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1. GENERAL:

1.1 *Introduction*

This report covers the evaluation and recommendations in respect of the technical bids opened on March 20, 2014 for the following Project:

Construction of 50 Cusecs Drainage of Wastewater and effluent Channel/pipe line from Mining Areas of Thar Coal Field Unit No. 2

The Bid Document was prepared using SPPPRA 's Standard Bidding Document. The bidding procedure adopted is "**Single Stage Two Envelope Procedure**"

The Contract/Bidding Data Sub-Clause 3.2 "Qualification of the Bidder" states

Quote

***3.2 Qualification of Bidder**

To be qualified for award of the Contract, bidders shall provide evidence satisfactory to the Procuring Agency of their capability and adequacy of resources to carry out the Contract effectively. Bids shall include the following documentation and information on the relevant Forms provided in Appendix M to Bid.

- (a) *copies of original documents defining the constitution or legal status, place of registration and principal place of business; written power of attorney of the signatory of the Bid to commit the bidder;*
- (b) *total annual turnover in the civil works construction business expressed as total of payment certificates for work performed in each of the last three years;*
- (c) *performance as prime contractor, management contractor, or proportionately as member of a joint venture or subcontractor, on works of a similar nature and complexity over the last three years, and details of other work in hand and contractual commitments;*
- (d) *major items of Contractor's Equipment proposed for carrying out the Contract;*
- (e) *the qualifications and experience of key personnel proposed for administration and execution of the Contract, both on and off site;*
- (f) *any proposals for subcontracting elements of the Works such that the total of subcontracting should not be more than 30 percent of the Bid Price;*
- (g) *reports on the financial standing of the bidder including profit and loss statements, balance sheets and auditor's reports for the past three years, and an estimated financial projection for the next two years;*
- (h) *evidence of access to lines of credit and availability of other financial resources;*
- (i) *authority to seek references from the bidder's bankers;*

- (j) information regarding any litigation or arbitration resulting from contracts executed by the bidder in the last three years or currently under execution. The information shall include the names of the parties concerned, the disputed amount, cause of litigation, and matter in dispute;
- (k) information regarding historic non performance and black listing of the bidder by government, semi government, autonomous bodies, private parties; and
- (l) proposal of work methods and program, in sufficient detail to demonstrate the adequacy of the bidder's proposals to meet the technical specifications and the completion time referred to in Appendix A to bid.

Bids submitted by a joint venture of two or more firms as partners shall comply with the following requirements:

- (a) the Bid shall include all the information listed in Sub-Clauses 3.2 (a) to (e) and (g) to (k) above for each joint venture partner and 3.2 (f) and (l) for the joint venture;
- (b) the Bid, and in case of a successful Bid, the Form of Agreement, shall be signed so as to be legally binding on all partners;
- (c) one of the partners shall be nominated as being in charge, and this authorization shall be evidenced by submitting a power of attorney signed by legally authorized signatories of all the partners;
- (d) the partner in charge shall be authorized to incur liabilities and receive instructions for and on behalf of any and all partners of the joint venture, and the entire execution of the Contract, including payment, shall be done exclusively with the partner in charge;
- (e) all partners of the joint venture shall be liable jointly and severally for the execution of the Contract in accordance with the Contract terms, and a statement to this effect shall be included in the authorization mentioned under (c) above, as well as in the Form of Bid and in the Form of Agreement (in case of a successful Bid); and
- (f) a copy of the Joint Venture Agreement entered into by all partners shall be submitted with the bid. Alternatively, a Letter of Intent to execute a Joint Venture Agreement in the event of a successful bid shall be signed by all partners and submitted with the bid, together with a copy of the proposed Agreement.

For the purposes of this particular Contract, bidders shall meet the minimum qualifying criteria set forth at the end of Bidding Data.

The figures for each of the partners of a joint venture shall be added together to determine the bidder's compliance with the minimum qualifying criteria set out in this Sub-Clause 3.2 above and in Evaluation & Qualification Criteria.

