And in case the contract shall be rescinded under the provision faforesaid, the contractor shall not be entitled to recover or to be paid any sum or any work therefore actually performed by him under this contract unless and until the Executive Engineer shall have certified in writing the performance of such work and the amount payable in respect thereof, and he shall only be entitled to be paid the amount to certified.

Clause 4.—If the progress of any particular portion of the work is unsatisfactory Executive Engineer shall, notwithstanding that all the general progress of the work is in accordance with the conditions mentioned in clause 2, be coulded to take action under clause 3 (b) after giving the contract 10 day's notice in writing. The contractor will have no claim for compensation, for any loss sustained by him owing to such action.

Clause 20.—If the contractor or his workmen, or servants shall break, deface, injure, or destroy any part of a building in which they may be working, or any building, road, fence, enclosure of grass land of cultivated ground continuous to the premises on which the work or any part thereof is being excuted, or if any damage shall be done to the work, while it is in progress from any cause whatever or if any imperfections become apparent in it within three months of the grant of a certificate of completion, final or otherwise, by the Engineer-in-charge, the contractor shall make good the same at his own expense, or in default the Engineer-in-charge may cause the same to be made good by other workmen, and deduct the expenses of (which the certificate of the Engineer-in-charge shall be final) from any sums that may then be due or may thereafter become due to the contractor, or from his security deposits or the proceeds of sale thereof, or of a sufficient portion thereof.

The value of such stores and articles as may be supplied to the contractor by the Engineer-in-charge will be debited the contractor in his account at the rates shown in the schedule in form "A" attached to the contract and if they are not entered in the said schedule, they shall be debited to him at cost price which for the purpose of the contract shall include the cost of carriage and all other expenses whatsoever, which shall have been incurred in obtaining delivery of the same at the stores aforesaid.


