With reference to your letter No.AD(Assessment)/SPPRA/30206/16-17/7017, dated, 8th November, 2016 on the subject mentioned above, I am directed to state that Program Monitoring Unit (PMU), UCBPRP has successfully completed its social mobilization program in 4 districts of Sindh i.e. Kashmore, Kandhokot, Shikarpur, Tharparker and Jacobabad. The program was aimed to improve livelihood conditions of the poorest rural communities in the rural areas of these districts and delivered excellent results. The Program is further being expanded to 6 districts in Sindh i.e. Kharpur, Sanghar, Thatta, Badin, Mirpurkhas and Umerkot.

PMU, UCBPRP in this regard initiated the Procurement Process by publishing Expression of Interest (EOI) in leading daily newspapers on 22nd November, 2015 for which a copy was endorsed to your office to hoist the EOI on SPPRA website. (copy enclosed at Annex-I).