The qualifications, capacity, and resources of proposed subcontractors will not be taken into account in assessing those of individual or joint venture bidders, unless they are named specialist subcontractors and the scope of their specialized participation in the Works is clearly defined in the bid.

Refer Evaluation & Qualification Criteria provided at the end of Bidding Data. To establish its qualifications to perform the Contract in accordance with Evaluation and Qualification Criteria the Bidder shall provide the information

requested in the corresponding information forms included in Appendix M along with information required in this Sub-Clause 3.2. Un-Quote*

Bids for the above Project were invited from the domestic bidders only. The lists of bidders qualified (fully or conditionally) along with detailed evaluation of their technical bids are provided as Annexure-I to this report.

1.2 Scope of Work

The work consists of laying of mining water discharge pipe line of 50 cusecs capacity from mining areas of Thar Coal Field Unit No. 2 (KM 00+000 to KM 37+500).

The laying of mining water discharge line of 1.2 m diameter GRP pipe which involves earth work including excavation in all kind of soil, laying and jointing of GRP pipe, backfilling, stone pitching at certain areas, construction of RCC inlet structure, construction of valve chambers, installation of wash out and air valves, leveling and grading, making of embankment at final disposal etc.

Bid opening and submission is summarized in Table 1 provided at the end of this report.

1.3 Methodology

Technical bid evaluation has been carried out in accordance with the SPPPRA standard procedures provided in SPPPRA Guide lines and procedures laid down in bidding document. The report is divided in to '5' sections namely:-

- Section - 1: General
- Section - 2: Bidding Process
- Section - 3: Preliminary Evaluation
- Section - 4: Detailed Evaluation
- Section - 5: Summary and Recommendations

2. THE BIDDING PROCESS

2.1 Invitation of Bids

Sindh Coal Authority (SCA) invited bids from the domestic bidders (Pakistani Firms/Organizations) through specific procurement notice (Invitation for Bids) advertised in daily "Dawn", on January 13, 2014

2.2 Addenda

During the bidding period, following addenda was issued by SCA.

2.3 Submissions of Bids

The procedure for the Submission of Bids is provided in IB Clause 19, 20 and 21 which states:

Quote

IB.19 Sealing and Marking of Bids

- 19.1 *Bidders may always submit their bids by mail or by hand. Procedures for submission, sealing and marking are as follows:*
Bidders submitting bids by mail or by hand shall enclose the original of the Technical Bid, the original of the Price Bid, and each copy of the Technical Bid and each copy of the Price Bid, in separate sealed envelopes, duly marking the envelopes as "ORIGINAL - TECHNICAL BID", "ORIGINAL - PRICE BID" and "COPY NO... - TECHNICAL BID" and "COPY NO.... - PRICE BID." These envelopes, the first containing the originals and the others containing copies, shall then be enclosed in one single envelope per set.
- 19.2 *The inner and outer envelopes shall:*
 - (a) *be addressed to the procuring agency at the address provided in the bidding data;*
 - (b) *bear the name and identification number of the contract as defined in the bidding data; and*
 - (c) *provide a warning not to open before the time and date for bid opening, as specified in the bidding data.*
- 19.3 *In addition to the identification required in sub-clause IB 19.2 hereof, the inner envelope shall indicate the name and postal address of the bidder to enable the bid to be returned unopened in case it is declared "late" pursuant to Clause IB.21*
- 19.4 *If the outer envelope is not sealed and marked as above, the procuring agency will assume no responsibility for the misplacement or premature opening of the Bid.*

IB.20 Deadline for Submission of Bids

- 20.1 *(a) Bids must be received by the procuring agency at the address specified not later than the time and date stipulated in the bidding data,*
(b) Bids with charges payable will not be accepted, nor will arrangements be undertaken to collect the bids from any delivery point other than that specified above. Bidders shall bear all expenses incurred in the preparation and delivery of bids. No claims shall be entertained for refund of such expenses,
(c) Where delivery of a bid is by mail and the bidder wishes to receive an acknowledgment of receipt of such bid, he shall make a request for such acknowledgment in a separate letter attached to but not included in the sealed bid package,
(d) Upon request, acknowledgment of receipt of bids will be provided to those making delivery in person or by messenger.

