

Clause 32.-When the estimate on which a tender is made includes lump sums in respect of parts of the work, the contractor shall be entitled to payment estimates in respect of the items of work involved or the part or the work in question at the same rates as are payable under this contract for such items, or if the part of the work in question is not in the opinion of the Engineer-in-charge capable of measurement, the Engineer-in-charge may at his discretion pay the hump sum amount entered in the estimate, and the certificate in writing of the Engineer-in-clearge shall be final and conclusive against the contractor with regard to any sum or sums payable to him under the provisions of this clause.

Clause 33.—In the case of any class of work for which there is no such specification as is mentioned in Rule 1 such work shall be carried out in accordance specification. with the Divisional specification, and in the event of there being no Divisional specification, then in such case the work shall be carried out in all respects in accordance with the instructions and requirements of the Engineer-in-charge.

. Clause 34.—The expression "works" or "work" where used in these conditions shall, unless there be something in the subject of context repugnant to such construction, be constructed to mean the work or works contracted to be executed under or in virtue of the contract, whether temporary or pemanent and whether original, altered, substituted or additional.

Clause 45.—If any materials, such as stones metal bajri, sand etc., are required to be conveyed by rail, the contractors will be granted certificates by the from the Railway.
