

APPROVED PC-I COST & BID PRICE OF SELECTED CONSULTANT

The PC-I cost for three schemes without consultancy charges (Design Services & Supervision Services) is Rs. 4,357.06 million (for Phase-I & II) whereas approved PC-I cost of Phase-I is Rs.1510.118 million, while the bid price of selected consultant is Rs.139.215 million (for both phases) and Rs.49.215 million for Phase-I, which is 3.26% of the approved PC-I cost.

MARKET PRICE

1. The design and construction supervision services for the development of infrastructure for Shaheed Mohtarma Benazir Towns was awarded to consultant in April 2012 at 2.8%. If we consider inflation of 10% per year the percentage is coming as 3.4%, while the Procuring Agency has accepted the percentage of 3.2%".
 2. In Sindh Coal Authority, a Consultancy Contract for road work Phase-II was awarded to M/s. AA Associates in consortium with ECIL in 2012 at the Price of Rs.60,241,506/-, for the design and supervision services of Road Woks, which was for rehabilitation of road work of 134-kms. and only seven (07) contract packages were involved, while this contract is of complex nature (involving roads, water supply, sewerage, storm water, buildings, etc) as compared to simple road works and the area of this work is also spreaded in four towns viz. Thatta, Sujawal, Ghorabari & Pir Patho. Hence, the rate quoted by the Consultants amounting to Rs.49,215,000/- as compared to other Bids is much low, hence justified.
- ii) The detailed bid evaluation report signed by all members of the Procuring Committee was submitted to SPPRA in June 2014. However, the BER on the format available on the SPPRA Website is sent herewith for your office record.
2. In light of above stated response and our various submissions in response to your various letters, it is requested that the observations may kindly be treated as complied.





REPORT ON EVALUATION OF FINANCIAL PROPOSALS

The technical & financial proposals for the following assignment were invited for hiring Consultants vide this office letter No.SO(B)SID/(T&S)/26-1/2014/39 dated: 24.02.2014 and subsequent corrigendum on the advice of Sindh Public Procurement Regulatory Authority letter No.Dir(CB)/SPPRA/3-8(THA)/2013-14/5210 dated: 11.03.2014 issued vide this office letter No.SO(B)SID/(T&S)26-1/2014/58 dated: 14.03.2014 wherein the RFP was to be issued upto 02.03.2014 and opened on 03.03.2014 on Quality Cum Cost Based Selection (QCBS) with 80% weightage of 80:20 in accordance with rules specified by SPPRA-2010 for engineering consultancy services.

NAME OF ASSIGNMENT

CONSULTANCY SERVICES FOR IMPROVEMENT / PROVISION OF BASIC CIVIC AMENITIES IN THATTA & SUJAWAL DISTRICT FOR SPECIAL DEVELOPMENT PACKAGE

2. The technical proposals were opened on 03.04.2014 by the Consultant Selection Committee notified vide Special Initiative Department letter No.SO(B)SID/27-1/2014-15 dated: 27.03.2013 in presence of the participating firms out of six (06) firms who purchased the documents, only three (03) firms submitted the documents.

3. These technical proposals were evaluated by the Consultants Selection Committee and approved in its meeting held on 06.05.2014 wherein only one firm M/s. EA Consulting (Pvt) Limited, Karachi was found technically qualified as per requirement of Article-16.1 at page-12 of RFP. The other two firms M/s. ESS-I-AAR and M/s. Alliance Engineering Consultants (Pvt) Limited, Lahore did not secure the required points hence not qualified. All the three firms were informed accordingly.

4. The financial proposals of the qualified firm M/s. EA Consulting (Pvt) Limited were opened by the Consultant Selection Committee on 06.05.2014 for the sum of Rs.139,215,000/- (Rupees one hundred thirty nine million & two hundred fifteen thousand only).

5. While going through the financial proposals, it is observed that the firm has quoted this amount for two phases as under:-

6. The PC-I for all the three packages viz. Thatta City, Sujawal and Two Union Councils (Ghorabari & Varr) has been approved by the Planning & Development Department, Govt. of Sindh in PDWP meeting held on 25.04.2014, Administrative Approval issued vide No.FD/SO(Dev-VI)8(04)SID/2013-14 dated: 12.05.2014 for Phase-I only.

7. Only one firm was found qualified technically and the financial proposal opened and read out in the Consultant's Selection Committee meeting on 03.04.2014 was Rs.139,215,000/-. However, on detailed evaluation, it is seen that the firm has offered the cost of Rs.49,215,000/- for Phase-I and Rs.90,000,000/- for Phase-II.

8. Since, only Phase-I of the scheme has been approved as mentioned above at para-6, awarding contract for consultation for both the phases is not advisable at this stage. Therefore the Consultant's Selection Committee considers the proposal of M/s. EA Consulting (Pvt) Limited amounting to Rs.49,215,000/- for Phase-I only. This rate as offered by the firm as compared is 58% below the provision in PC-I which is Rs.117.12 million (design charges 42.18 and supervision charges 74.94) and seems to be reasonable.

9. The Consultant's Selection Committee therefore approve the rate of Rs.49.215 million for Phase-I only and recommend to award the work on this rate.



1.0 EVALUATION CRITERIA

The method of Technical Evaluation is based on Quality cum Cost Based Selection (QCBS) with 80% weightage for Technical Proposal and 20% weightage for Financial Proposal (80:20) in accordance with rules specified by the Sindh Public Procurement Regulatory Authority (SPPRA) - 2010 for engineering consultancy services.




According to the RFP, minimum technical score required to qualify is 75% points (Refer page 12, Article 16.1 of RFP). Only one consulting firm has scored more than 75% points and stand technically qualified; it is EA Consulting Pvt. Ltd. (86.21 points, ranked 1); whereas ESS.I.AAR (64.30 points) and Allied Engineering Consultants (Pvt.) Limited (59.60 points) has failed to qualify.


It is recommended that the technically qualified consulting firm may be invited for announcement of Technical score and opening of the financial proposal of the firm.


