1. All work proposed to be executed by contract shall be notified in a form of invitation to lender posted on a board hung up in the office of the Executive Engineer and signed by the Executive Engineer-

This form will state the work to be carried out, as well as the date for submitting and opening tenders, and the time allowed for carying out the work; also the amount of earnest money to be deposited with the tender, and the amount of the security deposit to be deposited by the successful tender and the percentage, if any, to be deducted from bills. It will also state whether a retund of quarry lees, royalties, octroi dues and ground rents will be granted. Copies of the specifications, designs and drawings and estimated rates, schedule rates and any other documents required in connection with the work shall be signed by the Executive Engineer for the purpose of identification and shall also be open for inspection-by contractors at the office of the Executive Engineer during office hours.

rejection. No printed form of tender shall include a tender for more than one work, but if contractors wish to tender for two or more works they shall submit a separate tender for each. Tenders shall have the name and number of the work to which they refer written outside the envelope:

 The Executive Engancer or his duly authorised Assistant shall open tenders in the 2.3 presence of contractors who have submitted tenders or their representatives who may be present at the time, and he will enter the amounts of the several tenders in a comparative statement in a suitable form. In the event of a tender being accepted the contractor shall for the purpose of identification, sign copies of the specifications and other documents mentioned in Rule 1. In the event of a tender being rejected the Executive Engineer shall authorize the University Accounts Department to refund the amount of the earnest money deposited to the contractor making the lender, on his giving a receipt for the return of the money

- 6. The Officer competent to dispose of the tenders shall have the right of rejecting all or any of the tenders.
- 7. No receipt for any payment alleged to have been made by a contractor in regard to any matter relating to this tender or the contract shall be valid and binding on the University unless it is signed by the Executive Engineer.
- 8. The memorandum of work to be tendered for and the schedule of materials to be supplied by the University and their rates shall filled is and completed by the office of the Executive Engineer before the tender form is issued. If a form issued to an intending tender has not been so filled in and completed, he shall request the said office to have this done before he completes and delivers his tender.
- 9. All work shall be measured net by standard measure and according to the rules and custom of the Public Works Department without reference to any local custom.

10. Under no circumstances shall any contractor be entitled to claim enhanced rates Engr. Arshad Herpeed Memon for any items in this contract.

(b) to employ labour paid by the University and to supply materials to carry out the work, or any part of the work, debiting the contractor with the costs of the labour and the price of the materials (as to the correctness of which cost and price the certificate of the Executive Engineer shall be final and conclusive against the contractor) and crediting him with the value of the work done, in all respects in the same manner and at the same rates as it If had been carried out by the contractor under the terms of his contract; and in that case the certificate of the Executive Engineer as to the value of the work done shall be final and conclusive against the contractor.

(c) to measure up the work of the contractor and to take such part thereof as shall be unexecuted out of his hands, and to give it to another contractor to complete it, in which case any expenses which may be incurred in excess of the sum which would have been paid to the original contractor, if the whole work had been executed by him (as to the amount of which excess expenses the certificates in writing of the Executive Engineer shall be final and conclusive) shall be borne and paid by the original contractor and shall be deducted from any money due to him by the University under the contractor otherwise or from his security deposit or the proceeds of sale thereof, or a sufficient part thereof.

In the event of any of the above courses being adopted by the Executive Engineer, the contractor shall have no claim to compensation for any loss sustained by him by reason of his having purchased or procured any materials, or entered into any engagements, or made any advances on account of, or with a view to the execution of the work or the performance of the contract. And in case the contract shall be rescinded under the provision aforesaid, the contractor shall not be entitled to recover or be paid any sum for any work therefore actually performed by him under this contract unless and until the Executive Engineer shall have certified in writing the performance of such work and the amount payable in respect thereof, and he shall only be entitled to be paid the amount so certified.

Clause 4 .- If the progress of any particular portion of the work is unsatisfactory the Executive Engineer shall, not withstanding that all the general progress of the work is in accordance with the conditions mentioned in clause 2, be entitled to take action under clause 3 (b) after giving the contractor 10 days' notice in writing. The contractor will have no claim for compensation, for any loss sustained by him owing to such action.

Clause 5 .- In any case in which any of the powers conferred upon the Executive Engineer by clauses 3 and 4 thereof shall have become exercisable and the same shall not have been exercised, the non-exercise thereof shall not constitute a waiver of any of the condition hereof and such powers shall notwithstanding be exercisable in the event of any future case of default by the contractor for which under any clause or clauses hereof he is declared liable to pay compensation amounting to the whole of his security deposit and the liability of the contractor for past and future compensation shall remain unaffected. In the event of the Executive Engineer taking action under sub-clause (a) or (c) of clause 3, he may, if he so desires, take possession of all or any tools, plant, materials and stores in or upon the works, or the site thereof or belonging to the contractor, or procured by him and intended to be used for the execution of the work or any part thereof, paying or allowing for the same in account at the contract rates, or in the case of contract rates not being applicable, at current market rates, to be certified by the Executive Engineer whose certificate thereof shall be final. If the contractor shall desire an extension of the time for completion of the seed on the ground of his having been unavoidably hindered in its execution or on any other control he shall apply in writing to the Executive Engineer within 30 days from the date in which he was hindered as oforesaid or on which the ground for asking for extension to which in any case before the date of completion of the work, and the Executive Engineer that it in his opinion there are reasonable grounds for granting an extension grant such talension as the thinks necessary or proper. All such intermediate payments shall be regarded at payments by way of advance against the final payments only and not as payments for work actually done and completed, and shall not preclude the Engineer-in-charge from requiring any bad, unsound, imperfect or unskillful work to be removed or taken away and reconscructed, or erected, nor shall any such payment be considered as an admission of the due performance of the contract or any part thereof in any respect or the accuring of any claim, not shall it conclude, determine, or affect in any other way the powers of the Engineer-incharge as to the final settlement and adjustment of the accounts or otherwise, or in any way very or affect the contract. The final bill shall be submitted by the contractor within one month of the date fixed for the completion of the work, otherwise Engineer-in-charge's certificate of the measurements and of the total amount payable for the works shall be final and binding on all parties.
