INTRODUCATION

Tacking step forward to manage MUET operation through a systematic and easy way, the Management of Mehran University desires to implement state of the art Campus **Management System (CMS) through open competitive Bidding Process**. The ERP is to be used in MUET Jamshoro and its affiliated Institutes. Some of the primary objectives of having CMS are as follows:

- Zero redundancy in managing the institutions records
- Effective communication between teachers, parents and students
- Complete automation of all operations
- Centrally stored information with zero redundancy
- Best possible resource optimization
- Auto-generation of timetables with dynamic substitute management
- Cost-effective one point solution for total Campus management
- Save a lots of investment in different management issues
- Manage Finance, Income and Expenditure at finger tips.
- Etc.

Other than CMS, the Mehran University College of Engineering & Technology Khairpur Mir's intends to monitor security matters because the recent terrorist attacks in the Country and increasing threat of terrorist attacks on government offices / facilities, there is immediate need for a surveillance system by which the security officials will be able to monitor the activities of

suspects and exercise general surveillance of MUCEST. For this purpose a CCTV Surveillance security system is required for 24/7 monitoring.

There was also need to Establish Computer Systems + CAD/CAM Lab having 50 computers in each with networking. Therefore the Management of MUET desired to acquire above solutions through competitive bidding process as envisaged in Rule 46(2) of SPPRA on Turn Key Basis for providing, Installation, Commissioning and make Operative in all respects.

The Technical proposals were invited from bidders asking to submit their proposals on Turn-key-basis, so that the operational business to the extent of "after-sale-support" could be kept well maintained, therefore, Bidding firms must submit their BIDS for all items. In-case any bidding firm did not submit their bids for all items, their bid will be rejected forthwith.

Therefore Bids were invited through advertisement in daily widely circulated Newspapers from eligible bidders for procurement of solutions as listed above for Mehran University, under single stage - two envelope procedure as per rule No. 46(2) of SPPRA 2004 (amended up to 2010).

- 1) The Tender was published in widely circulated National level daily newspapers such as Daily Dawn (English) and Daily Express (Urdu). Such tenders were also published on SPPRA website under ID # 9911/2012 serial No. 14297.
- 2) 14 Nos, of bids were purchased by interested parties/suppliers
- 3) 5 bidders participated in tendering process on dated: 6th December 2012 and 9 parties did not participate reasons best known to them.
- 4) The evaluation has been done on the basis of evaluation/qualification criteria as envisaged in SPPRA Rules and clearly laid down in the TENDER DOCUMENT
- 5) Results of evaluation are shown on ANNEX-E
- 6) 3 parties qualified and two found in-eligible. Names of Recommended Bidders who qualified for the for Financial bidding process are shown at ANNEX-F
- 7) Evaluation was on the basis of Evaluation criteria as under:
 - 80% weighted will be given to Technically Sound Parties, using Weighted Average Formula, $= (100 - ((\text{Highest Point} - \text{Points Secured}) \div \text{Highest Points} \times 100)) \times 0.8$
 - 20% weighted will be given to lowest quoting firms, using Weighted Average Formula, $= (100 - (\text{Quoted Bid} - \text{Lowest Bid}) \div \text{Lowest Bid} \times 100) \times 0.2$

Comments / Remarks / Recommendations of the Evaluation Committee:

- This was the major condition in tender document that in-case any bidder did not submit their bid for ALL ITEMS on TURN KEY BASIS their bid will be rejected forthwith. The name of both firms who have not complied are listed below:-
 - M/s New Horizon (did not submitted proposal for Surveillance Security Solution)
 - M/s Rasteck Technologies (did not submitted proposal for Campus management Software & Surveillance Security Solution).

Therefore the Technical Committee cannot consider both the proposals for further evaluation, However it is recommended that their sealed Financial Bids may be returned forthwith.

Recommendations: Since M/s Suparco and United Communication Solutions are not meeting the qualifying criteria, for which comments and recommendations are already mentioned by the Technical Committee in the evaluation charts above. Although the SPPRA Rule No. 48 permits single bid, but the Technical committee recommend for consideration to open Financial bids of the all three Parties so that the prices could be checked to safe guard interest of the University by availing better chance of bargaining with qualifying firm.


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Ending Comments.
