All work proposed to be executed by contract shall be notified in a form of invitation to tender posted on a board hung up in the office of the Executive Engineer and signed by the Executive Engineer, and the detailed of the works to be tendered will be supplied to the prospective tenderers on their request.

This form will state the work to be carried out, as well as the date for submitting and opening tenders and the time allowed for carrying out the work; also the amount of earnest money to be deposited with the tender, and the amount of the security deposit to be deposited by the successful tenderers and the percentage, if any, to be deducted from bills. It will also state whether refund of quarry fees, royalties, octroi dues and ground rents will granted. Copies of the specifications, designs and drawings and estimated rates schedule rates and any other documents required in connection with the work shall be signed by the Executive Engineer for the purpose of identification, and shall also be open for inspection by contractors at the office of the Executive Engineer during office hours.

Clause 10.—A bill shall be submitted by the contractor as frequently as the progress of the work may justify for all work executed and not included in any previous bill and the Engineer-in-charge shall take or cause to be taken the requisite measurements for the purpose of having the same verified and the claim, as far as admissible, adjusted, if possible before the expiry of ten days from the presentation of the bill, at any time, despite a subordinate to measure up the said work in the presence of the contractor or his authorised agent, whose counter-signature to the measurement list will be sufficient warrant and the Engineer-in-charge may prepare a bill from such list which shall be binding on the contractor in all respects.
