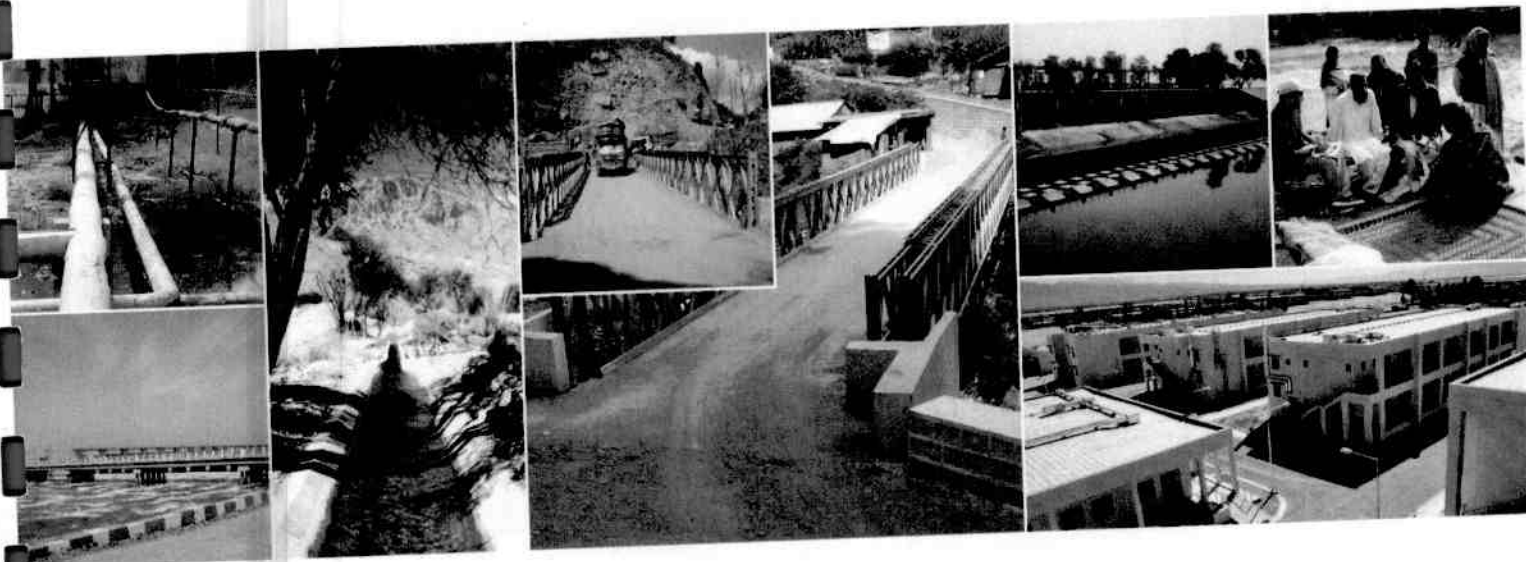

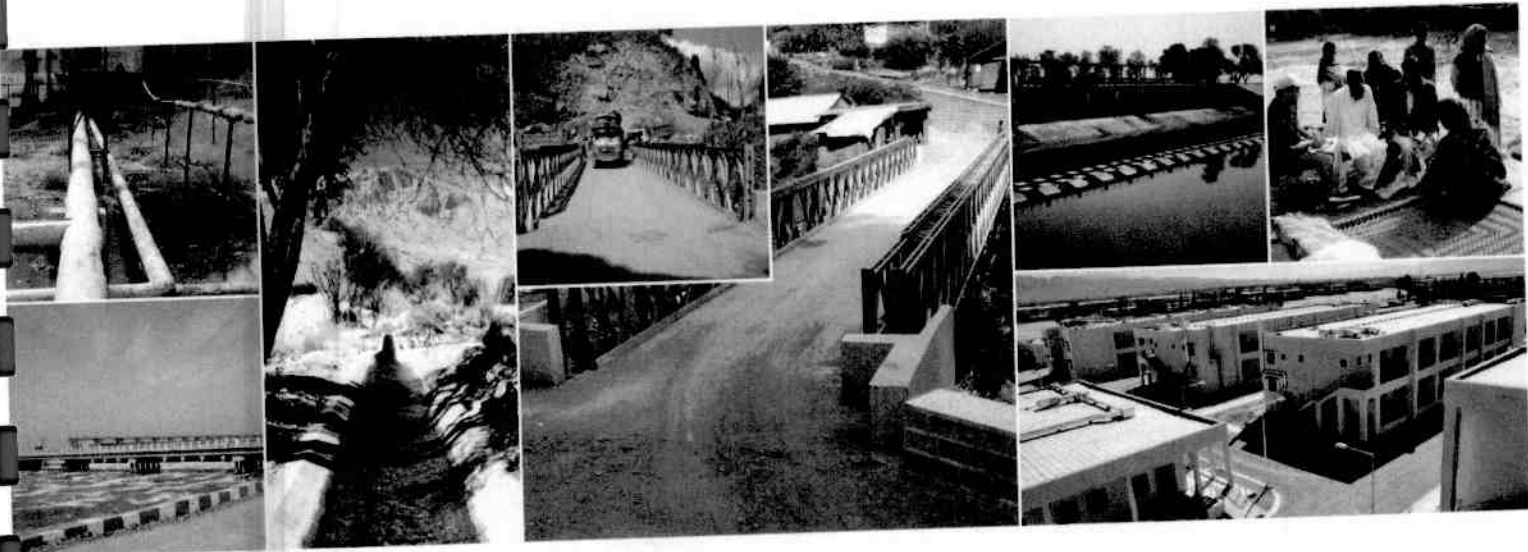

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Executive Summary

The bids for the construction of Six Schools in Khairpur District were called on 24th June 2013. Out of Five (05) pre qualified bidders, three (03) interested firms i.e. M/s Highway Engineers (Pvt.) Ltd, M/s Conpro-Zealcon (JV) and M/s Qasim khan & Company submitted their bids which were opened on the same day in the presence of the bidders.

The bid prices of all three bidders were higher than the Engineer's Estimate. Bid evaluation was carried out on the basis of the criteria as stipulated in the tender documents and in the line with the guidelines provided by SPPRA.

The bid evaluation process revealed that the rates offered by bidders were quite high and some of the rates were unbalanced. Therefore, Procuring Agency cancelled the bidding process dated 26th August 2013 and requested for rebidding among all the prequalified bidders in accordance to the SPP Rules.

NIT for re-tendering was sent to all the pre-qualified contractors on 26th August 2013. Only one contractor namely M/s Highway Engineers submitted the bid by due date and time while two pre-qualified contractors, M/s Abdul Majeed & Co and M/s Conpro-Zeacon (JV) sent a regret letters. The bid of M/s Highway Engineers was opened on 3rd September 2013 at 1500 hrs in presence of the bidder's representatives and Procuring Committee members.

The quoted bid of M/s Highway Engineers was Rs. 586,493,241/- which after the arithmetic correction comes out to Rs. 576,330,653/-. Final evaluated corrected bid price is 2.73% higher than the Engineer's Estimate, which is within the normal limit of variation.

The bid evaluation revealed that most of rates are near to or within the normal limits of Engineer's estimated rates. It is therefore, recommended that the Contract may be awarded to lowest responsive bidder M/s Highway Engineers on the final evaluated bid price of Rs. 576,330,653/-

1 Tender Submission

1.1 Background

The Program Management & Implementation Unit (PMIU), Education & Literacy Department, Government of Sindh intends to implement the Package-01: Construction of Six (06) Schools under the Program in Package-01 at Khairpur District. This program has been initiated by USAID for the development of Basic Education in Sindh.

