You are therefore directed to please start the above work the supervision instruction of the Assistant Engineer, Highway Sub-Division Uthatta, with 7 (seven) days from the date of issue of this letter. The time allowed for completion of the work 06 Months. The work is to be carried out according to P.W.D. Specification and strictly according to Technical Sanction accorded by competent authority.

1. Programme of work may be chalked out in concurrence with the contractor and acted upon strictly.
2. No expenditure to be incurred beyond the original Administrative Approval and funds.
3. This approval and acceptance is subject to the following conditions:
 - a. No premium shall be allowed on Non-Scheduled items
 - b. No separate payment for carriage of materials shall be made. Premium quoted by the Contractor covers the cost of carriage material involved.
 - c. All materials required for construction shall be procured and brought at site by contractor at his own cost from approved sources quarries.
 - d. No payment of extra item shall be made unless written orders is given to contractor by the Divisional Officer for execution of such extra items and approved by the competent authority.

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
