



M/s Sindh Bank has deputed its team as representatives to attend subject meeting as required under Rule-46(2)(g) of SPP Rules, 2010 (Amended 2017).

Subsequently, the PC opened the financial proposal in presence of representatives of M/s Sindh Bank and read out aloud the bid quoted by the bidder in consonance with Rules-41(4) & (5) of SPP Rules, 2010 (Amended 2017). The PC recommended to award the procurement contract to M/s Sindh Bank on the basis of their bid quoted is comparable to market rates (further details is available/ annexed with bid evaluation report and schedule of requirements duly signed by all the members of the PC).

Subsequently, the PC agreed to open financial proposal of only technically qualified firm i.e. M/s Sindh Bank before its representative as per Rules - 46(2)(g) & (h) of SPP Rules, 2010 (Amended 2017) on next schedule i.e. 5th September, 2017 @ 1 p.m.