20.2 The Procuring Agency may, at its discretion, extend the deadline for submission of bids by issuing an amendment in accordance with IB 09. In such case, all rights and obligations of the procuring agency and the bidders shall remain the same as mentioned in the original deadline.

IB.21 Late Bids

- (a) any bid received by the procuring agency after the deadline for submission of bids prescribed in to clause IB 20 shall be returned unopened to such bidder.
- (b) delays in the mail, person in transit, or delivery of a bid to the wrong office shall not be accepted as an excuse for failure to deliver a bid at the proper place and time. It shall be the bidder's responsibility to submit the bid in time.*

Un-quote

The closing date and time for submission of bids was March 20, 2014 at 1500 hrs and all the bids were received by that time.

2.4 Opening of Bids

The procedure for the opening of bids is provided in IB Clause 23 which states

Quote

*** IB.23 Bid Opening**

23.1 The Procuring Agency shall open the Technical Bids in public at the address, date and time specified in the Invitation for bids in the presence of Bidders' designated representatives and anyone who choose to attend. The Price Bids will remain unopened and will be held in custody of the Procuring Agency until the specified time of their opening.

23.2 Envelopes marked "MODIFICATION", "SUBSTITUTION" or "WITHDRAWAL" shall be opened and read out first. Bids for which an acceptable notice of withdrawal has been submitted pursuant to clause IB.22 shall not be opened.

23.3 All other envelopes holding the Technical Bids shall be opened one at a time, and the following read out and recorded:

- (a) the name of the Bidder;
- (b) whether there is a modification or substitution;
- (c) the presence of a Bid Security;
- (d) any other details as the Procuring Agency may consider appropriate.

Only Technical Bids and alternative Technical Bids read out and recorded at bid opening shall be considered for evaluation. No Bid shall be rejected at the opening of Technical Bids except for late bids, in accordance with Clause 21.

23.4 At the end of the evaluation of the Technical Bids, the Procuring Agency will invite bidders who have submitted substantially responsive Technical Bids and who have been determined as being qualified for award to attend the opening of the Price Bids. The date, time, and location of the opening of Price Bids will be advised in writing by the Procuring Agency. Bidders shall be given reasonable notice for the opening of Price Bids.*

23.5 *The Procuring Agency will notify Bidders in writing who have been rejected on the grounds of their Technical Bids being substantially non-responsive to the requirements of the Bidding Document and return their Price Bids unopened.*

23.6 *The Procuring Agency shall conduct the opening of Price Bids of all Bidders who submitted substantially responsive Technical Bids, in the presence of Bidders' representatives who choose to attend at the address, date and time specified by the Procuring Agency. The Bidder's representatives who are present shall be requested to sign a register evidencing their attendance.*

23.7 *All envelopes containing Price Bids shall be opened one at a time and the following read out and recorded:*

- (a) *the name of the Bidder;*
- (b) *whether there is a modification or substitution;*
- (c) *the Bid Prices, including any discounts and alternative offers if permitted; and*
- (d) *any other details as the Procuring Agency may consider appropriate.*

Only Price Bids, discounts, and alternative offers read out and recorded during the opening of Price Bids shall be considered for evaluation. No Bid shall be rejected at the opening of Price Bids.

23.8 *The Procuring Agency shall prepare a record of the opening of Price Bids that shall include, as a minimum: the name of the Bidder, the Bid Price, any discounts, and alternative offers. The Bidders' representatives who are present shall be requested to sign the record.* Un-quote*

The bids were opened by the Bid Opening Committee constituted by SCA, comprising:

In accordance with the Bidding procedure, reproduced above, an attendance register was signed by all the Bidder's representatives, and the members of the Bid Opening Committee. The whole record is kept in SCA, and copies are provided as Annexure-III to this report.