The scope of works includes all elements required for the construction of school building with complete infrastructure facilities, drinking water, wash rooms, library, laboratory, playing parks etc having G+1 RCC frame structure building at different locations of existing schools. The contractor shall also be responsible for, including but not limited to, all the electrical, plumbing and area development works as per drawings with all details mentioned in the BOQ and in compliance with the technical specifications as stipulated in the tender documents.

As a first step towards implementation of the project, five bidders were prequalified through the evaluation process in accordance with the SPRRA guidelines. Notification/reference letter for prequalified contractors are enclosed in Appendix-A to this report. The procurement committee approved the tender documents for construction of schools package-01 in the meeting held on dated 21st May 2013, and bids were called. Three out of five bidders submitted their bid on 24th June 2013, after evaluation of bids Procuring Agency realised that the bids are unbalanced and high, hence decided to call for the rebidding. The Procuring Agency (PMIU) cancelled the bids according to SPP Rules dated 26/08/2013, copy of letters to the bidders are enclosed as Appendix-B to this report. In this regard, Notice Inviting Tender (NIT) were issued to all prequalified bidders as listed below, copies of NIT letters enclosed as Appendix-C to this report;

1. M/s Abdul Majeed & company
2. M/s Conpro – Zealcon (JV)
3. M/s Gulzari Associates
4. M/s Highway Engineers (Pvt.) Ltd.
5. M/s Qasim Khan & Company

Soft copies of Tender documents including BOQs of same tender package were forwarded to all the bidders for their bid submission on fast track basis to save the time.

1.2 Receipt of Tenders and bid opening

The tenders were received in the office of PMU, at D-29, Block-2, Clifton, Karachi up to 1400 hours on 3rd September 2013 and the tender packages were opened in the presence of Procurement Committee and the bidders' representatives at 1500 hours on the same day. Out of above five (05) pre-qualified firms, following one (01) submitted their tenders:

1. M/s Highway Engineers (Pvt.) Ltd.

Bid opening sheet is attached herewith this report as Appendix-D.

Two prequalified firms i.e M/s Conpro-Zealcon (JV) regretted to participate in the bidding for their personal reasons and M/s Abdul Majeed & Co. requested to change Bank Guarantees to Insurance bond, in other case the firm may not participate in the bidding process for this package, copies of regret letters are enclosed as Appendix-E to this report.

