3. M/s Naseeb and Brothers

2.2 **Bid Opening**

Bids were opened as per given scheduled date, at 2:30 hours on 11, May 2016 at the office of the NSUSC, Bungalow No. A-14, Sindh Muslim Society, Airport Road, Sukkur, Pakistan by representatives of the NSUSC Bid Opening Committee. Representatives of bidders participated in the Bid Opening session. Bidder name, bid price, and the presence or absence of the requisite bid security and its amount were announced and recorded. The Record of Bid Opening was prepared soon after the bids were announced. A copy of Record of Bid Opening is attached as Appendix-2.

Three Bids were received and were opened by the Bid opening committee constituted of:

- (1) Chairman, Muhammad Mutahir Dayo, Director of Operations of NSUSC
- (2) Mr. Shahid Anwar, Procurement & Contract Specialist, NSUSC
- (3) Mr. Shehzad Asif Qureshi, Manager Capital Works, NSUSC
- (4) Mr. Zeeshan Ali Pandhiani, Manager HR & Admin. NSUSC
- (5) Mr. Jatin Kumar, Manager finance, NSUSC

2.3 Basic Data

Basic information pertaining to the bidding is summarized and attached as Appendix 4. The bidding process adopted is based on National competitive bidding (NCB), according to guidelines of SPP Rules 2010. All prices are quoted in Pak Rupees.

2.4 Bid Prices Announced

The bid prices were announced in the presence of the representatives of the prospective Bidders.

The summary of announced price is given in Appendix 2 and is also indicated here in:

It is pertinent to mention here that the bid of M/s Naseeb and Brothers was without bid security as mentioned in form, therefore the bid was rejected and no further evaluation of the bid was undertaken. Therefore, bid evaluation of other two bidders namely M/s Haji Gul Muhammad Khan Sheerani and M/s Haji Syed Ameer and Brothers was undertaken.

3.0 PRELIMINARY EXAMINATION OF BIDS

3.1 Bid Documents:

The bid submitted was first examined to check whether the bidder had submitted all the documents and information required by the bidding documents. The areas covered by the examination were:

- (i) Invitation for Bids
- (ii) Instructions to Bidders
- (iii) Bidding Data
- (iv) General Conditions of Contract, Part-I (GCC)
- (v) Special Conditions of Contract , Part-II (SCC)
- (vi) Specifications
- (vii) Form of Bid and Appendices to Bid
- (viii) Bill of Quantities (Appendix-D to Bid)
- (ix) Form of Bid Security
- (x) Form of Contract Agreement
- (xi) Forms of Performance Security, Mobilization Advance Guarantee, Integrity Pact and Indenture Bond for secured advance
- (xii) Drawings

Preliminary examination of bid documents is attached as Appendix 5.

3.0 Responsiveness of Bid

All bidders except M/s Naseeb and Brothers are considered responsive as they fulfilled all requirements mentioned below. Details are attached as Appendix-6.

3.1 Language of Bid:

All bid documents were submitted in English as per the contract.

3.2 Authorization of Bid Submission Letter:

Each bidder submitted:

1. Authorization on the letterhead of the bidding firm, authorizing the signatory of the bid to act for and on behalf of the bidder
2. Updated information regarding financial resources along with average annual construction turn over, financial predictions for current and following two years, work commitments, current litigation information, availability of critical equipment and Appendices mentioned in BOQ.

3.3 Bid Prices:

Each bidder filled the rates and prices of all items of work mentioned in the Bill of Quantities.

3.4 Currencies of Bid and Payment:

The unit rates and prices quoted by the bidders are in Pak Rupees as desired.

3.5 Bid Validity:

According to terms and conditions of the contract the validity period of bid was fixed as 90 days from the deadline for submission of Bid.

3.6 Bid Security:

Bid security was not submitted by M/s Naseeb and Brothers however, bid security of 2% was submitted by the bidders namely M/s Haji Gul Muhammad Khan Sheerani and M/s Haji Syed Ameer and Brothers in shape of bank guarantee and CDR.

3.7 Alternate Proposals/Bids:

Alternative bids were not allowed.

3.8 Pre-Bid Meeting:

Not Applicable.

3.9 Format and Signing of Bid:

All appendices to bid are properly signed and completed by the bidders. No alteration is made neither to the form of bid nor in the appendices.

