


This form will state the work to be carried out, as well as the date for submitting and opening tenders, and the time allowed for carrying out the work; also the amount of earnest money to be deposited with the tender, and the amount of the security deposit to be deposited by the successful tenderers and the percentage, if any to be deducted from bills. It will also state whether a refund of quarry fees, royalties, octroi dues and ground rents will be granted. Copies of the specifications, designs and drawings and estimated rates schedule rates and any other documents required in connection with the work shall be signed by the Executive Engineer for the purpose of identification, and shall also be open for inspection by contractors at the office of the Executive Engineer during office hours

2. In the event of the tender being submitted by a firm, it must be signed separately by each partner thereof. In the event of the absence of any partner, it shall be signed only on behalf of a person holding a power of attorney authorizing him to do so.

3. Receipts for tenders by a firm, shall also be described in tenders are described in tenders shall be signed in the name of persons having authority

4. Any person who states at what percentage memorandum showing tender take the work. Only be framed. Tenders, the said form of invitation to the work, or which of No printed form of tender but if contractors wish separate tender for each. Tenders shall have the name and number of the work to which they refer written outside the envelope.

5. The Executive Engineer or his duly authorized Assistant shall open tenders in the presence of contractors who have submitted tenders or their representatives who may be present at the time, and he will enter the amounts of the several tenders in a comparative statement in a suitable form. In the identification, sign copies of the specifications and other documents mentioned in Rule 1. In the event of a tender being rejected the Divisional Officer shall authorize the Treasury Officer concerned to refund the amount of the earnest money for deposited to the contractor making the tender, on his giving a receipt for the return of the money.

6. The Officer competent to dispose of the tenders shall have right of rejecting all or any of the tenders.







General Rules and Directions for the Guidance of Contractors

1. All work proposed to be executed by contract shall be notified in a form of invitation to tender posted on a board hung up in the office of the Executive Engineer and signed by the Executive Engineer.

This form will state the work to be submitted and opening tenders, and the work; also the amount of earnest money to be submitted, the amount of security deposit to be submitted and the percentage, if any to be deducted there a refund of quarry fees, royalties, octroi and other charges, if any, shall be granted. Copies of the specifications, design rates schedule rates and any other documents shall be signed by the Executive Engineer and shall also be open for inspection, and shall also be open for inspection by the Executive Engineer during office hours.

2. In the event of the tender being signed separately by each partner thereof, any partner, it shall be signed on his behalf by an attorney authorizing him to do so.

3. Receipts for payments made on account of any work by a firm, shall also be signed by all the partners, except as described in their tender as a firm, in which case the receipts shall be signed in the name of the firm by one of the partners having authority to give effectual receipts for the work.

4. Any person who submits a tender shall fill up a form stating at what percentage above or below the rates specified in the memorandum showing items of work to be carried out under take the work. Only one rate of such percentage, on all items, shall be framed. Tenders, which propose any alteration in the said form of invitation to tender or in the time allowed for the work, or which contain any other conditions, will not be considered. No printed form of tender shall include a tender for two or more works, but if contractors wish to tender for two or more works they shall submit separate tender for each. Tenders shall have the name and number of the work to which they refer written outside the envelope.

5. The Executive Engineer or his duly authorized Assistant shall open tenders in the presence of contractors who have submitted tenders or their representatives who may be present at the time, and he will enter the amounts of the several tenders in a comparative statement in a suitable form. In the event of a tender being rejected the Divisional Officer shall identify, sign copies of the specifications and other documents mentioned in Rule 1. In the event of a tender being rejected the Divisional Officer shall authorize the Treasury Officer concerned to refund the amount of the earnest money deposited to the contractor making the tender, on his giving a receipt for the return of the money.

6. The Officer competent to dispose of the tenders shall have right of rejecting all or any of the tenders.
