MINUTES OF 20TH MEETING OF PUBLIC PRIVATE PARTNERSHIP (PPP) POLICY BOARD

The 20th meeting of the Public Private Partnership (PPP) Policy Board (the PPP Policy Board) was held on Wednesday, March 8TH, 2017 at the Chief Minister House under the chairmanship of the Honorable Chief Minister, Sindh (the Chairman). The list of participants of the meeting is attached as [Annexure A] and the working paper is attached as [Annexure B].

2. The Chairman welcomed the members and participants of the PPP Policy Board and requested Secretary Finance to recite a few verses of the Holy Quran. The Chairman thereafter requested the Secretary Finance to present the agenda before the honorable members of the PPP Policy Board and update the forum on various projects undertaken so far.

AGENDA No. 1 - CONFIRMATION OF 19TH PPP POLICY BOARD MINUTES

3. The Secretary Finance presented the minutes of the meeting for the 19th PPP Policy Board Meeting [attached as **Annexure C**] for confirmation and approval by the members. There were no reservations of any of the members.

Decision: The PPP Policy Board accorded its approval to the minutes of the 19th PPP Policy Board meeting and confirmed the decisions made in the 19th meeting of the PPP Policy Board.

AGENDA NO.2 (A) — EDUCATION MANAGEMENT ORGANIZATIONS (EMOS) — RATIFICATION OF SUMMARY AND SIGNING OF CONCESSION AGREEMENTS

4. The Secretary Education & Literacy Department (ELD) informed the forum that after successful launch of the first RFP for four schools on 11th May 2016, second RFP of the EMOs Project was launched, whereby five more schools were identified to be awarded over to the private partners i.e. EMOs. Fourteen technical bids were submitted by six EMOs. After the technical evaluation and subsequent financial evaluation, the successful EMOs were identified for each of the five schools by the TFEC. A Summary dated 1st Nov 2016 was approved by the Honorable Chief Minister, Sindh as Chairman PPP Policy Board for the award of five schools and the subsequent signing of Concession Agreements with their respective Education Management Organizations. Further, the Independent Expert and the Independent Auditor for the remaining schools will also be appointed.

5. The Chairman stated that he had already approved the summary for signing the Concession Agreement and invited members for any comments. No reservations were expressed by any member.

Decision: The PPP Policy Board accorded approval for ratification of the Summary and subsequent signing of Concession Agreements with five schools under EMO project.

AGENDA NO. 2 (B) - TEACHER TRAINING INSTITUTE (TTI) & COLLEGES (TTC) PROJECT

- 6. The Secretary School Education Department (SED) informed the forum that the School Education Department, Government of Sindh intends to improve the quality of public sector Teacher Training Institutes (TTI) & Colleges (TTC) under the public private partnership mode. SED wants to explore the possible PPP arrangements for Teacher Training Institutes (TTI) & Colleges (TTC), which may include outsourcing the management of TTIs to reputable educational / training organizations through competitive bidding.
- 7. The Secretary SED highlighted that the Minister Education had consultation with the relevant stakeholders involved in the field of teachers' training. The Minster stated that he had a meeting with the stakeholders and is of the view that at least one institute per district headquarters should be handed out through investor solicitation to private parties.
- 8. The Chief Secretary supported the initiative and made recommendations to expedite the process. The Secretary Health Department (former Secretary SED) also supported the process of outsourcing under the PPP mode, in particular for the newly constructed facility i.e. Professional Development Center (PDC) on the outskirts of Karachi by the SED.
- 9. The DG PPP Unit highlighted that the SED was already in receipt of an unsolicited proposal in this regard for a school in Hussainabad Karachi and requested SED to provide their comments on the same. The Minister Education stated that they had a meeting on the unsolicited proposal and were keen to pursue it and further added that he was keen to outsource more institutes as currently large budgets are being spent on these institutes which are at present only acting as certification institutes and not adding much value.
- 10. In light of the unsolicited proposal, the Secretary SED requested the PPP Policy board to initiate the process for private partner solicitation through competitive bidding, as per an identified PPP structure.
- 11. The Chairman added that SED should proceed towards investor solicitation for these institutes. He also suggested utilizing PDF funding for structuring the same, if required.

Decision: The PPP Policy Board accorded approval to School Education Department (SED) to explore possible PPP options for Teacher Training Institute (TTI) & Colleges (TTC) by utilizing PDF funding. The PPP Policy Board further approved to initiate private partner solicitation for a teachers training institute per district including the Professional Development Center (PDC) as highlighted by Secretary, Health and the pilot project based on the unsolicited proposal through competitive bidding.