3.10 Sealing and Marking of Bids:

Each bidder submitted Original and Two Copies of the bid properly sealed and marked to the Managing Director, NSUSC, A-14 Sindhi Muslim Cooperative Housing Society, Airport Road Sukkur, Phone: 071-9310866 & 5633851.

3.11 Deadline for submission of Bids:

All bidders met the deadline and submitted their bids on 11th May 2016 before 2:00 hours.

3.12 Late Bids:

No any late bids were submitted.

3.13 Modification, Substitution and Withdrawal of Bids:

Some of the items were incomplete and missing due to clerical mistake in the BOQ so the addendum was issued and communicated in written to all bidders regarding changes/modifications as per bidding documents clause IB.9 and contract sub-clause IB 7.1

4.1 Bid Evaluation Qualification Criteria:

The Bid submitted was then examined to check whether the bidders meet the qualifications criteria stated in Invitation for Bids and the bidding document, including the following key criteria:

- (i) Firms should be registered with all relevant tax authorities (Tax certificates to be provided with bid).
- (ii) 3 to 5 years minimum average construction turns over shall be PKR 260 Million.
- (iii) 5 to 8 years minimum experience in similar nature of work in water sector projects.
- (iv) At least two projects executed in last five years of similar size, nature, depth and complexity.
- (v) Last 3 years complete financial statements duly audited by chartered accountant firm.
- (vi) Evidence of financial capacity and capability for last 3 to 5 years to be provided. Other sources such as Bank overdraft facility may also be provided.

5.0. Technical Responsiveness of Bid:

All bidders submitted signed and filled Specifications and Drawings as per contract hence are considered technically responsive firms. Details are attached as Appendix-7.

BIDDER No. 1

Bidder No. 1 submitted one Original (all pages stamped and initialed) and two copies of documents in accordance with requirements The Letter of Bid was filled out as required and signed and stamped. Bidder No.1 submitted Letter of Authorization for M/s **Haji Gul Muhammad Khan Shirani** the sole proprietor for firm on company letter head. Bidder No. 1 submitted a covering letter on company letter head paper signed by Authorized officer. And registered with all relevant tax authorities (Tax certificates), and registered with PEC with relevant categories as required / mentioned in NIT. The Bid Security was submitted as desired in the form of Bank Guarantee (BOK/IBB-SITE/109/05/09/2016) of PKR 5,200,000/= Bank Guarantee was issued from The Bank of Khyber B-78 , Allied Plaza Estate Avenue , S.I.T.E Karachi for Bidder no. 1 valid until 18 August 2016. Supplier has provided affidavit that company is not involved in Litigation or blacklisted with any institution or Government departments signed by "Authorized Officer" was provided in supporting document.

The updated information regarding average construction turnover, financial capacity and capability of bidder no.1 was examined. Bidder no. 1 net worth is positive during the last 3 years and has increased over the last 3 years. The turnover of bidder is well ahead of the requirement, hence bidder no.1 is considered in good financial position. Details are attached at Appendix 8.

The updated information such as listings of current workload, availability of construction equipment and key professional personnel, supplier has provided in bidding documents, which is satisfactory and in line with our requirements/criteria.

Bidder no.1 has also provided all the appendices mentioned in the BOQ, which were examined and found correct. Details are attached in Appendix-9.

Firm has successfully executed projects of similar size, nature, depth and complexity such as:

- i. Providing Laying of 30" Dia 24" Dia & 21" Dia RCC Sewer Pipe line for the improvement of sewerage system scheme 33 to provide outer development facilities from sector 34-A & 45-A in scheme 33 Gulshan-e-Iqbal Town amounting to Rs. 241,460,971, dated 14-05-12,
- ii. Rehabilitation / Construction of Storm Water Drain Improvement of Sewerage and water supply system in UC-1 to UC-06 Gulberg Town Karachi amounting Rs. 285,466,307 dated 14-04-15, Client: Project Directorate (SMBBT).

a) Verification

1. Form of bid and BOQ are properly signed and stamped.
2. The bidder is a joint venture. (Not Applicable)

b) Eligibility

1. Firm is eligible to participate in the tender as the firm is prequalified after the process of prequalification.

1. Required bid security is submitted in the form of Bank Guarantee (BOK/IBB-SITE/109/05/09/2016) of PKR 5,200,000/= Bank Guarantee was issued from The Bank of Khyber B-78 , Allied Plaza Estate Avenue , S.I.T.E Karachi for Bidder no. 1 valid until 18 August 2016.
2. The authenticity of the Subject bid security will be verified by NSUSC before notification of award if the firm's bid is technically responsive lowest bid.

