In this regard, Procurement Committee thoroughly examined technical proposals as well as samples submitted by the aforementioned 5 bidders and also checked the requisite documents according to eligibility and evaluation criteria mentioned in the bid document. The bidder-wise technical details is mentioned here as under.

i. M/s Mohsin Enterprises.

This firm has submitted all requisite documents mentioned in the bid document as well as submitted samples of **Khaki Drill Cloth and Blue Warm Jacket.** The Procurement Committee found the samples according to the required tender specification & quality, hence Committee declared them qualified for opening their financial proposals of the said quoted uniform articles.

ii. M/s Shaheer Traders.

This firm has submitted all requisite documents mentioned in the bid document as well as submitted samples of **Khaki Drill Cloth and Blue Warm Jacket.** The Procurement Committee found the samples according to the required tender specification & quality, hence Committee declared them qualified for opening their financial proposals of the said quoted uniform articles.

iii. M/s Imtiaz Enterprises.

This firm has submitted all requisite documents mentioned in the bid document as well as submitted samples of all uniform articles i.e. Khaki Drill Cloth, Blue Warm Jacket and Blue Beret Caps. The Procurement Committee found the samples of Khaki Drill Cloth and Blue Beret Cap according to the required tender specification & quality, but found the sample of Blue Warm Jacket not according to the requisite tender specification & quality. Hence, Procurement Committee declared them qualified for Khaki Drill Cloth and Blue Beret Cap and declared disqualified for Blue Warm Jacket.

iv. **M/s M.Siddique & Co.**

This firm has not submitted following mandatory documents mentioned in the bid document to qualify in technical evaluation.

- i. NTN / Income Tax Certificate.
- ii. GST Registration Certificate.
- iii. Professional Tax Certificate.
- iv. Relevant Experience of last 3 years.
- v. Bank Certificate / Statement of last three years (2014-15, 2015-16 & 2016-17).

Therefore, Procurement Committee declared them disqualified for opening their financial proposals and recommended that financial proposals may be returned to them unopened.

v. **M/s Business Links & Trade.**

This firm has not submitted following mandatory document mentioned in the bid document to qualify in technical evaluation.

- i. Relevant Experience of last 3 years.
- ii. Technical specification on manufacturer original letterhead with stamp.

The Procurement Committee also examined the supplied samples of uniform articles but not found according to the requisite specification and quality, hence Committee declared them disqualified for opening their financial proposals and recommended that financial proposals may be returned to them unopened.


In view of the above, the Procurement Committee unanimously decided for opening the financial proposals of the technically qualified bidders who submitted all mandatory documents mentioned in the bid document as well as samples of the uniform articles. In this connection, the Committee opened the sealed financial envelopes of technically qualified bidders and rates were announced in presence of the bidders as well as returned the sealed financial envelopes of technically disqualified bidders.

The Procurement Committee discussed the rates of above mentioned firms / bidders and found that **M/s Shaheer Traders** is lowest bidder in Khaki Drill Cloth, **M/s Mohsin Enterprises** is lowest bidder in Blue Warm Jackets and **M/s Imtiaz Enterprises** is single lowest bidder in Blue Beret Caps. According to the SPPRA Rule No.48, single bid is acceptable, even when only one bid is submitted, the bidding process may be considered valid, if it was advertised in accordance with the rules, and prices are comparable to the rates of the last award contract or the market rates. In this regard, the rates of single item "Blue Beret Caps" were compared with the last award contract, which were Rs.82.95 per no. hence the Committee found the same perfect and accepted. Therefore the Procurement Committee unanimously recommended to the I.G. Prisons that offered rates of all above mentioned uniform articles may be accepted.





In this regard, Procurement Committee with help of power looms experts of Central Prison Kraachi and Hyderabad, who are supervising manufacturing of cloth at power looms installed at Central Prison Karachi and Central Prison Hyderabad thoroughly examined the samples of yarn submitted by the aforementioned 3 bidders and Committee also checked the requisite technical proposal alongwith documents according to eligibility and evaluation criteria mentioned in the bid document. The bidder-wise technical details is mentioned here as under.

i. M/s M.Siddique & Co.

This firm has submitted all requisite documents mentioned in the bid document as well as quoted all counts of Yarn in the technical proposal, but submitted samples of two counts of Yarn i.e. 40/2 and 32/2. The Procurement Committee found the samples according to the required tender specification & quality, hence Committee declared the aforesaid bidder qualified for opening his financial proposal and rejected the technical proposals of 30/S and 20/S for non-submission of requisite samples.

ii. M/s Imtiaz Enterprises.

This firm has submitted all requisite documents mentioned in the bid document as well as submitted samples of all counts of Yarn i.e. 40/2, 32/2, 30/S, 20/S. The Procurement Committee examined the samples supplied by the bidder and found the samples of 30/S and 20/S according to the required tender specification and quality, but samples of 40/2 and 32/2 were not found according to the required tender specification & quality, hence Committee declared him qualified for two counts of Yarn only i.e. 30/S & 20/S and recommended for opening him financial proposals.

iii. M/s Mohsin Enterprises.

This firm has submitted requisite documents mentioned in the bid document. The Procurement Committee examined the samples of yarn supplied by the said bidder, but samples found of sub-standard quality and not according to the required tender specification, hence Procurement Committee declared him disqualified and recommended that sealed financial proposals may be returned to them unopened.

In view of the above, the Procurement Committee unanimously decided for opening the financial proposals of the technically qualified bidders who submitted all mandatory documents mentioned in the bid document as well as submitted samples of standard quality. In this connection, the Committee opened the sealed financial envelopes of technically qualified bidders and rates were announced in presence of the bidders as well as returned the sealed financial envelopes of technically disqualified bidder.

The Procurement Committee discussed the rates of above mentioned firms / bidders and found that **M/s M.Siddique & Co.** is single technically qualified bidder in **40/2 & 32/2** and **M/s Imtiaz Enterprises** is single technically qualified bidder in **30/S & 20/S**. According to the SPPRA Rule No.48, single bid is acceptable, even when only one bid is submitted, the bidding process may be considered valid, if it was advertised in accordance with the rules, and prices are comparable to the rates of the last award contract or the market rates. In this regard, the rates of single items were compared with the market rates and found the same according to prevailing whole sale market rates as the whole tender process was strictly observed according to SPPRA Rules.

Therefore the Procurement Committee recommended and accepted the offered rates of the single qualified bidders