Total three bids were received for this Project and Technical Bids of these three bidders were opened strictly in accordance with the procedure laid down in Instruction to Bidders. The three bidders are:

- a) M/s Pak Oasis Industries (Pvt.) Ltd.
- b) M/s Usmani Associates Engineers & Contractors.

c) M/s R.M. Gulistan Engineering & Contractors (Pvt.) Ltd.

3. **PRELIMINARY EVALUATION**

3.1 *Introduction*

The preliminary examination of the technical bids was carried out in accordance with IB Clause 26 to determine whether they are complete in order to assess their responsiveness.

IB Clause 26 states:

IB.26 Examination of Bids and Determination of Responsiveness

26.1 Prior to the detailed evaluation of bids, the procuring agency will determine whether the bidder fulfils all codal requirements of eligibility criteria given in the tender notice such as registration with tax authorities, registration with PEC (where applicable), turnover statement, experience statement, and any other condition mentioned in the NIT and bidding document. If the bidder does not fulfill any of these conditions, it shall not be evaluated further.

26.2 Once found to be fulfilling the eligibility criteria, as mentioned in sub-clause 26.1, the bids of eligible bidders will be evaluated for technical responsiveness as per specification and criteria given in the bidding documents. Technical and financial evaluations may be carried out in accordance with single stage-two envelopes, bidding procedures.

26.3 A bid will be considered technically responsive if it (i) has been properly signed; (ii) is accompanied by the required bid security; and (iii) conforms to all the terms, conditions and specifications of the bidding documents, without material deviation or reservation. A material deviation or reservation is one (i) which affect in any substantial way the scope, quality or performance of the works; (ii) which limits in any substantial way, inconsistent with the bidding documents, the procuring agency's rights or the bidder's obligations under the contract; or (iii) adoption/rectification whereof would affect unfairly the competitive position of other bidders presenting substantially responsive bids.

The Procuring Agency's determination of a Bid's responsiveness is to be based on the contents of the bid itself, as defined in IB 11.

A substantially responsive Technical Bid is one that meets the requirements of the Bidding Document without material deviation.

The Procuring Agency shall examine the technical aspects of the Bid submitted in accordance with IB 11, Technical Proposal, in particular, to confirm that all requirements of Works and Bidding Documents have been met without any material deviation.

26.4 If a bid has major deviations to the commercial requirements and technical specifications will be considered technically non responsive. As a general rule, major deviations are those that if accepted, would not fulfil the purposes for which the bid is requested, or would prevent a fair comparison or affect the ranking of the bids that are compliant with the bidding documents.

(A). Major (material) Deviations include:-
(i) has been not properly signed;

- (ii) is not accompanied by the bid security of required amount and manner;
- (iii) stipulating price adjustment when fixed price bids were called for;
- (iv) failing to respond to specifications;
- (v) failing to comply with Mile-stones/Critical dates provided in Bidding Documents;
- (vi) sub-contracting contrary to the Conditions of Contract specified in Bidding Documents;
- (vii) refusing to bear important responsibilities and liabilities allocated in the Bidding Documents, such as performance guarantees and insurance coverage;
- (viii) taking exception to critical provisions such as applicable law, taxes and duties and dispute resolution procedures;
- (ix) a material deviation or reservation is one which affect in any substantial way the scope, quality or performance of the works; adoption/rectification whereof would affect unfairly the competitive position of other bidders presenting substantially responsive bids.

(B) Minor Deviations

Bids that offer deviations acceptable to the Procuring Agency and which can be assigned a monetary value may be considered substantially responsive at least as to the issue of fairness. This value would however be added as an adjustment for evaluation purposes only during the detailed evaluation process.

26.5 If a bid is not substantially responsive, it will be rejected by the procuring agency, and may not subsequently be made responsive by correction or withdrawal of the non-conforming deviation or reservation.

Provided that a bid is substantially responsive, the Procuring Agency may waive any non-conformity in the Bid that does not constitute a material deviation, reservation or omission.

