In the event of any of the above courses being adopted by the fixecutive Engineer, the contractor shall have no claim to compensation for any loss sustained by him by reason of his having purchased or procured any. materials, or entered into any engagements, or made any advances on account of, or with a view to the execution of the work or the performance of the contract.