d) Substantial Responsiveness to Tender requirements

No material deviation or reservations were notified

Bidder No 2. M/s Haji Syed Ameer & Brothers

Bidder No. 2 submitted one Original (all pages stamped and initialed) and three copies of documents in accordance with requirements The Letter of Bid was filled out as required and signed and stamped. Bidder No.2 submitted Letter of Authorization for Allauddin, the CEO for firm on company letter head. Bidder No. 2 submitted a covering letter on company letter head paper signed by Authorized officer. And registered with all relevant tax authorities (Tax certificates), and registered with PEC with relevant categories as required / mentioned in NIT. The Bid Security was submitted as desired in the form of CDR/Pay order, cheque no. 0239586 The Bank of Khyber IBB SITE Branch Karachi. Supplier has provided affidavit that company is not involved in Litigation or blacklisted with any institution or Government departments signed by "Authorized Officer" was provided in supporting document.

Bidder no. 2 net worth is positive during the last 3 years and has increased over the last 3 years. The turnover of bidder is well ahead of the requirement. The updated information regarding average construction turnover, financial capacity and capability of Last 3 years

complete financial statements duly audited for year 2013, 2014 and 2015 as requested Details are attached at Appendix 8.

Bidder no.2 has also provided the updated information such as listings of current workload, availability of construction equipment and key professional personnel, hence the bidder is considered sound and responsive.

Bidder no.2 has also provided all the appendices mentioned in the BOQ hence the bidder is considered as responsive. Details are attached in Appendix-9.

Firm has successfully executed projects of similar in size, nature, depth and complexity, such as:

- i. Installation of Sewerage system with RCC pipe from Mir Mohammad Goth to Ajmair Nagri Police station for Naya Nazimabad Project, Contract No. SEW-001, Client: Layari Development Authority, amounting Rs. 125.38 Millions.
- ii. Providing laying of 30" dia and 21" dia RCC sewer pipe line for the improvement of sewerage system scheme-33 to provide outer development facilities from sector 34-A and 45-A in scheme -33, Gulshan Iqbal Town, Client: KW & SB, amounting Rs. 41.46 Millions.
- iii. Construction of new pumping station at Mianwali Colony UC-09 site town, Client: KW&SB, amounting Rs. 107.99 Millions. (Work in Progress)

a) **Verification**

1. The bid is properly signed and stamped.

b) **Eligible**

1. They are eligible to participate in the tender as they have been prequalified after the process of prequalification.

c) **Bid Security**

They have submitted bid security in the form of CDR/Pay order, cheque no. 0239586 The Bank of Khyber IBB SITE Branch Karachi. Cheque No. 0239586, the Bank of Khyber IBB SITE Branch, Karachi.

d) **Substantial Responsiveness to Tender Requirements**

No material deviation or reservations were notified

The results of this examination are presented in Appendix 5.

Bidder no 3 M/s Naseeb Khan and Brothers

Bidder no 3 has not submitted the required 2% bid security, hence it leads to the non-responsiveness of the bidder according to clause of ITB 23.2 and is rejected.

5.0 DETAILED EXAMINATION OF TENDER

5.1 Review of Item Rate

A detailed Comparative Statement of substantially responsive bids with Engineer's Estimate (excluding Provisional Sum and 5% Physical Contingencies) has been made and is presented in Annexure -1 of this report. A summary of Comparative study is reflected in Table 8.

It will be seen from this table that:

- ◆ M/s Haji Syed Ameer & Brothers has quoted a total price of Rs. **270,786,223.01** which is **5.51%** above the Engineer's Estimate.
- ◆ M/s Haji Gul Muhammad Khan Shirani has quoted a total price of Rs. **259,279,124.1/-**, however, the firm has also given a rebate of **1.25%** on the total bid price hence after applying rebate of **1.25%** the amount is Rs. **256,038,135.05**, which is **0.24%** below the Engineer's Estimate.

Since M/s Haji Gul Muhammad Khan Shirani Ltd has secured the 1st lowest evaluated position at amount **0.24% below** Engineer's Estimate, their quoted rates for the items of work, which make the significant financial impact, have been examined in detail.

