4. CONCLUSIONS AND RECOM MENDATIONS





3.7 Reasonableness of Price of Lowest Evaluated Bid

The lowest evaluated bid, submitted by Bidder No 3 (M/S MAJ & ICC (J.V)) is about 16.12% above the Executing Agency's estimate. It is recommended that the bidder may be called for signing of the bid.

3.8 Validity of Qualification Under Technical Proposal

In order to re-assure the prevailing capacity of the lowest evaluated bidder, with reference to qualification criteria given in the bidding documents, his status of resources as indicated in his Technical Proposal has been verified to be correct.

4. CONCLUSIONS AND RECOMMENDATIONS

On the basis of the systematic evaluation of bids as presented in this report, it was concluded that the bid of Bidder No.3 M/S MAJ & ICC (J.V) was the lowest evaluated substantially responsive bid. The Bidder is still qualified with required resources to execute the Work smoothly and complete it as per schedule. Therefore, it is recommended that the Contract for Work, under Package No 6: **Raising And Strengthening of MS Bund From Mile 12/0 to 18/1+150 & mile 18/3+30 to 24/7 & Raising of old stone pitching from mile 14/5 to 18/1+150 and mile 18/3+30 to 22/0.** be awarded to Bidder No 3: M/S MAJ & ICC (J.V) for the contract amount of PRs 197,599,169.