Provided that a Technical Bid is substantially responsive, the Procuring Agency may request that the Bidder submit the necessary information or documentation, within a reasonable period of time, to rectify nonmaterial nonconformities in the Technical Bid related to documentation requirements. Requesting information or documentation on such nonconformities shall not be related to any aspect of the Price Bid. Failure of the Bidder to comply with the request may result in the rejection of its Bid.

Provided that a Technical Bid is substantially responsive, the Procuring Agency shall rectify nonmaterial nonconformities related to the Bid Price. To this effect, the Bid Price shall be adjusted, for comparison purposes only, to reflect the price of a missing or non-conforming item or component. The adjustment shall be made using the method indicated in Evaluation and Qualification Criteria.

The Procuring Agency shall determine to its satisfaction during the evaluation of Technical Bids whether Bidders meet the qualifying criteria specified in Evaluation and Qualification Criteria.

The determination shall be based upon an examination of the documentary evidence of the Bidder's qualifications submitted by the Bidder, pursuant to Sub Clause 3.2.

An affirmative determination shall be a prerequisite for the opening and evaluation of a Bidder's Price Bid. A negative determination shall result into the disqualification of the Bid, in which event the Procuring Agency shall return the unopened Price Bid to the Bidder.

At this stage of evaluation following documents were checked for completeness:

- a) Bid received on time
- b) Bid Security of Correct Value and Validity Submitted
- c) Eligibility Documents (PEC, History of NP Contracts, Litigation) Provided
- d) Financial Documents Provided
- e) Experience Documents Provided
- f) Current Commitment Documents Provided
- g) Work Schedule Provided
- h) Method Statement Provided
- i) Organization Chart Provided
- j) Key Personnel Provided
- k) List of equipment provided

Based on the standard procedures, Checklists have been prepared, one for each bidder, of the documents submitted by them and checked by evaluation committee. The results are given at the end of this report as Table 3. The summary is provided hereunder:

4.1.1 Eligibility

Under this head following items were checked and verified using the evidence and documents/information provided by the bidders:

- M/s R.M. Gulistan Engineering & Contractors (Pvt.) Ltd. provided comprehensive work schedule.

4.1.9 Work Methodology

In accordance with **Appendix-F** to bid, the bidders were required to submit a narrative outlining the method of performing the Work. The narrative was required to indicate in detail and include but not be limited to:

The method of executing the Works, the procedures for installation of equipment and machinery and transportation of equipment and materials to the site. The Bidder was required to submit an outline of Construction Safety and Health Plan for this particular Project. The method of execution should clearly demonstrate the Contractors planning to complete the work within the completion period and should be supported by the details types of equipment and other resources proposed to be used with production rates commensurate with the quantities of major items of work. Same was checked, verified, reviewed and evaluated accordingly for suitability for the items of work involved along with the requirement of equipment and those proposed by the bidder, comprehensiveness and completeness.

- M/s Pak Oasis Industries (Pvt.) Ltd provided no work methodology for excavation related items. Schedule of work and work methodology has no relation.
- M/s Usmani Associates Engineers & Contractors provided no Proper Work methodology for any major works.
- M/s R.M. Gulistan Engineering & Contractors (Pvt.) Ltd didn't mentioned any occupational health and safety plan.

4.1.10 Organization Chart

- M/s R.M. Gulistan Engineering & Contractors (Pvt.) Ltd provided quite comprehensive organization chart.
- M/s Usmani Associates Engineers & Contractors provided sketchy organization chart. Not providing detail of organization of staff for specific tasks.

4.1.11 Camp & Housing Facility

In accordance with Appendix-H to bid, the bidders were required to provide description of his construction camp's facilities and staff housing requirements. The bidders were required to list or explain his plans for providing these facilities for the service of the contract as follows:

1. Site Preparation (clearing, land preparation, etc.).

 - b) Water (required amount and system proposed).
 - c) Sanitation (sewage disposal system, etc.).

5. Other Items Proposed (Security services, etc.).