1. For the Construction of 4'-6" Wide Brick Lined RCC Covered BLIS From Hathidar to Eid Gah Disposal (Remaining Portion) the Bidder has quoted the rate which is on average 0.89% below the Engineer's Estimate making a financial difference of -Rs. 389051.91.
2. **A)** For the providing Construction of 2'-6" Wide Brick Lined RCC Covered BLIS From Samadha Mandar via Police Station Head Quarter upto Rangers & Mehran Information Office Beghari Wah Disposal the Bidder has quoted the rate which is on average -3.80% below the Engineer's Estimate making a financial difference of -Rs. 869,981.82
B) For the Construction of 4'-6" Wide Brick Lined RCC Covered BLIS From Rangers & Mehran Information Office up to Beghari Wah Disposal the Bidder has quoted the rate which is on average 3.41% below the Engineer's Estimate making a financial difference of -Rs. 1,959,015.32
3. For the Construction of 3'-6" Wide Brick Lined RCC Covered BLIS From Bhattai Colony toward Bhattai Colony Disposal, the Bidder has quoted the rate which is 3.26% below the Engineer's Estimate making a financial difference of -Rs.1,540,187.36
4. For the Providing, Laying, Jointing and Testing 12" Dia MS Rising Main From Police Head Quarter Disposal to Beghari Wah./Sim Nala the Bidder has quoted the rate which is 1.54 % below the Engineer's Estimate making a financial difference of -Rs.108,645.62

5. For the Providing, Laying, Jointing and Testing 12" Dia MS Rising Main From Eid Gah Disposal to Oxidation Ponds, the Bidder has quoted the rate which is 1.78 % below the Engineer's Estimate making a financial difference of -Rs.97,062.53
6. For the Construction of 3'-6" Wide Brick Lined RCC Covered BLIS From Old Truck Stand to Kila Kafila. (Remaining Portion), the bidder has quoted the rate which is 5.17% above the Engineer's Estimate making a difference of +Rs. (1,257,021.98). Since the estimates were prepared almost 3 years ago for this project therefore, for non-scheduled items the contractor has quoted/taken rates on the open market therefore, applying the factor of inflation for last 3 years' average at the rate of 10%, the 5.17% difference is considered justifiable.
7. For the Construction / Restoration of Cement Concrete Streets / Roads over BLIS System & Rising Mains, the bidder has quoted the rate which is 10.25% above the Engineer's Estimate making a difference of +Rs. (3,010,863.79). Since the estimates were prepared almost 3 years ago for this project therefore, for non-scheduled items the contractor has quoted/taken rates on the open market therefore, applying the factor of inflation for last 3 years' average at the rate of 10%, the 10.25% difference is considered justifiable.
8. For the Mechanical & Electrical Works, the bidder has quoted the rate which is 17.15% above the Engineer's Estimate making a difference of +Rs. (3,330,478.00). Since the estimates were prepared almost 3 years ago for this project therefore, for non-scheduled items the contractor has quoted/taken rates on the open market therefore, applying the factor of inflation for last 3 years' average at the rate of 10%, the 17.15% difference is considered justifiable.

6.0 DETERMINATION OF AWARD

In view of the above evaluation and analysis, the lowest evaluated Bid of M/s Haji Gul Muhammad Khan Sheerani can be considered for acceptance as recommended below.

7.0 RECOMMENDATIONS and CONCLUSION

On the basis of the systematic evaluation of bids as presented in this report, it is considered that the Bid offered by **M/s Haji Gul Muhammad Khan Sheerani** is satisfactory, substantially responsive and lowest evaluated.

The Bid Evaluation Committee believes that Bidder No.1 has provided a responsive bid hence confident that this bidder can complete the works within the time period required by the bid documents. Bidder no.1 is an experienced contractor in similar works and has carried out many works of similar size, nature, depth and complexity in the past. The bidder has supported financial and other information fully and meets the evaluation qualification criteria. The price quoted by M/s Haji Gul Muhammad Khan Sheerani is Rs. **256,038,135.05** and is **0.24%** below the Engineer's Estimate and being the lowest. Therefore contract should be awarded to the lowest evaluated, technically responsive bidder M/s Haji Gul Muhammad Khan Sheerani.
