

Lubricants, Grease, cotton, Weste etc. & day to day repairs of the machinery crew well be paid by the contractor. The contractor is to indite, ay the cost of requiring the damaged Road roller if the damage accurse due to misuse of his fault.

All, minor repairs of the Road Roller up o an amount of Rs. 2000/= at a time will be responsibility of the Contractor and will attend it himself. In case contractor fail to carryout above the same shall be carried out by the Department at the risk and cost of the contractor. Any expenditure incurred this account for which certificate of Assistant Engineer Highway Sub-Division at Hyderabad/Tando Mohammad Khan /Tando Allahyar and Karach will be conclusive and binding on them shall be recovered from the Contractor towards their hire charges of Road Roller.

The Department will not entertain any claim on account of break down of the Road Roller during execution of work.

The contractor will have to arrange water by himself and Department does not in any way accept the responsibility for procurement of water required for this work
