(b) To employ iabour paid by the Public Work Department and to the supply materials to carry out the work, or any part of the work, debiting the contractor with the cost of the labour and the price of the materials (as to the correctness of which cost and, price the certificate of the Executive Engineer shall be final and conclusive against the contractor) and crediting time with the value of the work done, in all respects in the same manner and at the same rates as if it had been carried out by the contractor under the terms of his contract; and in that case the certificate of the Executive Engineer, as to the value of the work done shall be final and conclusive against the contractor.