The procurement committee advised M/s Halcrow Pakistan, project consultant and co-opted member procurement committee for the scrutiny, examination and preparation of the bid evaluation report on behalf of Procurement committee for their review, approval and necessary action. Bid opening minutes of meeting is attached as Appendix-F to this report

1.3 Assessment of Submissions

Examination of the bids was made to establish the compliance of the bidder with regard to submission requirements. A checklist of Tender securities has been prepared and attached as Appendix-G to this report.

1.4 Responsiveness Study

The responsiveness of the Bids is determined on the basis of Clause IB-26 of instructions to Bidders.

Generally, the bidder complied with the requirements, with the exception of submission of Tender rates breakdown. This minor non-compliance on the part of the bidder was not of a nature to invalidate the bid in its entirety.

2 Preliminary Evaluation of Bids

2.1 Examination & Evaluation of Bids

As per procedure of tender submission and opening, provided in tender documents, the bids were invited on the basis of single stage one envelope procedure from the already prequalified bidders.

The bidders were required to submit tender security for an amount equal to Rs. 6.5 Million in the form of Pay Order/ Demand Draft/Call Deposit from any scheduled bank in Pakistan in favour of PMIU. The bidder complied with the bid security requirement according to the Tender conditions.

3 Detailed Evaluation of Bids

3.1 Examination & Evaluation of Bids

Examination of the bids received was made to establish the compliance of each bidder with regard to submission requirements as per checklist in Appendix-G to this report.

3.2 Conditions Proposed by the Bidders

The bidder submitted unconditional bid as per tender requirements without any additional condition proposed by the bidding firm. Photocopy of cover letter of the bidder is enclosed as Appendix-H to this report.

3.3 Scrutiny of Bill of Quantities

The multiplication of unit rates with quantities and the total amount quoted in the Bill of Quantities were checked and arithmetic errors were corrected.

The arithmetic errors in all the bids have been corrected and a comparative statement of unit rates quoted by each bidder with Engineer's estimate of Rs. 561,038,638/-; has been prepared and is presented in Appendix-I to this report.

Corrected bid prices compared with Engineer's estimate are as under;

The comparison of corrected Bid prices with the Engineer's Estimate is then summarized in the below Table 3:

As is evident from the above table, the difference of lowest bidder with the Engineer's estimate is within the normal variations limit of $\pm 15\%$. The difference may be due to different percentage of overhead/profit assumed by the bidder and escalation risk factor for the materials other than specified in the Tender added in their respective bid prices.

3.4 Scrutiny of Rates

Scrutiny of the rates quoted by the bidder was carried out from the item wise comparative statement enclosed as Appendix-I to this report.

It was asked to all the bidders to provide analyses of the tender rates in Tender documents, to ensure that they have not front loaded or under/over estimated the risk involved and they have examined the site conditions prior to submission of their bids.

Quoted rates of all the bidders are individually discussed as under;

3.4.1 Bid of M/s Highway Engineers (Pvt.) Ltd

The comparison of items rates quoted by the bidder with Engineer's Estimate shows that bidder's quoted rates are generally higher than the Engineer's estimate. It is also noted that few items are unreasonably higher/lower than the scope involved in the respective works / work sections i.e. providing and maintenance of porta cabins for temporary academic facilities (-57%), re-routing of existing electrical supply line and telephone line to new location (35% & 40%), Water testing (600%), dewatering (-90%).

Other items are as follows; MS grill (25%), MS railing (29.2%), MS folding gate (41%), marble skirting (45%), heavy duty cover with frame (614%), electrical items (15%) and plumbing items (3.5%) are at higher side.

Whereas rates of dismantling of existing boundary wall (-85%), earthworks (-30%), lean concrete (-25%) and Hand Drier (-84%) are lower than Engineer's Estimate.

It is worth mentioning here that the bidder has not quoted rates for the plumbing item of 02-05P45: 6" dia uPVC pipe for Koro Goth school, the cost of such unquoted item is deemed covered under the price of other similar items according to Tender conditions IB 12.2, and no separate payment shall be made for this item.

The total quoted price for all schools by M/s Highway Engineers for General Items, Civil, External development, electrical and plumbing works are within the normal variation of $\pm 15\%$ of the Engineer's estimate. On the whole the overall tender price of M/s Highway Engineers is 2.73% higher than the equivalent Engineer's cost estimate, which is under admissible limits.

4 Conclusions and Recommendations

4.1 Conclusion

The bidder's submitted quoted bid price to Rs. 576,330,653/- after adding only one option where more than one options were priced and summed up for comparison purpose of the bids. Final corrected bid price is 2.73% higher than the Engineer's estimate may be considered acceptable as lowest evaluated responsive bid.

Keeping in view, it is hereby recommended to award the works of Package-1: Construction of Six schools in district Khairpur Mirus for total amount of Rs. 576,330,653 /- to the lowest evaluated responsive bid of M/s Highway Engineers.


