The meeting started with the recitation of Holy Quran. The Chair welcomed the participants and asked to Section Officer (Development) to brief about the present status of the scheme.

He informed the forum that Food Department has invited Financial & Technical Proposals for purchase of fire fighting extinguisher equipments under the subject scheme. The Notice Inviting Tender (NIT) was published through Information & Archive Department, Govt. of Sindh in the daily newspapers "Daily The Frontier Post" dated 31.01.2012, "Daily Awami Awaz" dated 31.01.2012, "Daily Difa" dated 29.01.2012, "Daily Khabrain" dated 01.02.2012 and placed on the website of SPPRA Tender ID 6566/2012 Sr. NO.10951.

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He further briefed that in response to this Department N.I.T. five companies have purchased the Tender Documents and the same five companies submitted their technical & Financial Proposals alongwith their profiles. In the Technical Evaluation Committee Meeting (Out of 7 members two members are taken from Industries Department and Civil Defence Sindh) held on 20.02.2012, three companies out of five were technically qualified.

He further informed the forum that in the Purchase Committee meeting held on 24.02.2012, the Financial Proposals of three technically qualified firms were opened in presence of their representative and the rate quoted by the successful bidder M/s Science & Computer Link was Rs.31110/- per unit.

Meanwhile, the Deputy Secretary Food drawn the attention of the forum on the observations raised by the Sindh Public Procurement Regulatory Authority on the request of Food Department for hoisting the Bid Evaluation Report on the website of SPPRA as per SPPRA Rules 2010. The observation is that Procuring Agency has accepted offer of 2nd lowest firm (i.e. M/s Science & Computer Link) in which the quoted rates are almost 50% higher than estimated cost of Rs.20.00 Million for installation of fire fighting extinguishers equipments at 1000 units of Food Godowns, how will Procuring agency justify such escalation /increased amount.


Deputy Secretary informed that the rate quoted Rs.31110/- per unit by the successful bidder are 50% higher than the estimated cost Rs.20000/- per unit, therefore, it is proposed that the scheme at the same cost, allocation / release i.e. Rs.20.00 Million (including 1% TPM charges Rs.200000/-) may be revised.

The Chief (Agriculture) Planning & Development Department and Section Officer (Dev-II) Finance Department, Government of Sindh, suggested that the scope of the scheme may be limited / reduced within the existing allocation / releases Rs.20.00 Million and purchase the 636 fire fighting extinguisher equipments for 636 important and selected units of food godowns by the Food Department instead of 1000 fire fighting extinguisher equipments for 1000 units of food godowns.

After detailed discussion, following decisions were taken:-

- i. The subject scheme at the same cost Rs.20.00 Million has been revised.
- ii. However, the scope of scheme installation of fire fighting extinguisher equipments within existing allocation / releases Rs.20.00 Million (Revenue Component) has been reduced from 1000 fire fighting extinguisher equipments for 1000 Units of Food Godowns to 636 fire fighting extinguisher equipments for important and main 636 units of Food Godowns.

The meeting was ended with a vote of thanks to and from the Chair.

I am directed to refer to SPPRA's letter No.Dir(A&F)/M0210/SPPRA/23-1/11-12/5708 dated 05.03.2012 on the subject noted above.

2. In response to your observations that the reasons for rejection of the 1st lowest company on the grounds that the items are local made, creates ambiguity, it is clarified that during the meeting of Purchase Committee (consisting 7 members including members from Industries Department and Civil Defence Sindh) held on 24.02.2012 under the Chairmanship of Addl Secy. Food Department, the Committee enquired from the representative of M/s Faiz Scientific Company about specification & supply of fire fighting extinguisher equipment, he informed the Committee that the cylinder of fire extinguisher will be made locally in Lahore and Helotron gas will be filled locally in these cylinder, in addition, the second-hand cylinders may also be used for filling gas. For the reason, the bid of M/s Faiz Scientific. Company is unanimously rejected by the Committee, as this is sensitive item and department can not bear any risk.

3. In response to your observations that Procuring Agency has accepted offer of 2nd lowest firm (i.e. M/s Science & Computer Link) in which the quoted rates are almost 50% higher than estimated cost, how will Procuring agency justify such escalation /increased amount. It is clarified that the estimated cost have been enhanced with the pace of time, therefore, the offer rates quoted by the 2nd lowest firm (i.e. M/s Science & Computer Link) are 50% higher than estimated cost. The Committee in its meeting held on 24.02.2012, decided to award the contract to the 1st ranking bidder M/s Science & Computer Link by considering Rule No.46 (2)(j) of SPPRA Rule 2010, "best evaluated bid".

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

It is further pointed out that in connection to justify / clarify the observation raised by your department, a meeting of DDWP was held on 13.03.2012 under the Chairmanship of Secretary Food to consider the issue. Wherein, the scheme was revised by reducing the scope of the scheme from 1000 fire fighting extinguisher equipments to 636 fire fighting extinguisher equipments which covers the issue.
